REFUND POLICY

There will be a \$10 charge for each refund OR transfer requested. Refund or transfer requests may be granted if presented in writing at least 5 working days before the first class meeting unless otherwise noted. Please choose classes carefully, as refunds, transfers or credits CANNOT be granted once a class has begun. Refunds or credits WILL NOT be issued for absences or late registrations. If you miss some meetings of a class you cannot make them up in another class. Refunds are not made on the basis of not receiving a confirmation.

Aquatics classes and lessons are offered rain or shine unless: a) It is raining so hard that the bottom of the pool is not visible, b) There is lightning in the immediate vicinity, or c) It is so cold that ice forms on the pool deck. If these conditions are not present and you decide to not attend a swim class or lesson due to inclement weather, there will be no refund, make-up lesson or credit granted.




