

Punctuation are marks we use in writing to help us make the meaning clear. Every sentence must end with a **period**, **exclamation point** or **question mark**.

.	period	used at the end of a sentence that tells something, and after most abbreviations	The cat sat on the Mr. Scott's rug.
!	exclamation point	used at the end of a sentence to express excitement	She didn't clean up her mess again!
?	question mark	used at the end of a sentence that asks a question	What do you want for lunch?
