

## Using a and an correctly

Using a and an is simple. For the most part if the word following the a/an starts with a vowel (a,e,i,o,u) then use 'an'. If the word starts with any other letter than use 'a'.

There are some exceptions to the rule. If a word sounds like it starts with a vowel, then use 'an' (hour) or if it sounds like a consonant the use 'a' (one).
