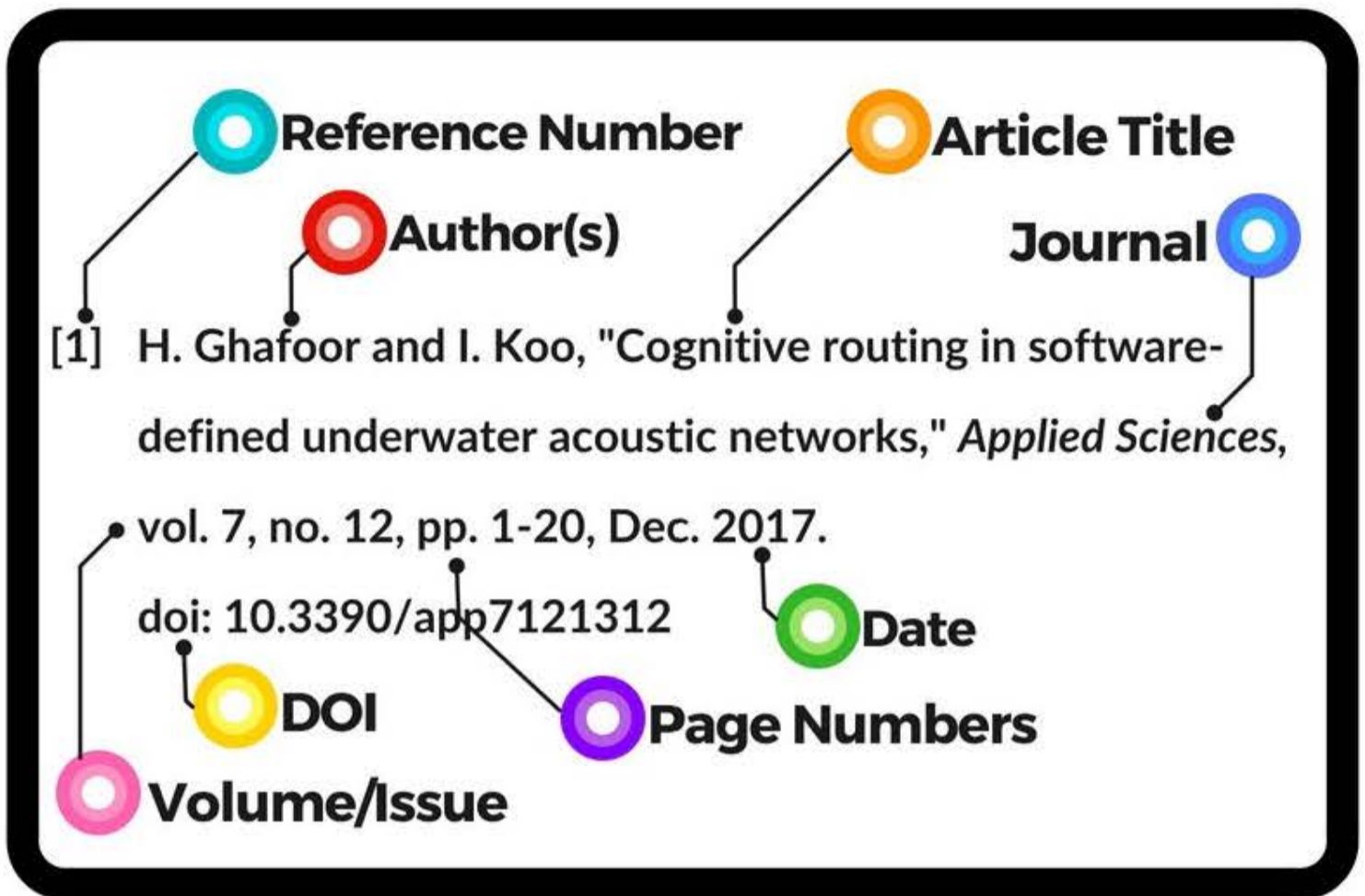


IEEE Citation Style

JOURNAL ARTICLE



- Reference Number:** IEEE style uses a reference number for each citation in the reference list. Assign a reference number to the article and write it in square brackets.
- Author(s):** Write the first and sometimes middle initial of the authors name, followed by a comma, then their last name. If there is a second author, write "and" followed by their name in the same format. End this section with a comma.
- Article Title:** Write the title of the article, followed by a comma. Place quotation marks on both sides of the title with the comma inside.
- Journal:** Write the title of the journal in italics, followed by a comma. Capitalize the first letter of each word.
- Volume/Issue:** Write "vol." and the volume number, followed by a comma, and then "no." and the issue number, followed by a comma.
- Page numbers:** Write "pp." and the page range, followed by a comma.
- Date:** Write the abbreviated month and the year in which the journal was published, followed by a period.
- DOI:** Write "doi:" and then the Digital Object Identifier (DOI), excluding https://. Do not follow this with punctuation.
