This year Newport Middle School and Future Bound Program students took part in the Oregon Aglink Adopt a Farmer Program. In the fall Stahlbush Island Farms came to NMS to have lunch with the students and share about their farm. They made a fun pumpkin pie recipe with the students from pumpkins grow on the farm. This spring the students were able to travel to Corvallis to tour the farm and learn all about sustainable agriculture. Stahlbush Farms has been a leader in agricultural innovation and was the first farm in Oregon to use GPS technology, and the first to build a bio-gas plant that generates electricity using agricultural by-products in North America! One of our first farm to school partnerships was with Stahlbush Island Farms. Their nutritionally dense and delicious squash and berries can be found in our school meals.
