The St Hilda's Foundation proudly organises 'A Day at the Races,' an annual event that has become a prominent fixture in the Gold Coast event calendar.

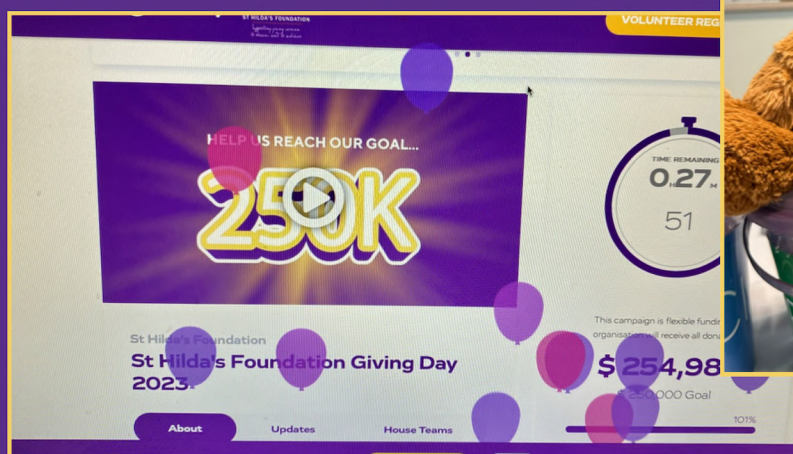
