## DESIGNATED SITE Camping Rules

**Permit required** for camping in designated dispersed sites located within the Timothy Lake Management Area.

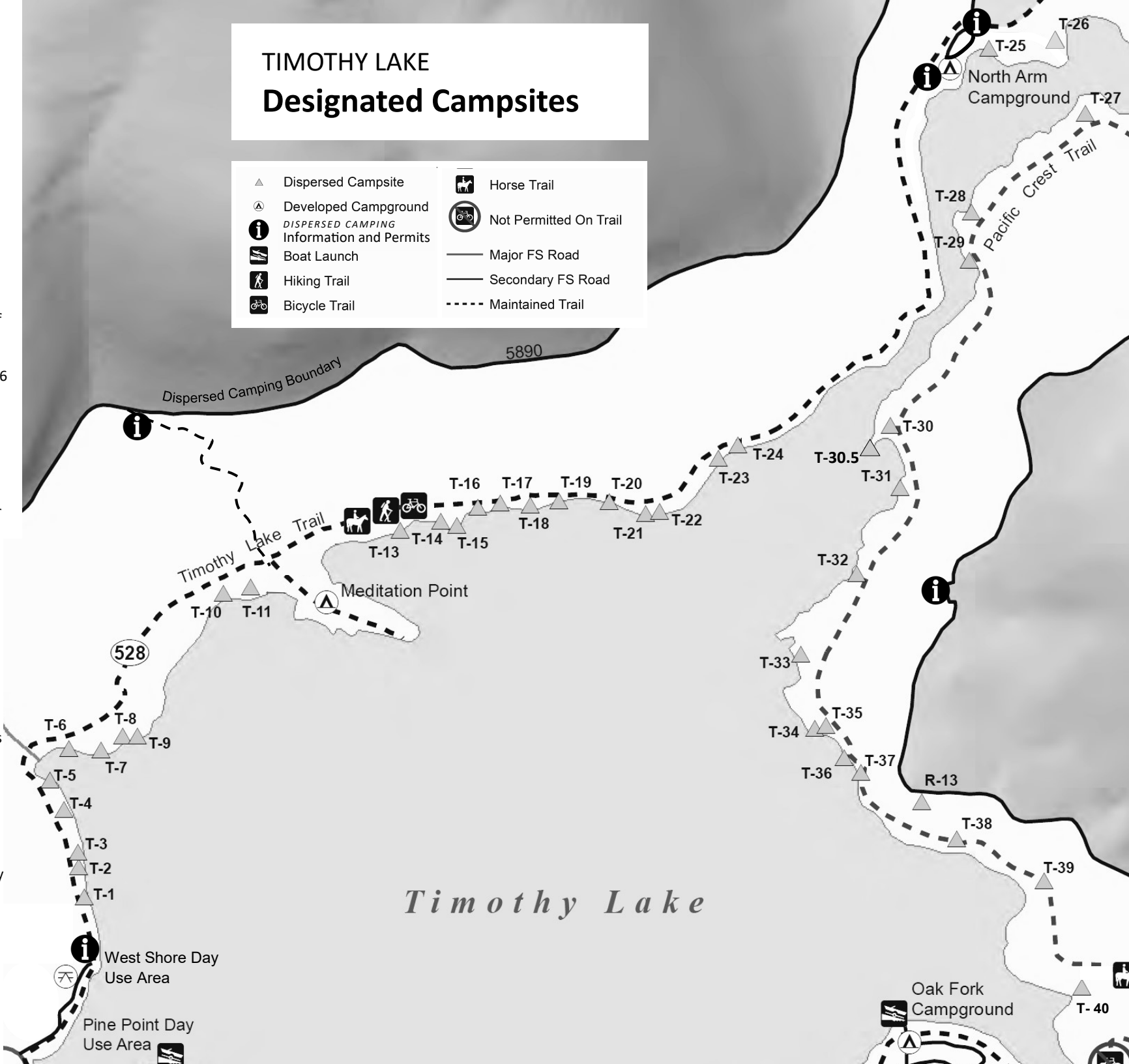
- Camping is only allowed in campgrounds and designated dispersed sites
- Site markers establish campsite location—camp within 10 feet of these markers
- Maximum occupancy for sites is 6 persons
- Campfires are allowed within campsite boundaries only, use existing fire rings
- Discharging a firearm, air rifle, or gas gun is prohibited
- Pack it in— Pack it out. All garbage, food, and belongings must be removed from site and properly disposed of when vacating site
- Deposit human waste by digging a cathole 6+ inches deep, 200+ feet from water, camp, and trails
- Pets must be on leash no more than 6 feet long and under control at all times
- Maximum of two 14 consecutive day stays per year with a 30+ day break between

These rules are enforceable under Title 36 of the Code of Federal Regulations. Violations are subject to fine or penalty.
