

# ENMU Tailgating Rules and Guidelines

ENMU invites fans and alumni to enjoy tailgating prior to ENMU football games at Greyhound Stadium. The designated tailgating area where the consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed is located in parking lot "B" of Greyhound Stadium directly south of the ENMU Greyhound Baseball Field.

Set-up for tailgating is allowed on the day of the football game. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed four (4) hours prior to the start of an ENMU football game. Tailgating space and availability are limited and are provided on a "first come, first served" basis except for specifically reserved spaces. Patrons are cordially asked to keep this area free of unnecessary vehicles in order to make room for tents, grills, set-ups, etc. Tailgating may commence four hours prior to the start of the game. The consumption of alcoholic beverages in tailgating area(s) will be stopped 30 minutes prior to the start of the game. Patrons should utilize this 30-minute window prior to the game to pick up their areas. Loitering in the tailgating area and parking lots after the start of the game will not be allowed. Patrons will be asked to proceed to the football game or leave the area at the start of the athletic event. This is necessary to deter criminal and administrative violations such as larceny, criminal damage, and excessive alcohol consumption. The tailgating rules and regulations listed below are designed to ensure participant safety at Greyhound Football games.

## **The following rules concerning tailgating will be strictly enforced:**

- The consumption of alcoholic beverages is only allowed in designated tailgating area(s).
- The consumption of alcohol is only allowed during designated times.
- The consumption of alcohol must stop 30 minutes prior to the start of the game.
- Drinking to the point of intoxication is prohibited.
- Glass bottles and kegs are prohibited.
- Loitering in parking lots and tailgating area(s) is prohibited when the game starts.
- Drinking games such as "Beer Pong" are prohibited.
- Items that facilitate the mass consumption of alcohol are prohibited.
- Patrons are expected to clean up their tailgating areas.

## **Individuals may face criminal charges for the following activity:**

- It is a felony to sell, serve, or give alcoholic beverages to minors.
- It is unlawful for an individual under the age of 21 to possess or consume an alcoholic beverage.
- It is unlawful to knowingly remain on University property after consent to do so is withdrawn.
- It is unlawful to litter or discard refuse in any place other than a trash receptacle.
- Violators may be Prosecuted or Removed from University Property!
