## **How We Work: By the Numbers**



- 3 powerful partners: AARP Foundation, AARP, and the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation
- 51 state-based Action Coalitions

  - 57 national, business, consumer, and health professional organizations make up our *Champion Nursing Coalition*
  - 9 leaders from leading minority nursing organizations make up our Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion Steering Committee

Under the Graduate Nurse Education Demonstration, CMS will provide reimbursement to up to five eligible hospitals for the reasonable cost of providing clinical training to advanced practice registered nursing (APRN) students added as a result of the demonstration.



## Big Win for Veterans: VA Lifts Restrictions on Nurses




The Department of Veterans Affairs has issued a final ruling on the proposal to allow advanced practice registered nurses to provide care to the full extent of their education and training to veterans in VA facilities.

The ruling on a proposal made early this year allows nurse practitioners, certified nursemidwives, and clinical nurse specialists full

practice authority. However, it does not allow certified registered nurse anesthetists (CRNAs) full practice authority, a part of the original proposal.




