



#### REDUCING E/M/SSIONS


Organizations working to eliminate or reduce greenhouse gas emissions generated in the course of business.

#### ENGAGING COMMUNITIES




Organizations working directly with communities impacted by climate change to collaborate, support, and elevate community-driven solutions.
