- We cannot pre-screen, evaluate or advise on an application or eligibility outside of our formal application process.
- Documents received via email will not be processed. To add documents to an application please upload them to the student portal: <https://nbcc.ca/admissions/forms-applications/admissions-document-portal>
- All applications received are time and date stamped on completion (once all documents/transcripts are received) which sets the priority for the evaluation process.
- Due to the high volume of applications anticipated, the evaluation process may take longer than 6-8 weeks. Evaluation decisions will be issued by email only once the evaluation is completed. Until then, no further update will be provided.
- Evaluations are completed on a campus-specific program basis. Applications and admission offers are not transferrable between campuses, programs, or intakes.
- Please refrain from sending multiple emails to different individuals/departments, as this drastically slows down our response time.
