## HOSTEL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Students residing at the Hostel are bound to comply with the rules and regulations, as follows which have been framed to ensure the safety of all inhabitants and that the Hostel property and to ensure a comfortable and conducive environment for healthy living.

1. The Hostel fee shall be payable yearly in advance along with the interest free security deposit and other charges. The term for the Hostel fee is one academic year as per the academic calendar of the respective course/program.
2. Hostel fee is once paid non-refundable.
3. The Student is required to disclose his/her past medical history in writing. Non-disclosure of past medical history will be at the risk of the Student.
4. Room allotment shall be done by the University authorities. Students shall not interchange their rooms with another or occupy any vacant room/bed without the prior written permission from the Rector/Warden which permission may be refused without assigning any reasons. The Rector/Warden has the right to shift any Student from his/her room to another room in the Hostel.
5. No right in nature of tenancy, lease or any other right of such nature is created by occupation or use of Hostel premises and property. A Student is merely permitted to temporarily stay in the Hostel, under the rules and regulations framed by the University from time to time. The Management may revise, alter, change or revoke any rule(s) or regulation(s) without prior intimation to the Students and the same will be binding upon the Students
6. Provision of Hostel accommodation at the time of admission does not automatically ensure its continuation in the subsequent years. The Student has to apply every year for admission to the Hostel which can be denied by the University on any grounds whatsoever including but not limited to low academic performance, previous acts of indiscipline, etc.



7. The Student is personally responsible for safety of their all valuables. Neither the University nor its Management will be responsible for any loss, theft, breakage, breakdown, etc., of any goods of the Students.
8. Students shall NOT bring any extra furniture or other fixtures in the room. All furniture and fixtures in the rooms allotted to students shall be cared for property. Students shall be required to pay double the original cost of any item found missing from their room. Students shall also be required to pay twice the charges of repair to items that are found to have been willfully damaged or have been damaged on account of misuse or unfair wear and tear.
9. All furniture and fixture in the rooms allotted to the Student must be cared for properly. The Student will be required to pay double the original cost if any item is found damaged or missing from their room. The Student will also be required to pay twice the charges of the repair of an item that is found to have been willfully damaged or have been damaged on account of misuse or unfair wear and tear.
10. Students are prohibited from interchanging any furniture/fixture from one point/location in the Hostel to another. Besides a penal recovery as imposed by Warden/Rector, the Students involved in such activities may be expelled from the Hostel.
11. Theft/damage to Hostel premises or University assets will be recovered from all Students of the flank/wing involved. In case of theft/damage to items that pertain to usage by the complete Hostel, the recoveries will be made from all the occupants of the Hostel.
12. Students are not permitted to bring on the premises and/or use electrical appliances. Violation of the said rule will result in confiscation of the appliance and removal of the Student from the Hostel.
13. The lights in the room and bathroom should be used only as and when necessary and shall be switched off, when not in use. In case of default the Warden/Rector may impose a fine on the Students occupying the room.
14. Students shall ensure that the usage of water is within limits and should ensure all taps and water outlets are closed to avoid any scarcity.
15. The Warden/Rector or any other person authorized by the University



including but not limited to any person deputed as security guard may inspect the room and belonging of any Students at any time to ensure to ensure strict compliance of rules and prevent violation of any laws or rules.

16. A Student shall be required have to vacate the Hostel/room within five days of completion of her/his examination or as directed by the Warden/Rector/University, whichever is earlier. Any stay beyond the aforesaid period may result in the suspension of the Student from the University along with other remedies. The University reserves the right to eject any Student by use of reasonable force and confiscate his/her belongings in the event of any violation of this rule by a Student.
17. The University/Warden/Rector reserve the right to expel any Student from the Hostel on any ground deemed fit and which decision will be final and binding upon the Student. No refund of Hostel fee or any other charges will be made in the such an event.
18. Any Student expelled and/or suspended by the University or any institute of the University will automatically stand expelled from the Hostel. No refund of Hostel fee or any other charges will be made in the such an event.
19. Students shall be responsible for storing their belongings safely while being away from the Hostel. The University//Warden/Rector/Management will not be responsible for any loss or theft of any belongings.
20. At the time of vacating the room/Hostel the Student must ensure that he/she has taken back all his/her belongings. No claims on account of any misplacement, theft, loss, etc., will be entertained and it will be deemed that the Student has taken back all his/her belongings with him/her.
21. Each Student must personally sign the attendance register/biometric attendance record every day between 8:00 pm - 9:00 pm. After such prescribed time, the Student is not allowed to go out of the Hostel. Going out of the Hostel will lead to a disciplinary action.
22. Students shall return to the Hostel before prescribed time after which the gates will be closed and entry will be prohibited. The gates will reopen at 6.00 a.m. the next day. Late entry will only be permitted subject to a written request by the parent/guardian of the Student and subject to the



same being allowed by the Warden/Rector. Violation of the said rule more than once will result in expulsion of the Student and the Hostel fee along with other charges will stand forfeited.

23. Any overnight stay outside the Hostel premises including for any University/institute activity will be subject to the Student submitting proof of such activity or the parent/guardian of the student making a request and the same being allowed by the Warden/Rector.
24. No outside guests are allowed inside the Hostel premises. Further, any parent/guardian visiting the Student will not be allowed entry anywhere in the Hostel premises beyond the Hostel lobby and further any such visit will be subject to the written permission of the Warden/Rector. Overnight stay by parents/guardians are not permitted.
25. Students may celebrate birthdays and festivals only with the prior written permission of the Warden/Rector and subject to compliance with all rules of the Hostel and applicable laws. Crackers, explosives, speakers, loudspeakers, permanent colours, oils, grease, lubricants, oil, etc., are not permitted during the celebration of any festivals. Any Student not willing to participate in such activities will not be forced, coerced by other Students and any Student found guilty of forcing, coercing, pressurizing, etc., any other unwilling Student will be expelled from the Hostel and the Hostel fee along with other charges will stand forfeited. The University may further take any disciplinary action as may be necessary against such Student(s). However, no celebrations or festivities are permitted between 21:00 hours to 09:00 hours or during any class timings of any program/institute.
26. Any Student permitted by the Warden/Rector in writing for overnight stay will not be permitted to enter the Hostel premises before 06:00AM on the subsequent day except in case of any medical emergency.
27. Students must always carry their Hostel Identity Cards on their person inside the Hostel premises and outside. Any violation of this rule will result in necessary disciplinary action.
28. Servant and/or helpers are not permitted on the Hostel premises.
29. Outside food is not permitted on the Hostel premises. Mess is compulsory for all Students residing at the Hostel. Any violation of this rule will result



in strict disciplinary action.

30. Mess food will not be served to any Student in their room unless certified by the University's designated medical practitioner. Students are not permitted to carry, take or store mess food inside their rooms.
31. No student can claim mess rebate unless he/ she had intimated his / her absence in advance by applying for mess rebate in the prescribed form and such permission has been granted by the Warden/Rector.
32. No outside food is allowed in the mess.
33. Mess timings shall be followed strictly.
34. Cooking inside the rooms is strictly prohibited. Students are not permitted to bring on the Hostel premises any cooking equipment, stove, gas cylinders, induction stove, etc. Violation of this rule will result in immediate expulsion of the Student and forfeiture of the Hostel fee and other charges.
35. Students may give their feedback or complaints regarding the mess, menu Hostel, etc., to the Warden/Rector.
36. Any Student not eating any meal at the mess due to any reasons whatsoever has to inform the Warden/Rector in advance to avoid wastage of food.
37. Parents/guardians are permitted to eat at the mess subject to prior permission and payment of charges as may be decided by the Warden/Rector. The Warden/Rector may refuse such permission on any grounds whatsoever.
38. Students are prohibited from keeping any speakers, microphones, loudspeakers in their rooms. Further, strict silence must be maintained from 22:00 Hours to 06:00 Hours each day.
39. Students must keep their rooms, verandah, common areas and surrounding areas tidy, neat and clean at all times and shall not throw anything including trash, in such places or any premises in the Hostel, except in the dustbin or the place specifically provided for the said purpose.
40. No wet clothes should be dried on the furniture or in corridors/balconies.



The Warden may confiscate any such clothes hung for drying in the balconies/corridors.

41. Students must treat the staff of the Hostel with due courtesy and respect at all times. Service of the Hostel staff shall NOT be utilized for private or personal work. No tips in cash or kind should be given to the Hostel staff.
42. Ragging in any form whatsoever is strictly BANNED. It is a cognizable offence and violation will invite action as per law of the land, in addition to expulsion from the Hostel and University.
43. Being a silent spectator and not reporting/stopping others indulging in ragging is also an offence and will invite similar disciplinary action.
44. Students should report any such incident immediately to any member of the Anti-Ragging Committee/Warden/Principal/Rector directly at any time of the day/night.
45. Students are strictly prohibited from bringing or keeping any pet(s) or animal(s) inside their room or the Hostel premises. Any violation of this rule will result in immediate expulsion from the Hostel and University and forfeiture of the Hostel fee, course fee and other charges.
46. Students are strictly prohibited from bringing, storing, possessing, consuming, selling, distributing any alcohol, derivatives of alcohol, products containing alcohol in any amount, intoxicating drinks, drug or substances of any kind whatsoever. Smoking in the room and/or any part of Hostel premises is strictly prohibited. Violation of this rule will result in immediate expulsion from Hostel and University and further action as per law will be taken.
47. Gambling, betting, lottery, sale of tickets, committees, etc., are prohibited on the Hostel premises. Violation of this rule will result in immediate expulsion from Hostel and University and further action as per law will be taken.
48. Students must not paste, display or hang any posters, paintings, wall art, etc., inside the room or Hostel premises. Further, Students are prohibited from changing/altering the colour scheme of the Hostel premises and/or their room.



49. No offensive or derogatory statement, picture, poster, etc., shall be pasted, hung, displayed by any Student against any other Student, Warden, any professor, staff University or its Management. Violation of this rule will result in immediate expulsion from Hostel and University and further action as per law will be taken.
50. Students must not bring on the Hostel premises and/or store anything in their rooms which is prohibited under any law. Further, any substance which may cause annoyance or nuisance to other Students, staff, public are prohibited from the Hostel premises.
51. Students shall not indulge in any political or communal activity which is in violation of the rules and/or against any law, rules, bylaws, etc., and/or against the Government or its policies. Students shall not carry on any propaganda or publicity of any nature whatsoever in respect of any political or communal matters. Students are strictly prohibited from forming any union, political organization, outfit, etc., or joining any existing union, political organization, outfit, etc. Violation of this rule will result in immediate expulsion from Hostel and University.
52. Students are strictly prohibited from uploading any pictures, photos, videos, etc., of the Hostel premises, University campus or their room on any public domain. Violation of this rule will result in immediate expulsion from Hostel and University.
53. Processions, rallies, slogan shouting, etc., is strictly prohibited within the Hostel premises.
54. Additional locks and safety equipment is not permitted to be attached or fixed to any doors, windows or other property of the University.
55. A minimum of two months' notice is necessary in case a student wishes to vacate the Hostel.
56. Male students are strictly prohibited from entering the female hostel and vice-versa. Violation of this rule will result in strict disciplinary action.
57. Students shall take prior written permission of the Warden /Rector/principal before giving any information or interview to any member of the Press, Print Media, Radio, Television or any other media or before making or appearing in any speech, video recording, voice



- recording, podcast, survey containing any information regarding the Hostel, University, its staff, its management, etc.
58. Storage or possession of firearms, ammunitions, explosives and inflammable goods including any licensed firearms, ammunitions, explosives and inflammable goods is strictly prohibited. Violation of this rule will result in immediate expulsion from Hostel and University and further action as per law will be taken.
  59. If any common property is lost/damaged/disfigured, the loss will be recovered from all the Students, in equal share, who are responsible for the damage or loss or in general use of that property. In case the damage/loss cannot be pinpointed to Student(s), then collective fine to recover the loss will be levied by the on all the Students.
  60. Students residing in the Hostel will be staying at their own risk, liability and consequences. The University or its Management is not responsible for the conduct of any Student.
  61. Students are prohibited to have any type of motor vehicles. Management does not take responsibility of the vehicles. Parking of two wheelers in the hostel corridors and under porticos is strictly prohibited.
  62. The University may assist a Student in case of a medical emergency however, the cost and risk of any medical treatment will be that of the Student along with his parent/guardian. The University and/or its management are not responsible for the same.
  63. Proper dress code must be maintained in the Hostel premises. Wearing of boxers, vests, underwear, towel and/or sans any of the above is strictly prohibited outside the room or in any common areas, verandah, balconies, etc.
  64. Hostel authorities, University and its management will not be responsible for any loss of money, jewelry or personal belongings of any Student. Students are advised not to keep any cash/jewelry or any costly items in the room.
  65. In addition to the penalties, punishments and fines provided in these Rules, Disciplinary action as per University guidelines and the law shall be taken against Student violating these Rules.





66. The University reserves the right to expel any Student on any grounds whatsoever from the Hostel.
67. These rules may be amended, modified, changed, etc., at any time without any prior intimation to the Students and the decision of the University will be final and binding.
68. The University reserves the right to take action against any Student including but not limited to expelling him/her from the Hostel and/or the University on any grounds not mentioned in these rules. The decision of the University will be final and binding in this regard.
69. The University may withdraw the Hostel facility at any time without any prior intimation which decision will be final and binding.
