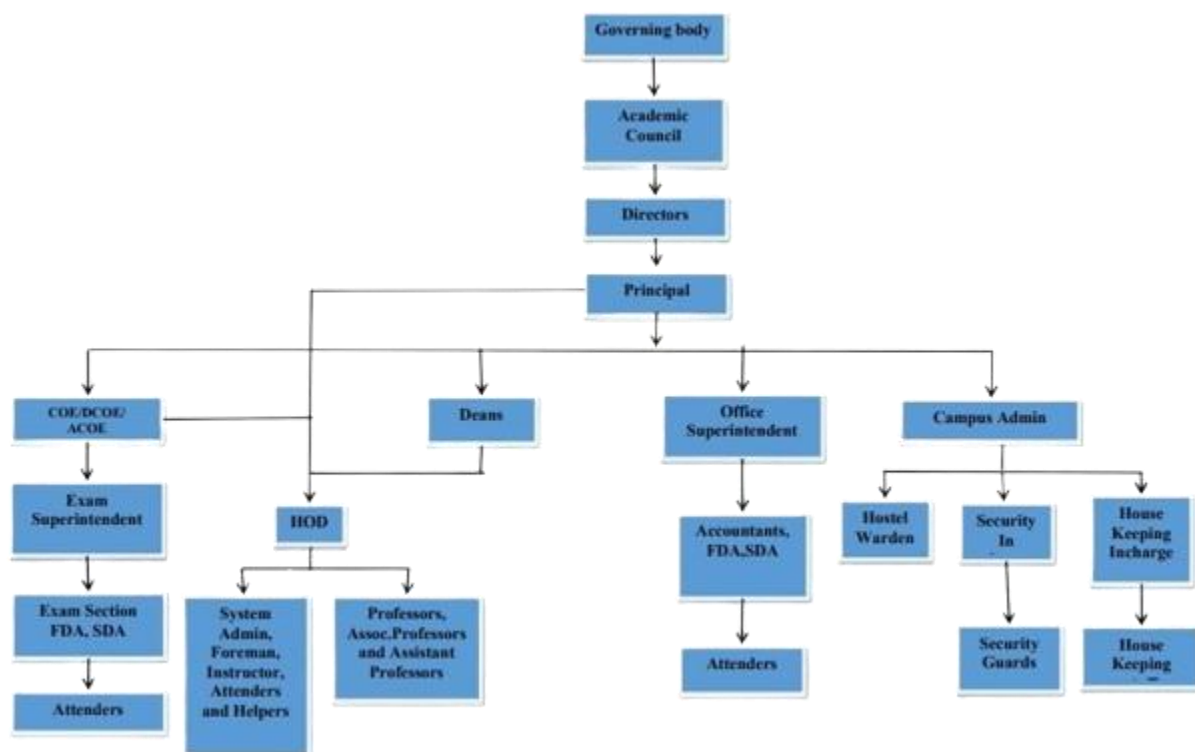

Procedure for Grievance Handling:

1. **Receipt of Grievances:**
Grievances can be submitted either online or offline by the complainant.
2. **Committee Meetings:**
The Grievance Redressal Committee will convene meetings on a fortnightly basis to review and address the grievances received.
3. **Resolution of Grievances:**
 - Upon receiving a grievance, the Committee will discuss and attempt to resolve the matter.
 - If the complainant is satisfied with the resolution, the Committee will forward the grievance and its decision to the Appellate Authority (Principal) for final approval.
4. **Appellate Decision:**
The Appellate Authority shall provide the final decision on the grievance within 3 working days from the date of its receipt by the Appellate Authority.
