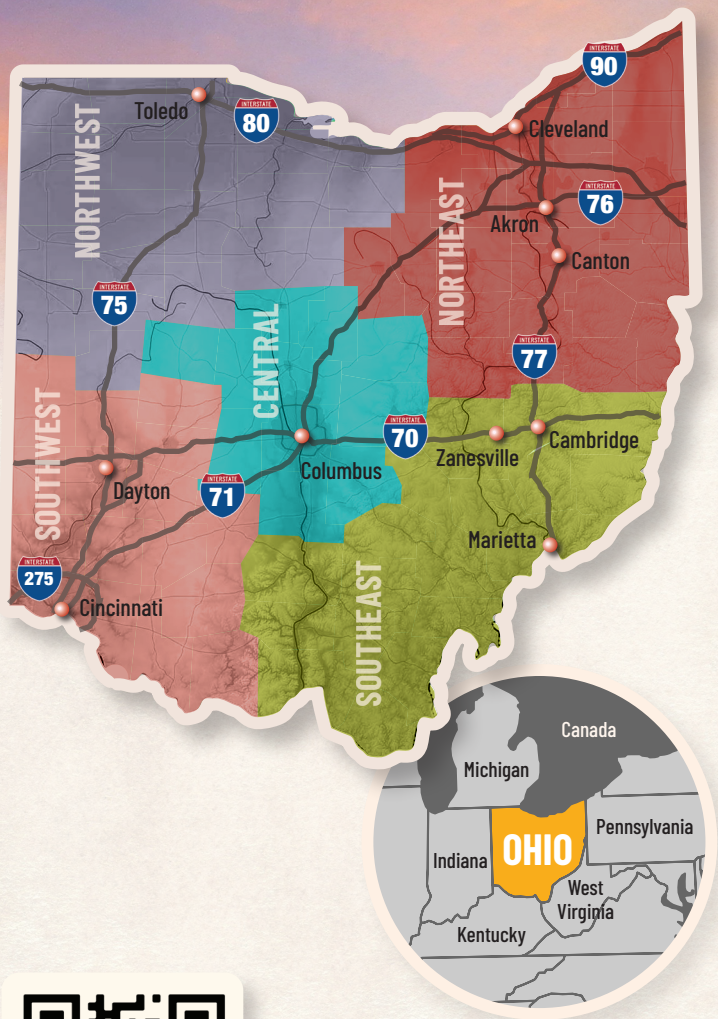
## CENTRAL
