Sub: Report on e-voting conducted at the Tribunal Convened Meeting of Trade Creditors of M/s. Incor Hospitals Private Limited on 15.10.2022 held through videoconferencing.

I, Kruthi Kalaga, Advocate, appointed as the Scrutinizer by the Hon'ble National Company Law Tribunal, Hyderabad Bench at Hyderabad vide its order dated 05.09.2022, in CA. (CAA) No. 25/230/HDB/2020 for the purpose of scrutinizing evoting of the Meeting of Trade Creditors of M/s. Incor Hospitals Private Limited held on 15.10.2022 at 12:00 P.M. through video-conferencing on Webex, on the resolution seeking approval of Trade Creditors of Incor Hospitals Private Limited for the proposed Scheme of Amalgamation of Incor Healthcare Private Limited ('the Transferee Company') with Incor Hospitals Private Limited ('the Transferee Company') and their respective shareholders & Creditors in terms of the notice dated 12.09.2022 convening the meeting (the "Resolution").

I hereby submit my report as under:

### 1) CUT-OFF DATE

Notices were issued to Trade Creditors whose names appeared in the books of accounts of Incor Hospitals Private Limited as on 31.03.2022, being the cut-off date for



the purpose of deciding the entitlements of Trade Creditors to vote through e-voting at the meeting.

## 2) <u>E-VOTING AT THE MEETING</u>:

### 2.1 Agency:

Incor Hospitals Private Limited Appointed Central Depository Services (India) Limited ("CDSL") as the agency for providing the e-voting facility at the meeting.

### 2.2 Quorum:

The meeting was attended in person/proxy/authorised representative by 47 (Forty-Seven) Trade creditors of Incor Hopsitals Private Limited having their total outstanding unsecured liabilities amounting to INR 3,07,32,937/- as on 31.03.2022.

### 2.3 E-voting at the Meeting:

- Based on the quorum present at the meeting, the identity and/or authorization
  of the Trade creditors who attended the meeting were verified against the
  records available with Incoe Hospitals Private Limited.
- After the announcement was made by the Chairperson appointed for the Meeting, trade creditors and proxies and authorised representatives present at the Meeting voted through electronic means on the facility provided by CDSL.
