

Average Daily Adult Custody Population by Centre and by Indigenous Status, 2017-18

Centres

Edmonton Remand Centre (ERC), Fort Saskatchewan Correctional Centre (FSCC), Peace River Correctional Centre (PRCC), Calgary Correctional Centre (CCC), Calgary Remand Centre (CRC), Lethbridge Correctional Centre (LCC), Medicine Hat Remand Centre (MHRC), Red Deer Remand Centre (RDRC)

Findings

- The average daily adult indigenous inmate population represented 40.3% of the total adult custody population in 2017-18.
- The Edmonton Remand Centre had the largest indigenous population. However, in 2017-18, the proportion of indigenous inmates was highest at the Peace River Correctional Centre (55.8%) compared to 45.9% at the Edmonton Remand Centre.

Definitions

In-House Population: Inmates in a provincial correctional facility including inmates temporarily in hospital, out to court or in transit to another Alberta provincial correctional facility. In-house (centres only) population does not include inmates under correctional supervision, but either out on temporary absence programs, in mental health hospitals, in police cells, on provincial parole; or intermittent servers on non-reporting days.
