# Capiunto

- "they shall contain"
- Extension to Scribunto providing basic infobox functionality.
- Consistent and portable Infoboxes
- Easy to use interface for assembling infoboxes.

# Convenient for standard use cases

- Current Lua interface:
  - `capiunto:addSubHeader`
  - `capiunto:addImage`
  - `capiunto:addRow`
  - `capiunto:addHeader`
  - `capiunto:addWikitext`
  - Many formatting options

# Decoupling from page content

- Separate schema definitions (Wiki-wide)
  - Schema defines possible data fields
  - Schema (possibly) defines allowed value types
  - Schema defines how to get data from Wikidata
- Separated data definition (tied to the page)
  - Possibility to store data in the Wiki
    - Overrides Wikibase-Data
- Restricted Lua modules for data formatting
  - Lua module to use is defined in the schema
  - Lua module must not alter or add data
  - Lua modules don't have access to data from the outside

# Implementation sketch
