Cabin & Camping Regulations

- . Check-Out Time: 11:00 AM
- Park gates open at 8:00 AM and close around sunset.
- The entrance gate is provided for your security. Only registered guests are allowed in the park after closing hours. Allowing anyone else into the park after closing will result in your immediate expulsion.
- Quiet hours are enforced 10:00 PM until 6:00 AM.
- Minors (under 18 years of age) must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Only one camping unit is allowed per site. A camping permit is required before setting up camp.
- Tents or RVs should immediately occupy the assigned campsite after registration is completed.
- Maximum occupancy for improved sites is 8 persons and two motor vehicles. Maximum occupancy for primitive sites is 4 persons and one motor vehicle.
- Maximum occupancy for small cabins is 4 people and two motor vehicles. Maximum occupancy for large cabins is 6 people and two motor vehicles.

- Campers must provide their own camping equipment suitable for the locations; all equipment is subject to the Park Management's approval.
- Fires permitted in grills and fire pits at cabins and campgrounds so long as the park is not under a burn warning.
- · All motor vehicles must have valid license plates and be operated by a licensed driver. Vehicles can only be operated on established roadways designated for their specific use.
- All campsite trash must be deposited in the dumpsters **NOT** in the bathhouse or other facility trash receptacles within the park.
- You must use a suitable holding fixture for all waste water and dispose of it properly. Drainage of water, soap, grease or any other waste product onto the ground or into anything other than an approved holding tank or the sewage receptacles and dump stations provided is a violation of Alabama state law.
- Pets must be kept on a leash. They are not allowed in the cabin area unless you have a pet friendly cabin and have paid the pet fee.
- Complete Alabama State Park Rules and Regulations are posted in conspicuous locations within each Alabama State Park.


