REMOVAL PROCESS:

STEP 1: DRAINAGE

The entire pool is drained of its water using the pump that was installed when the swimming pool was built

STEP 2: TOP LAYER REMOVAL

The top of the pool, including the surrounding concrete, are destroyed and multiple 3-inch holes are drilled for future rainwater drainage

STEP 3: DEMOLITION

The rest of the pool material is demolished and the debris will either be used to fill up the swimming pool or be cleared and hauled

STEP 4: FILLING

The pool area is completely filled with fill dirt and the layer above is filled with topsoil, allowing grass to regrow

PREPARATION CHECKLIST:

DRAINING

Drain as much water from the pool that you can before the pool removal contractors are able to drain all of it

ACCESSORIES

Remove any accessories from the pool area such as a step ladder, diving board, or pool lights to ensure a smooth removal






POOL COPING

If possible, take out any of the coping that is removable from the pool so that the demolition process is easier

BUYING SOD

Purchase enough sod to install after the pool is completely filled with dirt and enough topsoil to support new grass
