

GENDER PAY GAP REPORT 2018

We are proud to confirm a 14.4% improvement in our mean gender pay gap from last year.



At Sykes we are striving to improve every aspect of our employee experience, as a fast growing and dynamic business we are constantly reviewing our processes and approaches to attracting the right talent into our business, Our approach is intended to ensure that employees are paid fairly, regardless of personal characteristics. There are several factors that affect pay and result in remuneration differences including job grades, seniority within grades and performance levels. We evaluate all of our job roles irrespective of gender as part of our job grading development. Our salary and promotion proposals are independently reviewed with HR and senior management.

Gender split by role

In common with other companies with high investment in technology and web services, our gender pay gap is primarily due to a lower proportion of female employees in these roles and at a senior level.
