From the outdoor courtyards that surround Pasadena City Hall, to the legendary Rose Bowl Stadium, the historic Castle Green, or Albert Einstein's inspired Athenaeum at Caltech, there's a venue option for everyone.





A LOCAL SCENE WITH GLOBAL OFFERINGS

Choosing Pasadena for your meeting or convention is smart for many reasons. Described as “a shiny jewel of Southern California” by the New York Times, Pasadena thrives with four distinct neighborhoods.

The city’s pedestrian-friendly streets and efficient public transportation options virtually eliminate the need for a car. The proximity of its offerings allows visitors to experience its quaint streets and alleys, while enjoying its vibrant cultural hotspots.

The city’s hotels offer well-appointed meeting spaces and amenities. With many located along the famous Rose Parade route, these hotels take guest experience seriously and offer accommodations tailored to savvy business travelers.

SOUTH LAKE DISTRICT

South Lake Avenue District has taken on the motto “Shop. Dine. Live.” and with good reason. It’s a shopping and dining district that flaunts a stylish approach to happy living. The charming, 10-block area with mid-century and European flair is home to designer shops, artisanal boutiques, outdoor bistros and spas.

OLD PASADENA

Pasadena’s 19th century origins can still be seen in what was once the city’s original marketplace and oldest commercial area, Old Pasadena. Referred to by locals simply as Old Town, the neighborhood is a model of historic preservation and civic revitalization. The 22 blocks of Old Pasadena were designated a National Register Historic District in 1983 and contain restored examples of late 19th and early 20th century architecture, which are now home to more than 200 shops and 100 dining establishments.



CIVIC CENTER DISTRICT

The Civic Center District, between Old Pasadena and Playhouse Village, is home to beautifully designed buildings reflecting the Beaux-Arts and Mediterranean Revival era. History still resonates here with landmark buildings including the Pasadena Central Library, Pasadena Civic Auditorium, and City Hall. The Civic Center District is also home to The Paseo, a retail and shopping promenade featuring contemporary dining, specialty shops and more.

PLAYHOUSE VILLAGE

The tree-lined and bohemian-centric Playhouse Village is home to the Pasadena Playhouse, the official State Theatre of California. With festivals like Pasadena ARTWalk, as well as local crafts and specialty shops, the entire neighborhood is practically an open-air museum. The visually engaging neighborhood is a feast for the eyes thanks to a large number of public art installations like utility box art, street art, spun chairs and painted crosswalk designs.

GROUP ACTIVITIES

From architectural tours to fabulous food tastings, Pasadena offers a variety of unique experiences for your attendees or their spouses and partners.

ART & CULTURE



ARCHITECTURE

California Institute of Technology (Caltech) Tour the historic halls of one of the world’s most widely recognized institutions for the study of science and engineering. Architectural tours of the 124-acre campus start at the Athenaeum at 551 S. Hill. Please call for up-to-date information and reservations.

City Hall This exquisite 1927 landmark exhibits Italian Renaissance and Spanish influences with its red tile roof, ornate fountain and lush garden courtyard.

The Gamble House Built in 1908 during the American Arts and Crafts movement, this masterpiece is the best-preserved example of work from internationally recognized architects Charles and Henry Greene. The home is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals The Court is now housed in the original Vista del Arroyo Hotel, built in 1903. Tours are by appointment only.

Tournament House and Wrigley Gardens

This ornate mansion, once owned by chewing gum manufacturer William Wrigley, Jr., was built between 1908 and 1914, and today serves as the headquarters for the Pasadena Tournament of Roses® Association. Please call for tour information and reservations.

ART MUSEUMS

Armory Center for the Arts

The Armory offers exhibitions, performances, and art workshops and classes for children and adults.

The Huntington Library, Art Collections, and Botanical Gardens

The library features works from British and American history and literature, including an original Gutenberg Bible

and Chaucer’s “*Canterbury Tales*.” Three art galleries showcase 18th and 19th century European masterpieces, including Thomas Lawrence’s “Pinkie.”

Kidspace Children’s Museum

Kidspace Children’s Museum sparks creativity and imagination with interactive environments in the natural sciences, exhibits, art programs, climbing towers, and acres of gardens with a running stream. Located in Brookside Park adjacent to the Rose Bowl, Kidspace is an oasis for children and families.

Norton Simon Museum View seven centuries of European art, from the Renaissance to the 20th century, including works by Van Gogh, Picasso, Rembrandt and Fragonard. The museum also houses an extensive collection of South Asian sculptures and a sculpture garden featuring the works of Rodin.

Pasadena Museum of History Near the Gamble House is the Pasadena Museum of History, the Finnish Folk Art Museum, and the 18-room Fenyes Estate, circa 1905, which contains its original furnishings and paintings.

USC Pacific Asia Museum Housed in the historic Grace Nicholson mansion, the museum is dedicated to the preservation, promotion, and understanding of the arts and culture of Asia and the Pacific. The museum is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

GARDENS

Descanso Gardens Located on 160 acres, Descanso Gardens features forests, streams, a lake, and a bird sanctuary, and is highlighted by 80 acres of colorful flowers, including camellias, lilacs, and roses.

The Huntington Library, Art Collections, and Botanical Gardens The Huntington is an oasis of art and culture set amid 120 acres of breathtaking gardens. More than a dozen gardens feature 14,000 species of plants.

Los Angeles County Arboretum & Botanic Garden This 127-acre horticultural and botanical center features plants from around the world, native and migrating birds, wildlife, colorful peacocks and historic buildings, including the Queen Anne Cottage made famous on Fantasy Island.

Wrigley Gardens The Centennial Rose Garden at the Tournament House features 1,500 varieties of roses, camellias and annuals.

PERFORMING ARTS

A Noise Within One of the few theaters in Southern California producing works of world drama in a rotating repertory with a company of professional, classically trained artists.

Beckman & Ramo Auditoriums Year-round events, performances, lectures, storytelling, films and concerts in the historic venues of the California Institute of Technology.

Boston Court Performing Arts Center Two state-of-the-art theaters—an intimate 99-seat theater and a 60-seat performance space—are the stages for diverse programming from concerts to world premieres, or a twist on a classic Shakespearean play.

Ice House Comedy Club Experience a night of laughs brought to you by headlining comedic talent.

Lineage Dance Contemporary dance company presenting performances, classes and workshops throughout the year as well as an annual dance festival.

Pasadena Civic Auditorium The renowned 3,000-seat theater, dedicated in 1932, is on the National Register of Historic Places and home to year-round concerts and other entertainment events.

Pasadena Playhouse Anchoring the Playhouse District and built in 1917, the Playhouse is the Official State Theatre of California and a National Historic Landmark, and features Tony and Pulitzer award-winning plays.

Pasadena Symphony and POPS Pop, symphonic, and youth orchestra performances by the Pasadena Symphony are offered October–May at the Ambassador Auditorium and an outdoor summer series by the Pasadena Pops at the Los Angeles Arboretum and Botanic Gardens.

MORE TO SEE

Mount Wilson Observatory Overlooking Pasadena from atop the Angeles National Forest, Mount Wilson Observatory is a world-class astronomical research facility. Founded in 1904, it is home to the 100-inch Hooker telescope and the world's most powerful optical telescope array.

Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL) JPL is the world-renowned research, development and flight center for NASA. Tours of the facility are by appointment only and arrangements must be made well in advance.
