HOW TO PREPARE

Will you host a virtual event or do the activities at home with your family? How many people will be participating?

If you are doing the activities at home with your family, review the included activities and collect all the materials you'll need—like paper, pencils, and crafting supplies.

If you'll be hosting a virtual event, choose from one of the provided Zoom backgrounds to help set the mood. Be sure to perform a test run of your virtual event ahead of time to address any technical or logistical issues. Look through this kit and decide which activities you'll use at your virtual event and which ones will be offered as downloadables for kids to enjoy later.

HOSTING TIP: We suggest starting your event with an icebreaker activity. Included are two crowd-pleasers to get your party started! The Professor Poopypants's Name Change-O-Chart 2000 activity can be easily adapted for use at virtual parties. Share it with guests ahead of time and have them change their real screen name to their new Professor Poopypants name for the virtual event.

ICEBREAKER ACTIVITIES

WHO AM I?

HOST INSTRUCTIONS

FOR VIRTUAL EVENTS

1. Print out one set of the WHO AM I? name cards for the host. The virtual party host is the only one who has the cards.
2. The guesser closes their eyes, and the host shows the card to the other players.
3. Every virtual party guest, one at a time, gives a one-word clue to the guesser.
4. The guesser can guess after any clue, and can offer a final guess after all clues are given. If they get it right, move on to the next guesser. Play as many rounds as needed.

FOR IN-PERSON PLAY

1. Print out one set of the WHO AM I? name cards and cut them out. (Note: If you need more name cards, reuse some of the names or use your own paper to create additional Dog Man or Captain Underpants character name cards.)
2. Use tape to attach a nametag to each participant's back, ensuring that no one sees their own nametag.
3. Explain the rules.

Rules

- Which Dog Man or Captain Underpants character are you? It's up to you to find out! One at a time, each player will ask the group a series of yes-or-no questions (for example, "Am I a reporter?" or "Do I have a tail?") to help them guess the name on their nametag.
- When a player thinks they know the answer, they can make a guess. If their guess is correct, move on to the next player. Play as many rounds as needed.

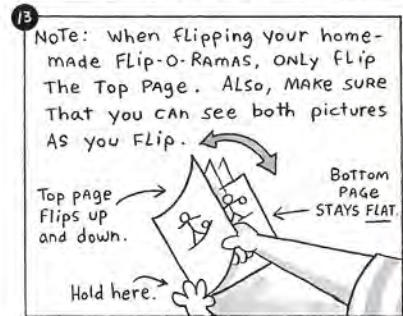

MUNCHY The LUNCH BAG

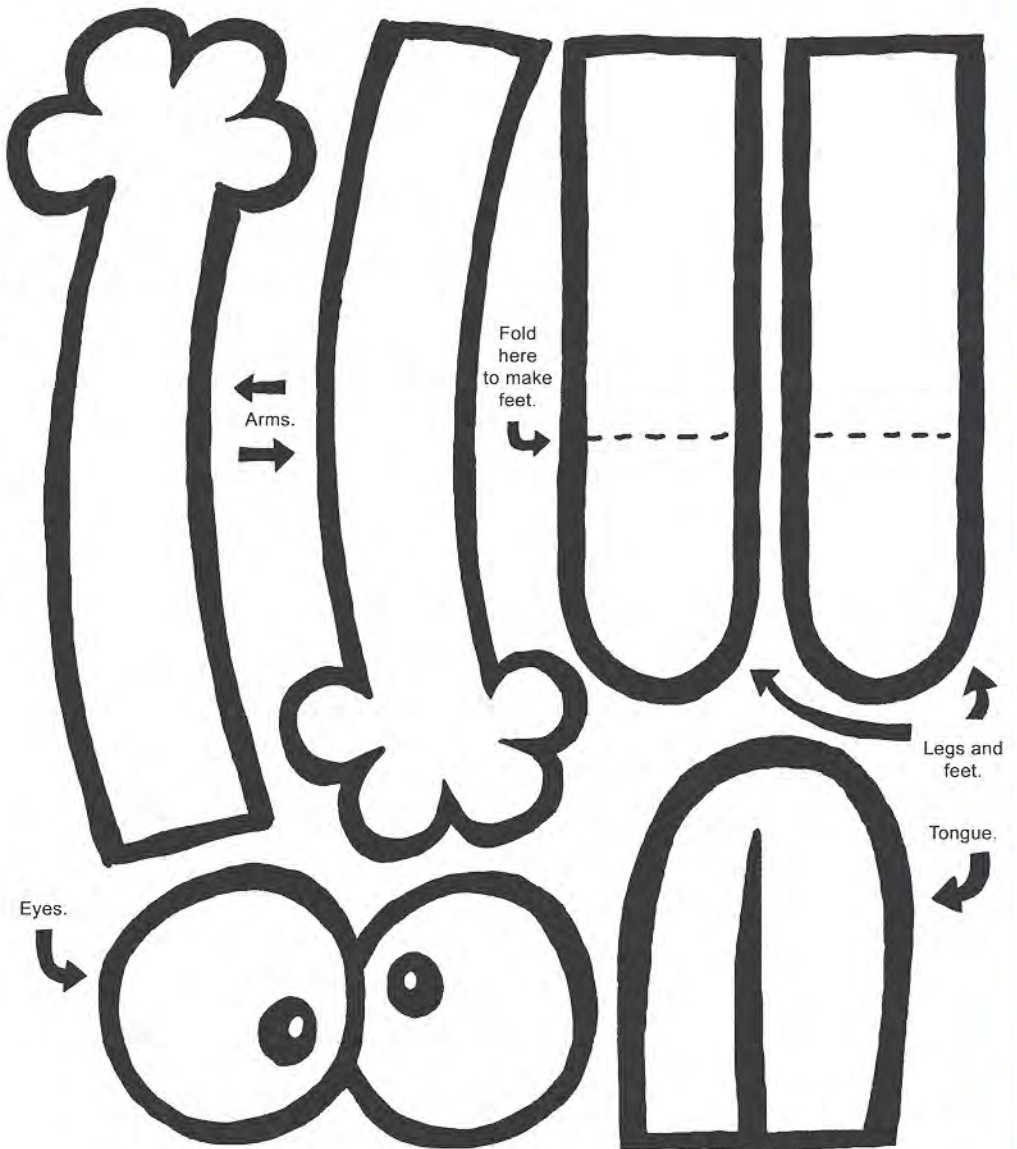
in 4 Ridiculously easy steps!

DOG MAN READERS' THEATER

Get ready to ham it up with Dog Man Readers' Theater! First, choose a scene. Use one that's provided below or find a different chapter or passage from your favorite Dog Man book. The Dog Man books are full of great multiple-character scenes to choose from.

INSTRUCTIONS

FOR VIRTUAL EVENTS

1. Provide downloadable copies of the script and assign roles ahead of time. You can also share your screen for a live view of the script.
2. Suggest to performers that they use a highlighter to keep track of their lines.
3. Encourage virtual guests to dress in costume for their role, use props, and create their own scenery for their backdrop.

FOR IN-PERSON PLAY

1. Make copies of your scene ahead of time.
2. Have everyone take a look at the illustrations in the book you will be reading so everyone understands the context.
3. Set up a stage and seating area.
4. Have highlighters available so that performers can keep track of their lines.
5. Provide costumes and props so that performers can really get into character.
6. Remind everyone to read with expression, use different voices, and to have fun!

PIGGY: So, you've returned. Are you ready to tell us your final word?

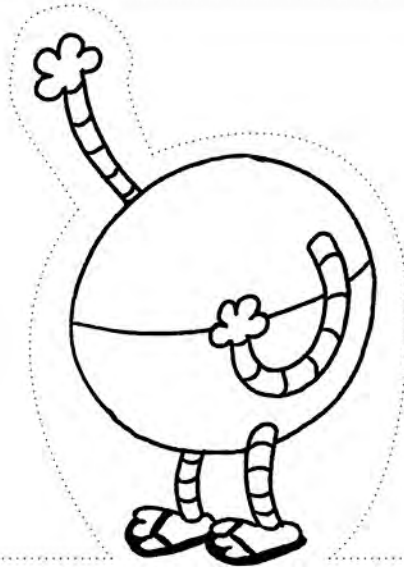
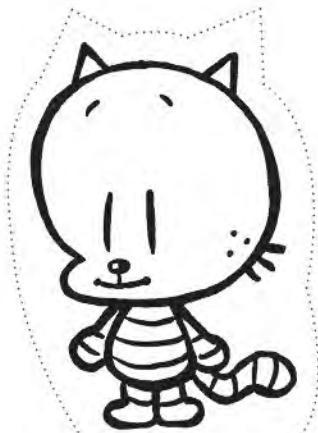
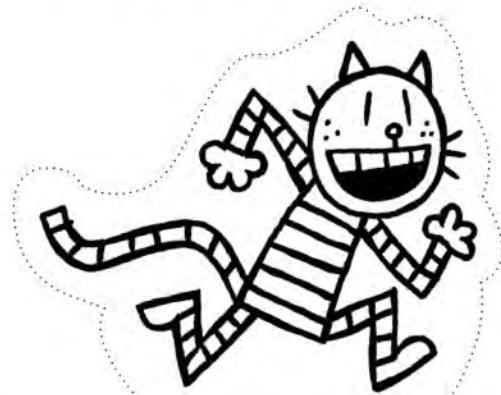
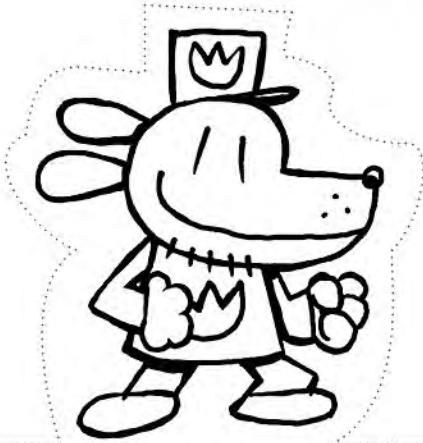
