The SHSM also assists students in their transition from secondary school to apprenticeship training, college, university or the workplace

RED SEAL

Successful completion of a SHSM is indicated on the student's Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) by a Red Seal



TRANSCRIPT



Successful completion of a SHSM is indicated on the student's Ontario Student Transcript (OST), where it may be seen by any post-secondary institution or training organization.

SHSM RECORD

Students receive a SHSM Record that documents their achievement of the required components including sector-related certifications earned and/or training courses completed



EXPERIENCE



Students gain valuable experience and certifications, which increase confidence in their ability to succeed and see the connections between their studies, the world beyond high school and future careers.

OPPORTUNITY
