Votes by your state legislators on key small business issues are listed here. Although this Voting Record does not reflect all elements considered by a lawmaker when voting, nor does it represent a complete profile of a legislator, it can be a guide in evaluating your legislator's attitudes toward small business. Please thank those legislators who supported small business.

SENATE ONLY

- 1. Minimum Wage (2024 - SB 308):** Legislation to prevent raising the state hourly minimum wage. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed in the Senate 14-10.
- 2. Liability Insurance (2024 - SB 462):** This bill would raise liability insurance premiums for small businesses. **A "NO" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 17-7.
- 3. Unemployment Compensation (2024 - SB 436):** Legislation to halt increases to minimum and maximum weekly unemployment insurance benefit amounts. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 13-10.
- 4. Payment to Employees (2023 - SB 46):** A legislative attempt to prohibit employers from paying their workers using debit cards. **A "NO" vote supports the NFIB position.** Failed in the Senate 10-14.
- 5. Interest and Dividends Tax (2023 - SB 261):** Legislation to keep the repeal of the interest and dividends tax in place, preventing reinstatement of the tax. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** The bill passed in the Senate 13-10.

A "NO" vote supports the NFIB position. The House passed the bill 198-183.

8. Minimum Wage (2024 - HB 1322): This bill would have increased the State's minimum wage. **A "NO" vote supports the NFIB position.** Failed in the House 187-192.

9. Hotel Room Tax (2024 - HB 1254): A vote to take no further action on allowing municipalities the authority to assess a local option tax on hotel rooms. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** The bill passed the House 195-171.

10. Youth Labor Laws (2023 - HB 125): Restrict the number of hours that 16 and 17-year-olds can work in a week. **A "NO" vote supports the NFIB position.** Failed in the House 175-195.

HOUSE ONLY

- 6. Right to Join a Union (2024 - HB 1377):** Proposal to take no action on whether workers have a choice to join or refrain from joining a labor union. **A "NO" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed in the House 212-168.
- 7. Unused Earned Time (2024 - HB 1178):** Requires employers to pay out an employee's unused earned time even if that employee was terminated for cause.
