That was followed up by the gorgeous Sun Parasol Giant Peach Sunrise. Now we have five new introductions that made a splash at the Tropical Plant International Expo (TPIE) in Ft. Lauderdale, FL. Two won Favorite New Flowering Plant and three won the Garden Center Group's Cool Product Award.

Three new varieties join Sunbeam in creating the Sun Parasol Original XP class for outstanding flower power and performance. Bluephoria, our first blue, is getting a groovy, psychedelic brand launch. Two more have been very well received in Europe – Mauvelous (Sundaville Flamingo Pink) and Double Pink Blush (Sundaville Double Blush Pink), a FleuroStar winner.
