



Touchscreen Cleaning Procedure

The touchscreen manufacturer recommends using the following disinfectants to clean the touchscreen:

- 1:100 household bleach/water solution
- Isopropyl alcohol ($\leq 75\%$)

NOTE: Always power down device before cleaning touchscreen.

- Wet a clean, new, non-abrasive cloth and squeeze out any excess liquid.
- Apply cleaning agent/disinfectant liberally to the cloth. (Never apply disinfectant directly to the touchscreen.)
- Using the cloth in a Z-motion, wipe down the touchscreen. Make sure to wipe the entire surface of the screen.
- Use a dry cloth to dry the panel completely. Do not leave any cleaning solution or residue on the panel for more than 2 minutes or the screen may be damaged.



Do not use any of the following materials to clean or disinfect the touchscreen:

- Abrasive cleaners or detergents
- Detergents with fluoride
- Detergents with > 1.6% ammonia
- Methyl or ethyl alcohol > 35%
- Isopropyl alcohol > 75%
- Thinner / benzene
- Strong lye
- Strong solvents
- Acids
- Formula 409
- Steel wool
- Abrasive sponges
- Steel blades
- Cloth with steel threads

Do not mix bleach and ammonia. This will produce a dangerous chemical reaction.
