- Lights and Decorations (display and placement);
- Special Effects (sound effects, animation, etc.);
- Overall Appearance (effort & attractiveness).

Judging Period:

Judging night will take place on Sunday, December 13th between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. Depending on the number of entries, judging may continue from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Monday 12/14/2020. The Taylor Mill Commission and volunteer judges will meet at the City of Taylor Mill parking lot at 6:00 pm, and enjoy a ride around the neighborhood to see this year's contenders.

The contest is open to all residents within the City of Taylor Mill. Entry deadline: December 9th at 5:00pm.


