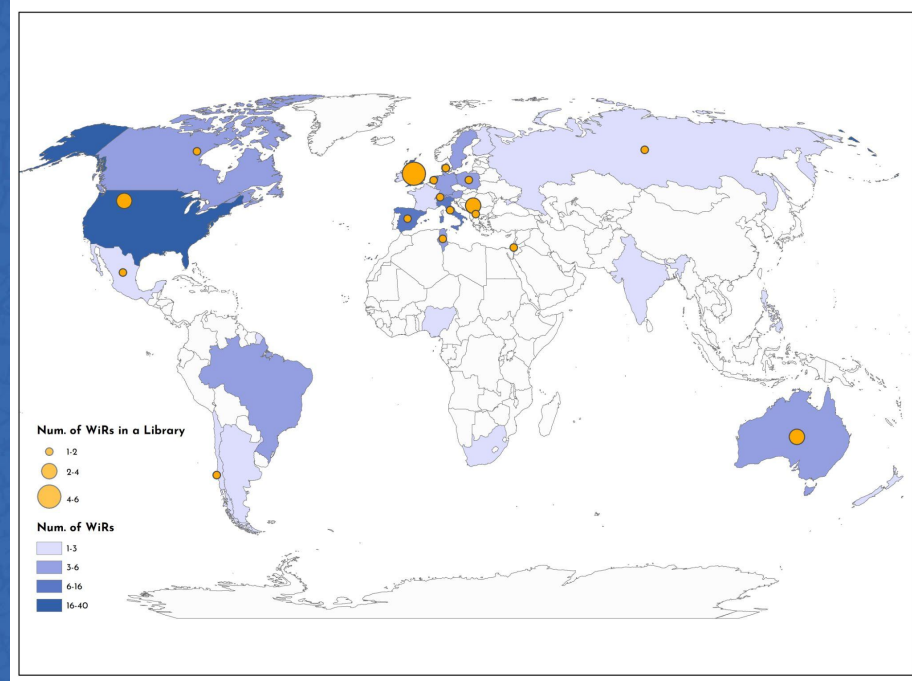

WIKIBRARIANS GATHERING MOMENTUM

The Wikipedia and Libraries information evenings presented by ALIA in partnership with Wikimedia Australia in late 2014 attracted 360 participants to nine presentations around the nation, and have already led to new collaborative projects, including a new Wikipedia editing assignment for undergraduate students at the University of Notre Dame Australia in Western Australia.



WIKIBASE IN NIGERIAN LIBRARIES
(PROMOTING LINKED OPEN DATA IN NIGERIAN LIBRARIES)

The project aims to build a knowledge base of linked open data in Nigerian libraries, to help shape the decentralization of knowledge graph, through the creation, connection, and growth of a collaborative knowledge base in Nigeria.

MAIN OUTCOMES

- Support Nigerian librarians to create Wikibase.cloud user accounts and set up Wikibase instances.
- Link bibliographic records from selected Nigerian libraries to Wikibase instances.
- Train at least 30 Nigerian librarians to work in a Wikidata/Wikibase Environment.

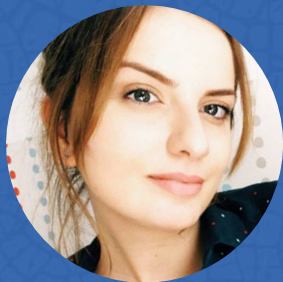
Memorandum between the Czech National Library and Wikimedia CZ

The General Director of the National Library, **Tomáš Foltýn**, pointed out that we are in a data war and that it is the duty of the National Library and other cultural institutions to share as much relevant data as possible with the public. He highlighted the importance of cooperation with Wikidata and described the fact that today he officially signed the memorandum in the presence of a representative of the Ministry of Culture, a member of the European Parliament and members of Wikimedia Europe as something extraordinary. He thanked the WMCZ staff and volunteers involved in the cooperation with the NL and his team at the NL.

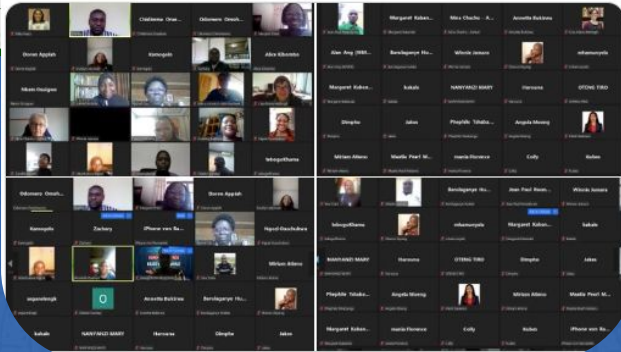

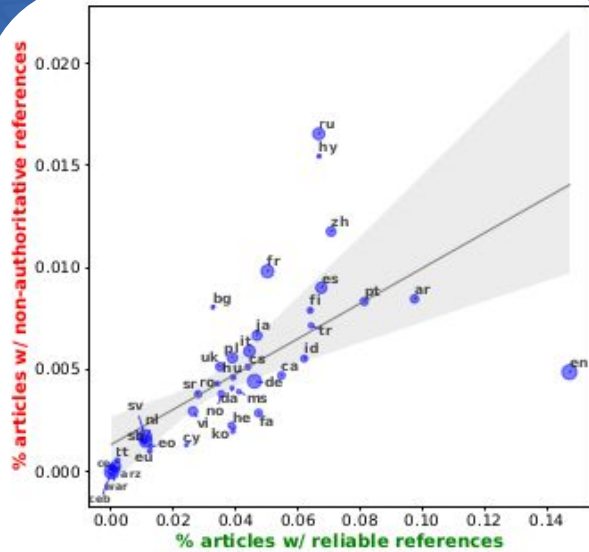


Figure 1: The proportion of articles referencing generally reliable and deprecated / blacklisted sources from the English Wikipedia *perennial source* list for the top 40 language editions by the number of articles. The size of a circle represents the number of unique articles in that edition. The shaded area shows a 90% confidence interval. Languages can be mapped from the Wikipedia code using this list.¹

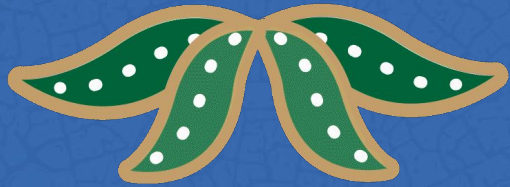

The #1Lib1Ref campaign invites us –open knowledge enthusiasts, Wikimedians, book lovers, and library workers– to collaborate on verifying, increasing, and diversifying references on Wikipedia.

The campaign happens twice a year (January and May), and at the end of this post, we will tell you more about the second round. However, let's engage on a celebratory trip for this campaign's seventh birthday in January, by giving our traditional statistics a twist to travel the #1Lib1Ref globe in ten stops:

Serbian

Let's start with our contributions-champions in Serbia, which celebrated the end of the campaign with 38 editors who edited 5,461 articles and added 12,659 references! We also love to note that the three top editors are a dedicated pedagogy student, a brilliant librarian, and a member of Serbia's Senior Citizen project. O [Wiki Movimento Brasil \(WMB\)](#) criou este comitê estratégico no início do ano de 2023, para ampliar e melhorar sua atuação em termos de [parcerias GLAM](#) com bibliotecárias e bibliotecários em território brasileiro.

Ocorrerão reuniões periódicas, bimestrais ou trimestrais, com a participação dos membros do comitê e da equipe do WMB. Esses encontros serão importantes espaços de troca e de orientação, onde apresentaremos os planos e as realizações do WMB em relação à maior integração da Wikimedia nas redes e práticas de bibliotecárias e bibliotecários no Brasil, com especial interesse no Wikidata. As reuniões fechadas serão em português / inglês, com tradução simultânea entre os idiomas.

Bibliotecas no Brasil

Dados publicados pela [BBC Brasil](#) em 16 julho 2022 indicam que, no período de 5 anos (entre 2015 e 2020), o número de bibliotecas públicas no Brasil passou de 6.057 para 5.293 (uma redução de 12.61%). A região mais afetada foi a Sudeste, com o fechamento de 683 instituições.
