

# SHEFFIELD

Community Place Initiatives

This map shows the Sheffield place-based initiatives, groups and organisations that were recorded as part of the Urban Education Live research project (2017-2021), funded by the ESRC and EU Horizon 2020 JPI-Urban

Researchers and students from Sheffield School of Architecture worked with teams from Finland, Romania and Slovenia to develop and test new models of collaboration between universities, urban communities, NGOs and public bodies. A key strand of the research in Sheffield was to map the community place initiatives in the city many of whom we had already worked with through our Live Projects programme. This mapping expanded our knowledge of the network of place-based groups in the city. We then worked with many of them further, through focus groups and interviews, to understand the main challenges they face and to explore how the University could support them to do more for their communities and
