On 8/31/2018 I was assigned to squad and call sign 123 P# 76746 with my partner Officer HERNANDEZ #2925. At approximately 2136 hours we responded to a Criminal Sexual Conduct report at the Carlson School of Management at the University of Minnesota at 321 19 Av S.

Upon arrival, we met with the reporting party MANDY XUE. XUE said that she is a program director for Carlson School of Management and was looking after an international student from China, who was the victim of criminal sexual conduct. The victim was [REDACTED], who was positively identified via her Chinese passport.

I spoke to [REDACTED], who had a slight language barrier and understanding with me. [REDACTED] said that she went to a party, related to school, at the Origami in uptown on 8/30/2018 at 1830 hours. She originally went to the party with a friend but was separated by the arrestee's secretaries. The secretaries sat her next to the arrestee, who is QIANGDONG LIU, and throughout the night she drank with everyone at the party and became drunk. She said that she thought something bad was going to happen to her because they had separated her from her friend but did not think much of it because QIANGDONG was a famous wealthy individual from China. QIANGDONG had flown from China and was suppose to leave Minnesota back to China on 9/1/2018. QIANGDONG was also drunk.

[REDACTED] said after she became intoxicated, the secretaries arranged a ride for her with QIANGDONG. They escorted her to a vehicle, which was occupied by 4 other individuals, one of them was QIANGDONG. They drove her to a hotel, which was an unknown location for [REDACTED]. QIANGDONG asked [REDACTED] multiple times to go into the hotel with him. [REDACTED] repeatedly told QIANGDONG that she did not want to go into the hotel and that she knew he was married and it would be wrong for her to go inside. QIANGDONG repeatedly asked her to go inside again and [REDACTED] told him that she wanted to go home. QIANGDONG agreed to take her home and drove her back to her apartment at [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] said that when they arrived inside her apartment, QIANGDONG began hugging her and kissing her on her neck and face. At this point, [REDACTED] thought that QIANGDONG was going to rape her so she attempted to push him back multiple times. QIANGDONG continued to try to kiss her so she told him that they could talk about him staying calm.



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██████████ said that they walked into her bedroom and she sat down on the bed with QIANGDONG. She told QIANGDONG to calm down and that she did not want to do anything with him because he was married. QIANGDONG began kissing her again on her neck and face, and then took off her shirt. She said he attempted to take her bra off and she pushed him away. She continuously told him to calm down and that she did not want to do anything with him. Finally he promised her that he would not touch her anymore. She told him go take a shower and he went into the bathroom. When he went into the bathroom, ██████████ put back on her shirt.

██████████ said that QIANGDONG pulled her into the bathroom and asked her to shower with him. She refused and attempted to get out of the bathroom. He pulled her shirt off once again. She attempted to get out of the bathroom once again and he pulled off her bra. She kept telling him to calm down. QIANGDONG finally let her leave the bathroom and she went back into her room. Her clothes was wet because the showers was running as QIANGDONG was trying to pull her into the showers. She decided to change into a green one piece. Afterwards ██████████ went and sat down on a chair in the living room.

██████████ said that QIANGDONG finished his shower and came out of the bathroom naked. He came from behind her and hugged her. While hugging her, he pulled her into the bedroom and tossed her onto the bed. She said he took off her underwear and threw it onto the ground. ██████████ began to remind him that he promised not to touch her but he ignored her. ██████████ said he raped her by penetrating her vaginally with his penis and he pinned her down by both her shoulders with his hands. ██████████ said that as the assault was happening she told him not to ejaculate inside of her because she did not want to become pregnant. QIANGDONG ejaculated on the bed sheets. After the ejaculation, he fell asleep on her bed.

██████████ said after the assault, at approximately 0239 hours on 8/31/2018, ██████████ contacted one of her friends and told them she was raped by QIANGDONG. QIANGDONG was still sleeping in her bed at the time. ██████████ friend contact 911 and officers came out to the scene. Officers detained QIANGDONG. ██████████ said that she was afraid of what might happen to her and told officers that nothing happened. She said that she wanted to find evidence first before presenting anything to officers. QIANGDONG was transported a (This call was 18-293415)

██████████ said that she searched her room and found the area where QIANGDONG had ejaculated on her bed sheet. She took her underwear and the bed sheet to Fairview Hospital at 1500 hours on 8/31/2018 and took a SARS exam. She said that the hospital took her clothing and the bed sheet and gave her a copy of the exam. Afterwards, ██████████ went to her program director XUE and explained what happened.

██████████ said that she was afraid of QIANGDONG throughout the night. She also said that she was afraid for her family and what might happen to her in light of the assault. ██████████ said that, before QIANGDONG was naked, he was



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wearing all black with blue jeans. He had a brown belt and black socks and underwear on.

As I was ending the interview with [REDACTED], she received a phone call from QIANGDONG's secretary. The secretary told her that QIANGDONG was coming to meet her. I called Sgt JOSEPH #3579, and received PC for his arrest. QIANGDONG arrived to our location and we arrested him for Criminal Sexual Conduct. We searched him and placed him into our squad. [REDACTED] completed a medical release form, which was property inventoried, and we transported QIANGDONG to HCJ. QIANGDONG was booked into HCJ for CSCR.

[REDACTED] received a blue card and I took photos of her copy of the SARS exam and later uploaded them to evidence.com.

BWC was active.

On today's date in relation to this case, I traveled to the Cedar Riverside Hospital where I collected a sexual assault examination kit (SAE Kit). This kit had a unique identifying code attached to it that was identified as: [REDACTED]. In comparing the sexual assault kit with this unique identifier to the records maintained by the Hennepin County SARS Office, I was able to identify a known victim that was attached to this report and identified as V1. This unique identifier is given to SAE kits that are collected but the victim has not yet reported the crime to police.

While at the hospital, I collected five items related to this examination. These items were listed as a sexual assault collection kit, biological specimens kit also known as a blood kit, a urine specimen kit, a sealed bag containing white underwear and another sealed bag containing bed sheets.

These items were transported by me to the Minneapolis Police Department Property and Evidence room where they were property inventoried under this case number, to be held as evidence.

Also on this day, I collected a sexual assault examination paper report from the Hennepin County SARS Office. This report was also property inventoried and a copy was made and provided to the case investigator, Sgt. Matthew Wentz.

Q. This is Sgt. MATT WENTE of the Minneapolis Police Department, badge 7640. The date is September 10, 2018, the time is 1130 hours. I'm at 7760 France Avenue S uh, with the victim in this case, [REDACTED]. Um, present with me is her, are her attorneys, I'm going to ask them to identify themselves for the record.

A. Uh, WILL FLOREN and CHAD FLOREN from FLOREN RODIG in Palm Harbor, FL.

A. HAILEY LIU and JANE HAN from HAN ASSOCIATES in New York

A. She didn't mention my name, (Inaudible) from HAN ASSOCIATES

Q. Okay, alright and [REDACTED], will you please state your name and date of birth for me, please?

A. I'm [REDACTED], I was born in [REDACTED]

Q. Alright. And for the course of our interview, you've asked me to refer to you as [REDACTED], is that true?

A. Yeah

Q. Alright, so um, and you and I last spoke last Saturday didn't we, on September 1st?

A. Yeah

Q. Alright, so you do know who I am, alright. We'll be referencing Minneapolis CCN 18-294338. Alright, and [REDACTED], I'll just ask right now for you to start where you would like to start with the events of that, or the, of, about this incident, and just tell me what happened, alright?

A. Yeah. Um, um, I was at CARLSON SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT um, that day um, it's on August the 29th, um, in the afternoon around 4 pm, and I was at the front desk with two other female staffs, one is CLAUDIA and the other is PAN, the last name is um, you can call her P-A-N

Q. Okay

A. And then um, CEO YAO, he came to me and he asked me whether I want to go dinner with him or not

Q. Okay

A. And he asked me face to face. I know his company and he's very famous, but I'm wondering why he's asking me, but instead of other students. So um, I um, and he uh, he, he wanted to, he wanted to like, have my contact, I mean, he wanted to have my WeChat, but I told him I had the WeChat of his um, assistant, or his secretary, QUEENA



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Q. QU, QUEEN?

A. QUEENA

Q. QUEENA, how would I spell that?

A. Q-U-E-E-N-A

Q. Okay

A. And finally he told QUEENA to, like, and he told me that QUEENA's gonna contact me. And, and then I talked to my friends, like I talked to [REDACTED], I talked to [REDACTED], I talked to CLAUDIA, and I talked to PAN and DONGTING, or um, you can spell it like, D-O-N-G-T-O, uh, T-I-N-G.

Q. Okay

A. And um, I was scared 'cause I've never been to, I've never like, I, I'm confused 'cause I'm wondering why they're, why they, why they're like, inviting me to go to dinner...

Q. Okay

A. ...together, so uh, I just ask whether PAN wants to go with me, but she told me that she has paper to do, 'cause, 'cause she is completing her Master's Degree in CARLSON SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT and I also asked DONGTING and she told me that she could go with me and then I asked QUEENA and QUEENA, she told me that she is not familiar with DONGTING so what she means is that I can't bring DONGTING with me. And then I asked [REDACTED], um, and, [REDACTED], he first, he first told me that he was, he might have something to do and she'll think about it and then I asked [REDACTED], [REDACTED], he told me that he had to go to the um, football game that night, um, like, and then I asked [REDACTED] again and that, and then I asked QUEENA whether [REDACTED], whether I can bring [REDACTED] with me or not. She told me that, "Okay, you can bring [REDACTED]." Like, she, she did not say yes, but instead he told me that um, she is okay with, she is okay if I let that. Um, so I brought, I brought um, I brought [REDACTED]. And then before I know they might drink, so I told [REDACTED], if they drink, if I get drunk, please bring me home. [REDACTED] agreed, he told me that he will try his best and then we took a Uber and we went to um, ORIGAMI, Uptown Minneapolis. Um, we arrived there uh, around six, probably 6:15, and I do have the Uber record for that ride

Q. Okay

A. And then from there, we met LI...BOTAN LI, B-O-T-A-N, L-I

Q. Okay

A. And he is one of the DBA students, um, I talked to him, he, he asked, he asked me for the WeChat so I just give, gave him my WeChat to him and the we talked. We uh, he ordered some beer and then we uh, had some fried squid. And I had sparkling water and [REDACTED] had mineral water and LI had beer. And then um, CHANGDONG LIU and um, and two other DBA students um, arrived at the same time. Um, they decided that we should go indoor, so um, we went, we went to, we went inside and what they, what they, I, I want to sit with [REDACTED] and the other assistants, but it seems like LIU he wanted me to, like, you know YAO, he, YAO and LIU arrived at the same time.

Q. Who is, who is YAO?

A. CEO YAO,

Q. Okay

A. QI YONG, Q-I, Y-O-N-G, YA



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A. YAO is the, I don't know, do you want me to help you?

Q. Yeah, that's fine, feel free.

A. YAO is the gentleman that invited you to dinner

Q. Right

A. QUEENA's his assistant

A. Yes

Q. Okay, alright, so that's who, I want to make sure, 'cause, alright, so QUEENA (inaudible) this. Alright, alright, alright. Okay, go ahead

A. Um, the reason why I trusted YAO is because I was the [REDACTED] and YAO took part in the [REDACTED] um, for like, at least two times

Q. Mm hm

A. So we're kind of, we talk, we've been talk to each other and he invited me to come to his work, work, um, at his company in the future, after graduation.

Q. Okay

A. And yeah, and that's why I, I, I trusted him and when he, once he asked me, he invite, he invited me to the dinner I just agreed (inaudible). And however YAO, he wanted me to sit next to QIANGDONG LIU, um, so um, I don't know, I, I'm wondering why, but I still sat there. And [REDACTED], he's, he's sitting with the other assistants.

Q. Mm hm

A. I was on the left side of QIANGDONG LIU

Q. Okay

A. And um, in, and um, and then like, more DBA students arrived and, and one of the waitress, she speaks Japanese, um, the reason why, the reason why I knew that she speaks Chin...Japanese is I talked to her in Japanese

Q. Okay

A. So um, she brought us a menu, she brought the menu to QIANGDONG LIU and QIANGDONG LIU he asked me what do I want to drink. I do have my sparkling water with me, I refused, I, I, I don't think I'm gonna drink but he just insisted, ask me what do I want to drink. I, I picked sake at, at first, because I know, you are, if you pick sake, you are not so easy to get drunk.

Q. Okay

A. But LIU insists, insisted that he will pick wine, so he picked wine and he asked his assistants to go to a liquor shop to get more wine

Q. Okay.

A. And [REDACTED] and the other assistant, they, they went out to get the wine and then he also ordered some wine from the restaurant

A. And the, and the waitress, she brought two bottles of wine and they opened the bottle and they started drinking

Q. Okay

A. And then I was also invited to drink and they told me that, like, more or less you drink, you, you have to take some wine, like that's what it, that's what they told me.

Q. Okay

A. But you know, I know these people are very famous people. I think I have [REDACTED] here to help me, so I can drink a little bit, 'cause I don't like, LIU, he told me do not lose my face, like, he whispered in my ears, um, for several times, so I'm just, okay, fine, I'll drink. So then um, like, I'm wondering like, you asked me what's my name and like, where does, where do, where do my parents work, um (inaudible) questions and LIU, he um, he told me um, like, he asked me whether I want to be his assistant in JD, is his company, in the future, after graduation. I didn't answer, I was like, fine, fine, just fine. Like, I don't care, I just want to like, I don't want to get in trouble, I don't want to, I just, I'm just a [REDACTED], like, I, I just wanna finish my like, col...my university studies and then probably um, do a PhD program for French or Japanese.

Q. Okay

A. Like, I just, I didn't, I, I didn't answer, I just like, fine, fine, I didn't answer.

Q. Okay

A. And then like, they started drinking and they um, drank, they drank a lot. And we, um, and either do I. Like, they're like Chinese cheering and something and like, you drink a, once you cheer with somebody, you drink it up and then you drink with another, another person, and then you drink it all, like that

Q. Okay

A. Like, um, I got drank and during that period, LIU, he was (inaudible) my ears, like, "I like, I like you and um, I want to bring you to New York and you can go with me um, with my private jet." Like, I, I was shocked that, that time, like, I, I know, I knew what's gonna happen so I, I tried to like, I drank more sparkling water instead of wine, but they just insist that I have to like, drink and LIU, he repeated that don't lose my face, he repeated that for several times. Like, finally I, I got really drunk and I, I told him that I want to go to the restroom and there's a, a assistant. I took, we had his assistance, whose name's [REDACTED]

Q. [REDACTED]

A. [REDACTED] and I brought her to the restroom and I begged her, "Please help me, I don't want to, I don't want to do this sort of thing, I don't want to go to New York, I just want to like, I, I'm a normal, I, I'm a normal girl, I just want to like, keep studying, I don't want to do this, like, please help me, please, bring me back home, please."

Q. Okay. What did [REDACTED] say?

A. [REDACTED] say like, [REDACTED] said, "You know he's, he's, you know he's QIANGDONG LIU, I'm his assistant."

Q. And that, what do you think that was supposed to mean?

A. Like, she's not, she's not gonna help me, 'cause she's...

Q. Okay

A. ...she's (inaudible)



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Q. Because she works for him?

A. (Inaudible) she works for LIU.

Q. Okay

A. But I just, I begged him, and, I begged her and like, "Please help me," and finally she told me that she will do whatever she can to...

Q. Okay

A. ...and then um, and then we, I got really drunk that time, like I, I was feeling really dizzy, I can't walk by myself, so that's, that's why I held the hand of like, LIU's assistant. I hold her hand

Q. Do you remember what time that was, [REDACTED]?

A. No, no.

Q. Do you remember what time dinner started?

A. Um, 6:30

Q. Okay.

A. And I remember it is, it's dar...it was dark outside and I hold [REDACTED] hand and then, and then LIU came, he came to me and he dragged my arm and he put his coat all over my body and he was holding my shoulder. I tried to escape, but I was feeling too dizzy, I can't walk by myself.

Q. Okay, do you, do you remember what kind of coat it was?

A. A black coat

Q. Long or...

A. A rain jacket...

Q. ...like a raincoat?

A. ...short.

Q. Short?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay

A. And LIU, he was wearing a pair of black leather sneakers and he was wearing black t-shirt and jeans.

Q. Okay.

A. And they did, I thought they were gonna, like, I, I can't walk by myself, I, I can't call a Uber to, to come back to my apartment by myself and they, they didn't tell me where I was going, where, where they're, where they're gonna take me.

Q. They told you that they're taking, taking you someplace now?

A. They're, I thought they're taking me someplace right now but I, I just can't escape 'cause I was really drunk, that's why

Q. Okay



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A. And then LIU, he, like, I was taken like, [REDACTED] helped me to get, get on a car. It was a black car, um, very big, sounds like um, a van or an SUV, something

Q. Okay

A. Um, there was a driver, he was a male, he was white um, he has white hair and beard

Q. Was he, do you think he was American?

A. I don't know, I know he's a white person

Q. White person?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay

A. I know, I, I remember he was short

Q. Alright, did you speak to him at all?

A. No

Q. Okay, so they took you from the restaurant and they put you in the...

A. In a car

Q. ...in a car, I guess we'll call it a limousine, I think that's what it would be

A. Yeah

Q. If it's a large enough car and has a driver. Alright, so you get in the limousine, who is in the limousine with you?

A. [REDACTED] and LIU and the driver. They didn't tell me where, where like, where are we going. They didn't tell me at all

Q. Alright

A. And I was put on the, on the back, on the, like, very behind row

Q. Okay

A. And...

Q. Was it the third row?

A. The third row

Q. Alright

A. And [REDACTED] tried to get LIU onto the second row, but LIU told [REDACTED], "Don't interrupt me," he told [REDACTED] that

Q. Mm hm

A. And [REDACTED] did not say anything and she like, went to the front and sat beside the driver. And then LIU started to (inaudible) me and he started to kiss me and he was trying to pull, pull off my clothes. I just, I just, I tried to push him away, but I just can't

Q. Okay



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A. Cause he was a male and he, he was like, he was heavy and he was, he tried to like...

Q. Was he stronger than you?

A. Yes.

Q. Okay

A. He is much heavier than me

Q. Yes, he is

A. And he was trying to like, I tried to, I tried to, to keep sitting, but he was trying to like, lie me down

Q. Okay. When you left the restaurant and you were in the, the limousine, okay?

A. Mm hm

Q. Where did you go from the restaurant? Where was the next stop?

A. I don't know, they didn't tell me

Q. Okay

A. I was scared.

Q. Did you recognize anything as the car was moving?

A. No, and I'm finally, we were, I, I just (inaudible) him "don't do that, you would have, you have wife and you have kids, don't do this, I don't want to do this." No, he did not listen to me.

Q. Okay, did you ever learn where it was that they were going?

A. No.

Q. Okay

A. No, they didn't tell me.

Q. Do you know now where it was?

A. Probably, but I'm not sure.

Q. Okay, alright.

A. And after that, um, they arrived at somewhere I recognized there were two cars in front of ours

Q. Mm hm

A. Probably other DBA students and that um, building was orange, it has um, orange lights...

Q. Okay

A. ...and the windows were, um, were white, the frames, the window frames were white and there were, there was a grass field in front of the building and there was a small like, small road or something

Q. Like a driveway?

A. Um, just a path (inaudible)

Q. Okay, alright.

A. A small path



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Q. When you got there, did anyone do anything there?

A. He, they were trying to like, LIU was trying to pull, pull my arms and they, they want me to go with them. I don't know where it was...

Q. Okay

A. ...'cause scared, I know what's gonna happen if I go to that place

A. Her phone will have a GPS on (inaudible)

Q. Okay, alright. So, okay. So what happened when you, you went from the restaurant to this place you don't know, okay. And then from there, where did you go? Did you, at what point did it go to your apartment?

A. I was very scared. I thought I'm gonna, I'm, I was kidnapped somewhere and I thought something (inaudible), something bad's gonna happen. I, I think he probably gonna rape me so I just need to, I just want to escape. I knew, I knew he's very famous, I thought he, he, he was just drunk, so I think if we sit down and talk, we're pro...at least I can go back to my apartment, I'm gonna be safe, safer than that place, you know what I mean?

Q. Okay

A. So, I begged him, "Please, please, I know, like, I don't want to do this, I know you're (inaudible) people...I know you are a good person," 'cause he have, he have (inaudible) all the DBA members, he has safety guys

Q. Mm hm

A. He has, he has at least three safety guys, I don't want to get in trouble, I, all I want to do is to come back to my apartment so that I might have chance to escape from him

Q. Mm

A. So I to...I begged him, "Please, um, I don't want to do this," I told him, like, "let, let's sit down and talk and act, I think, I know you got drunk and um, and you need, you might be, you might calm down and so that you can realize what you are doing right now." So I, I just begged him, "Please go back to my apartment, I wanna go back to my apartment, I wanna go back home," and finally, he told his (inaudible), he agreed that we were going back home...

Q. Okay

A. ...like, going back to my apartment. I gave the addr...address to the driver and they drove me back to my apartment

Q. Okay, when you arrived at your apartment, who was in the limousine?

A. Just the driver, [REDACTED], and LIU, and me

Q. And you, alright

A. And after we were right there, LIU told [REDACTED] and the driver to wait in the car and he'll be back soon, that's what he told [REDACTED]

Q. Alright.

A. And I was drunk and I can't walk by myself, so I get lost, I don't know which gate they put me...

Q. Okay



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A. ...so, and LIU, he hold, he held my arms and I, so, so that I can walk...

Q. Mm hm

A. So um, I got lost in the building. I think we passed two different gates and...

Q. When you mean "gates," do you mean, uh, entrance doors, or?

A. Entrance doors

Q. Okay

A. Yeah

Q. And you said he was holding you while you were walking?

A. Yeah

Q. How was, how was he holding you?

A. Like, um,

Q. You can show me on KELLY, that's alright

A. Like this

Q. Okay

A. Like this

Q. So, alright

A. Yeah

Q. Okay.

A. And he was on the left, I think

Q. Okay

A. But I couldn't remember. I just, he was on the left first

Q. Alright.

A. Um, then I get, I got lost, I fir...I couldn't remember where, which gate it was, 'cause I was really drunk.

Q. Okay

A. I tried to figure out where is my apartment and LIU was following me

Q. Okay

A. And finally, I got to my apartment and I let LIU to set down on a chair

Q. So you went, so, just to be clear, you, you got in your apartment building, okay?

A. Mm hm

Q. And you got to your apartment

A. Mm hm

Q. Did anyone see you while you were in the building?



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A. Yeah

Q. Okay, 'cause you told me that the other day, that someone had, had, had seen you

A. Yeah

Q. Where was that person?

A. He was, he, he is on 10th floor,

Q. Okay

A. ...and he was walking his dog that time

Q. Alright

A. He saw that LIU was holding my arms and he thought I did it spontaneously

Q. So, he saw, he saw, he was walking his dog downstairs?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay, but he lives on the 10th floor?

A. Yeah

Q. Oh, alright, hang on just a second, alright. Where, and then, so he saw, did he see you on the ground floor, then?

A. I don't

Q. Where you come into the building?

A. I don't know, I, I couldn't, I didn't see him

Q. Alright

A. 'Cause all I could recognize is the, the buttons

Q. Okay

A. And

Q. Alright, so he was walking his dog, I imagine he was probably outside. Um, and you don't remember what door you came into the building in?

A. No

Q. Okay

A. Probably the door behind...

Q. Alright

A. 'Cause I couldn't remember, I just remember there is a grass field...

Q. Okay

A. ...there and then I couldn't remember

Q. And how did you find out that you, if you don't remember him seeing you, how do you remember, how do you know that he saw you



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A. DONGTING, she's my friend and that one is

Q. Okay, that the same woman we talked about earlier? DONGTING?

A. Yeah (inaudible)

Q. Alright, alright

A. The witness, he is the friend, he's one of the friend of DONGTING

Q. Okay. Alright, okay, so then you arrive at your apartment, you live in apartment on, what floor, I know already, okay, you don't have to say it

A. Mm

Q. Alright, um, what happens next?

A. Uh, I told him to come down and ask him whether you want, do you want tea, do you want water? He told me no, and he just, he, he, he was trying to pull off my clothes. I let him stand on the chair, you know that chair?

Q. Yes, the one I sat on?

A. Yeah

Q. Yes, okay

A. I let him sat on the chair, but he, he was trying to like, he, he had my arms, he was far too stronger than me. I can't escape, he was trying to pull off my clothes. I was like, I was trying to push him away, like, we were like battling...

Q. Okay

A. ...inside the apartment and finally my sweater was like, he pulled, pulled off my sweater and he start to, to kiss me all over my neck and he was having my arms and he was like, holding, holding my, he was holding my shoulder and my neck, too, he was kissing all over my neck and

Q. Okay, alright, um, do you remember what time you arrived at your apartment?

A. No

Q. Okay

A. I just, like, you know, my, I, I, I was feeling really dizzy, I couldn't even recognize the numbers on the buttons on the elevator

Q. Okay

A. So I do have my small handbag with me

Q. Okay

A. But I just, I was too drunk and I, I think I just, and um, he was having my arms

Q. Okay, holding your arms?

A. Yeah, he was holding my arms...

Q. Okay

A. ...and the shoulders



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Q. What happened then?

A. Then my sweater was, was like, he pulled off my sweater and then I was pushed away to him, "Don't!" Like, [REDACTED] and the driver, they were, they're waiting for you downstairs, we can talk. Like, you know, I'm a normal student, I just wanna, like, if you want to give me a, give me, give me a job, yeah, I appreciate that, but don't, you have, you have your family, I don't wanna, I don't want to do that. Just, I don't want to do that."

Q. Mm hm, alright

A. He didn't, he didn't listen to me and he mentioned WENDY DONG

Q. What, what is that? I'm sorry

A. (Unknown female): WENDY DONG is (inaudible) ex-wife

A. (Unknown male): (inaudible)

Q. Oh, okay, alright

A. (Unknown male): (inaudible)

A. He mentioned WENDY DONG

Q. Alright

A. Like, he told me that, "You can, you can, you can be, you can be that, but you can be a woman like, just like WENDY DONG..."

Q. Okay

A. ...she's very (inaudible)," and I don't know what the (inaudible). He, he, he does, he probably think like that, I can be his, like, uh, I can be his lover and so that he, he's gonna give me a job or something. I just refused. But, but he just, uh, I told, I told him no several times, but

Q. Okay

A. He was trying to like, pull off my, my skirt, as well, and my bra, as well, and finally my bra was like, he pull off my bra

Q. Okay, alright

A. And he...

Q. Then what happened?

A. But I, I was still wearing my skirt and my underwear and then he hold, he held my arms and he, he tried to throw me on the bed

Q. Okay.

A. I was trying to like, keep sitting on the bed but he was trying to like, we were battling against each other, like, on, on the bed, and finally I got a escape from him and I told him, and I, I pull, I, I, I just went, went back to my living room and put on my bra again

Q. Okay

A. And I told him that, I know he was drunk and he lied on my bed and he was, he was, he was taking off his trousers, he, he took off, and then, when I came back, he already took off his trousers and I told him, "No, no, if you want to take a shower and, and, if you want to take a shower, okay, you go, you, you take a shower



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and then you can be calm again and then you go downstairs. [REDACTED] and your driver, they're waiting for you, you go downstairs." Okay, and he, he took a shower...he, he told me that, "No, I, I, like, I just want to stay here." I said, "No, I don't want to do this. You can take a shower if you want, just please take a shower," and he told me that if I, "if you, if you won't be with me, I will not take the shower." And like, he had my arms, you know, he held my arms, but he, um, and, and finally I, I, I agreed, "Okay, you take a shower and then you go," and then he, he, he hold my arms and he went into the, and he went into the shower, um, like, I opened the, I opened the shower for him and I, I tried to escape, I, I, I tried to like, went out, went out from the restroom and he still held my arms and he was trying to pull me inside the shower.

Q. Was he naked at that time?

A. Yes

Q. Okay.

A. And I tried my best to battle against him, I tried, I tried my best to escape and finally I succeeded, but that time, like, my bra was like, he, he took off my bra again and I got wet all over. I stood outside of the restroom but I still like, I'm wearing my skirt and my underwear and I, I got wet all over and I think I have to get changed, but I, but I still stood out of the restroom.

Q. Okay, so, just for the record, I've been to your apartment so I know where the restroom is in relationship to your bedroom, your living room, and your kitchen...

A. Yeah

Q. ...alright, so you were, you, you got out of the restroom and you got to your bedroom

A. I stood outside

Q. Okay

A. Yeah

Q. So you would have been in your bedroom area, there, right?

A. Yeah

Q. Alright. And what did you do next?

A. And he came out of the shower and then I told him that I'm gonna get changed, and "you are gonna go back to your car and I'm gonna get changed. I'm gonna like, I'm gonna take you out of the apartment and get you on the car."

Q. Okay

A. Then I got dressed. I got changed and I locked the door of the restroom when I got changed

Q. Okay. Alright, so you locked, you were inside the, you were inside the restroom to change?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay, alright.

A. And I locked the door.

Q. Okay

A. And when I came out, I'm ready to go out and get him on the car, but he refused to leave.



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Q. Did he get dressed again when he got...

A. No

Q. ...out of the shower?

A. No.

Q. Okay, so he, he was still naked...

A. And he was lying on my bed.

Q. Okay, alright. So he was lying on your bed, naked

A. Yes

Q. Were his clothes in the bathroom or in the bedroom?

A. They were on the chair

Q. Okay. So you went in the restroom, locked the door behind you, and you got dressed

A. And I came out and I went to the living room

Q. And he's still on your bed?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay

A. And he refused to leave. He told me that he want to stay here

Q. Okay.

A. And I told him that, "Okay, you, you gonna stay on my bed, I'm gonna stay in the living room."

Q. Alright

A. 'Cause I can't, since he's naked, I don't, I, I, I have no idea to get him out of my apartment, you know what I mean?

Q. Mm hm

A. And he refused to leave, he told me that, "I just want to stay here for one night," and then, I had no idea and I went back to the living room and he followed me to the living room and he was trying to pull my arms and get me back to the bedroom again

Q. Okay, he kept pulling, pulling you back towards the bedroom, you were in the living room

A. Yeah

Q. Okay, where your table and chair were

A. Yeah

Q. He pulled you back in

A. Yeah

Q. Alright. So, what's it, actually, back up just a second, what did he do while he was in the shower?

A. He tried to pull me in, into the shower, and we are battling against each other



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Q. Okay, and when he couldn't get you in, did he just finish showering then?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay, so, is that a customary thing to do? I don't know.

A. Unknown Male: To do what?

Q. To, to shower, or something like that for him?

A. Unknown Female: I, I would think she was trying to make sure that (inaudible) water (inaudible) and he would see more clearly, I think that might be the (inaudible)

Q. Okay. Alright, I, I didn't know, sorry

A. Unknown Male: That, that was my impression that, that (inaudible), in fact, I think she said that. (Inaudible)

Q. Okay, so, yeah, just to kind of calm down. So, I didn't know if there was something that he would do also (inaudible) different

A. Unknown Male: (Inaudible)

Q. Okay, alright.

A. Unknown Male: That was the impression I had

Q. Okay, so he kept pulling you into, or trying to pull you into the bedroom, alright?

A. Um, he succeeded

Q. Okay

A. Um, I was sitting on the edge of the bed with him.

Q. What happened next?

A. Um, he told me to like, that time, I turned out the light, 'cause he, I'm gonna stay in the living room and I want to find a chance to get out of the, get out of the apartment, but I, I, so I don't want anyone to know about this

Q. Okay

A. I just want to, like, I think, if I, I can keep staying in the living room and he can like, he got drunk and he can fall asleep and tomorrow morning, he does not have any chance to rape me, so I just want to stay, like, stay in, in my living room and finally I was pulled back by him

Q. Okay

A. And then I was sitting on the edge of the bed and then finally he just, um, throw me onto the bed

Q. Okay

A. And then um, he was on, like on me, like he was heavy, like, I, I tried to push him away but I just...

Q. He was on top of you?

A. He was on top of me

Q. Okay

A. And he was trying to like, raise my like, legs



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Q. Okay. How did, did he, at what point did he remove your clothes?

A. Like aft...he, he did not like, put on his clothes after the, after he, he, he finished the shower

Q. So he was still naked?

A. Yes, he was still naked

Q. Okay. And when he threw you onto the bed and he was on top of you, what did he do then?

A. He just pull off my underwear

Q. Okay

A. And then he raised my two legs and then

Q. Did he ever, and he raised your le...his, your legs towards you, or...?

A. Towards me

Q. Towards you, so he pushed them back towards you?

A. Yeah

Q. Alright. And then what happened?

A. And then he raped me

Q. Okay. [REDACTED], I'm gonna need you to be a little bit more specific than that, alright? I know it's hard to talk about, okay, especially with a room full of strangers, okay, but you need to tell me exactly what he did.

A. Um, he first took off my underwear and then he was all over me, he raised my two legs,

Q. Okay

A. And he, um, penetrate, that okay?

Q. Mm hm

A. Um, and he started to like, I, I just can't escape from him. He was like...

Q. Okay

A. ...he was, he raped me, and then he was asking like, whether, whether, are, are you at your, like, whether is my safety period or not

Q. Okay

A. And I told him, "No, I don't want to be pregnant."

Q. Okay

A. And after this, like, he pulled, like

Q. He withdrew?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay, pull, he pulled out?

A. He pull out



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Q. And so, if, if it's okay, I'll paraphrase for you. Um, at some point, he pushed your legs up towards your head

A. Yeah, so that I can't move

Q. Okay, and he penetrated...

A. And he still have, he, he held my like, shoulders

Q. Okay

A. So that I can't move

Q. Alright, and so then he penetrated your vagina with his penis?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay

A. And he, he put my leg on his shoulder...

Q. Okay

A. ...and he had his arm, he held my shoulder so that I can't move

Q. Okay. Alright, and then how, how long and, I guess, not that you're tracking time, but how long do you think this lasted?

A. I, I don't know, about two minutes

Q. Okay

A. I don't know. But I, I, I asked him, "Why do you do this?" I, he, he did, he didn't answer and he told me that he just, he just want, he just want me and that's all

Q. He said he just wanted you?

A. He just wanted me and that's all

Q. Okay, when, when he ejaculated, because I know that from the report that he did, alright, when he ejaculated, did he withdraw from you and he ejaculated someplace else?

A. Just out of me, on the sheet, on that sheet

Q. On the sheet?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay, so underneath you or on the bedsheet?

A. I think it's on my stomach (inaudible)

Q. Okay

A. And then like, I, like I just turned, like, I, I turned and like, I try to keep all these sort of thing on my bedsheet, you know...

Q. Okay

A. ...I just want to keep it as the evidence



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Q. Alright.

A. And finally, I like, I was tired and, and I, I think, "Oh geez," I think that my dress that I, I was wearing was dirty so then I got, I got changed to a t-shirt...

Q. Okay

A. ...and I was too tired and I got drunk. I was like, hopeless, so I just slept on the bed again

Q. Where was he?

A. He was beside me. He, he fell asleep, like, right after he raped me

Q. Did you fall asleep too, at some point?

A. Yes

Q. Okay, but he fell asleep before...

A. Yeah

Q. ...just after he ejac...when he finished, he just laid there?

A. Yeah. He finished and he fell asleep and I got changed

Q. Okay

A. And then I fell asleep. I try to stay away from him, but I still fell asleep on the bed.

Q. Okay.

A. And then at two, around 2:00, um, it rained and the lightning just woke me up

Q. Okay

A. I got my phone and I tried to, I, I text, I text my boyfriend and my friend and [REDACTED]

Q. Alright

A. I, I knew everybody, they were trying to like, they, they were trying to find me, 'cause they probably think that I was kidnapped

Q. Okay

A. 'Cause I didn't reply to their messages. And then I text my boyfriend and my friend and [REDACTED], I told these people that I was raped by QIANGDONG LIU and he was still in my room.

Q. Okay, what's your friend's name?

A. It's YI, (inaudible) Y-I

Q. (Inaudible) G-Y-I

A. I, Y-I, X-I-E

Q. X-I-E, alright. How do you say that?

A. (Inaudible)

Q. (Inaudible)

A. XIE is the last name



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Q. Oh, okay, what's her first name?

A. Y-I

Q. Oh, Y-I, I'm sorry, okay, Y-I, alright.

A. Unknown Male: Two (inaudible)

Q. Yeah, okay. And that's your best friend, or girlfriend?

A. My best friend, yeah

Q. Okay, and she's in China?

A. She's in China

Q. Okay, and your boyfriend is?

A. Z-I

Q. Z-I?

A. Z-I

Q. Alright. KELLY, you have to help me with this, okay?

A. KELLY: Yeah

A. C-H-E-N

Q. C-H-E-N, okay?

A. C-A-O

Q. C-A-O, alright

A. KELLY: ZI CHEN CAO? CAO is the last name

Q. Okay

A. KELLY: CHEN is first name

Q. Okay, perfect. And he's in another country, too, am I right?

A. Yeah, he's still in China

Q. Oh, okay, alright.

A. And other, and [REDACTED]

Q. Right, but [REDACTED] is here.

A. Uh, he was here?

Q. No, I mean he's in Minneapolis.

A. Yeah, he's here

Q. Yeah, okay, so, no, he's not right here, I'm sorry. Alright, and then what happened?

A. And then [REDACTED], he came from his apartment, which is called WAHU. He came directly from his apartment to my apartment

Q. Okay



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A. 'Cause he was, he told me that he was worried about me. He, he wanted to call the police

Q. Mm hm

A. I told him no, I don't want to get in trouble, I just, like, you know, he's very famous and he can do whatever he want with his money. I, I, I think my, my parents, they are working in China

Q. Mm hm

A. I, I worrying about my parents, 'cause you know, there are many, they could hire killers, they're in China

Q. Okay

A. They, he, he has a lot of money, but in China

Q. That's (inaudible)

A. Yeah, and like, he can even hire killers where they can hire somebody to hurt my parents so that, like, I, I don't want to make him angry, you know what I mean

Q. Mm hm

A. 'Cause once, if I call the police, he, he's like, he's gonna be arrested and he's gonna be angry and he's gonna do something to hurt me or my parents or my friends and I don't want this to, to happen, so I like...

Q. Okay

A. ...I was thinking about like, just, you can apologize to me, just I need apologize, I need an explanation.

Q. Okay

A. 'Cause I, I realize that this is a trap

Q. Alright. What do you, what do you mean by "trap?"

A. Trap is like, you know, [REDACTED], I, I, I saw, I saw the conversation between [REDACTED] and QUEENA, um, [REDACTED] WeChat, and QUEENA, he, even though is YAO, who, who invited me to the dinner

Q. Right

A. But QUEENA, he, she told [REDACTED] that it was LIU that asked [REDACTED] to invite me to the dinner

Q. Okay.

A. And I, I now, I might realize that like, [REDACTED] and they, all of the DBA student, they know another student, another DBA student, whose name is um, YANG ZHANG, last name zay, Z-H-A-N-G, first name, Y-A-N-G

Q. Okay

A. He rent, he booked a, a AirBnB like, online, it was, it was a villa

Q. Okay

A. And I, I, I, I've seen the pictures from like, [REDACTED] cell phone. I can tell that that place was where they just brought me that night

Q. Oh, that night, that place that you didn't know

A. I didn't know



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Q. Okay, alright. Alright, I think I know where that is, so, alright. So, [REDACTED], you talked to [REDACTED] and your two friends, your boyfriend and your friend in China, okay? And [REDACTED] called the police.

A. Yeah, [REDACTED] called the police, but he didn't tell the police that, like, I was raped but he, actually, he show some like, I was, um, you know, personally, I talk, I talked to [REDACTED] and then LIU, he woked up at about 2:40

Q. Okay

A. And he asked me why I'm, who I'm texting to. I told him that I text my mom

Q. Alright

A. I told him that I text my mom, but actually I'm texting [REDACTED] and um, LIU, he was asking what time is it right now, I told him is 2:40, is gonna be 3:00. Um, he, he got up and I told him, "Okay," and then I got dressed as, immediately. I got dressed, I, I put on a, a purple knitted dress and I, I, I got dressed and I'm ready to send him to his hotel

Q. Okay

A. And I told him that I will call a Uber for you and send you back to HOTEL IVY, but he refused to, refused to take the, take the Uber to, to go back to HOTEL IVY. I had no idea, 'cause he refused to put on his clothes

Q. Okay

A. Although, I brought the clothes and I put them on the bed, I told him, "Just get dressed. I'll call a Uber and the Uber driver is arriving at 5, in, in five minutes." And I first called Uber at 3 pm

Q. 3 am, you mean?

A. Uh, yeah, 3 am.

Q. Okay, alright

A. And he asked, he let me to, he asked me, "If you call the Uber, I'm not gonna get dressed. I'm gonna be naked like this," and I had no idea and I cancelled the first Uber and, okay, I told him, "Okay, I'll call another Uber after five minutes and then you get dressed." And then he, like, I, after five minutes, I called another Uber, that was three, uh, three eight, after five minutes

Q. Okay

A. And I, I do have the screenshots of the Uber

Q. Okay

A. And he still refused to get dressed. I don't know what, what he want to do, I told him to leave and that time, the police officer, he knocked on the door and I answered the door

Q. Okay, alright. And then what happened?

A. And then, um, the police officer, he, he came in, two police officers, they came in

Q. Okay

A. And um, and LIU was caught and two officers probably let him get dressed

Q. Mm hm

A. And one police officer, he told me to get my ID...



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Q. Okay

A. ...and I handed him my passport

Q. Alright

A. And he asked me what happened, I told him I was raped, but not that kind of rape, 'cause, you know, not that kind of rape, I don't want to like, let, let him be arrested, I don't want to let him angry, so I like, so I told him I was raped. 'Cause I didn't know what [REDACTED] told the police. If [REDACTED] told the police that I was raped, okay, I'll tell him, I'll tell him the truth. And so I told him that I was raped but not that kind of rape, I just want to like, let LIU go, and just let him go, I don't want to get in trouble. If he apologize, I'm not gonna sue him and if he give me a explanation, I'm gonna be fine. 'Cause I know he's famous, he has power and he's, he has money. I don't want me to get hurt

Q. Alright. And then the officers took him from your apartment, didn't they?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay. And where did you go after that?

A. I went on to the police vehicle

Q. Okay

A. And I sat there and the police officer asked me, um, "What happened to you? Did you um, did you do this spontaneously?" I told him, "Okay, yes, and just let him go."

Q. Alright, and they did, didn't they?

A. And, and they did, and they sent LIU to HOTEL IVY with their police vehicle

Q. Yeah, alright.

A. And I was waiting for, after that, I was waiting for his apologize

Q. Mm hm

A. Like, I thought tomorrow somebody's gonna come to me and, or he will contact me by himself where he will apologize to me, or he will give me an explanation

Q. And that didn't happen

A. That didn't happen and, that's a shame, you know, he sent his assistant to collect my passport information, 'cause he was still thinking that I'm gonna go to New York with him

Q. So his, which assistant came to see you? It was, was it [REDACTED]

A. [REDACTED]

Q. [REDACTED] okay

A. ...another...

Q. Okay, so this is the next day, or, I guess...

A. Yeah, the next day...

Q. ...continuing with the next day...

A. ...next morning



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Q. Okay, so [REDACTED] came to see you?

A. No, she called me

Q. Okay

A. She added my, I don't, I didn't know where she, how she got my, like, contact information for WeChat. She got my WeChat and, and she talked to me through WeChat, like, and she wanted to have my, she told me that LIU want to, want me to go to New York with him. She want to have my passport information

Q. Okay

A. And I was totally shocked, you know

Q. Alright. Okay, so you spoke to [REDACTED] on the phone, alright?

A. Mm hm

Q. And she wanted your passport information

A. Yeah

Q. Alright, and did you, did you give it to her?

A. No

Q. Okay, what did you tell [REDACTED]?

A. I told her I was tired and I got sick, "I need to talk to you later this evening."

Q. Okay, and then did you talk to her again?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay, when did you talk to her next?

A. And is, after I went to the hospital, 'cause I talk to my friends then, TALIA, DONGTING, and other friends...

Q. Okay

A. ...they came to my apartment and I had no idea, like, what I'm gonna do next so I talked to [REDACTED], I talked to CLAUDIA, I told them, "What should I do next?" They told me that, "If you don't, if you, if you, if you're gonna sue him, you're, they, like, uh, they probably like, you know the public might have your information, they might know that, know who you are." You know the Chinese media, they're trying to like, he's very famous in China

Q. Yes, I've found that out

A. And, or, and he's, I don't want me to be on the newspaper, you know what I mean. I, I don't want me to be interrupted, I just want to finish, complete my university career successfully

Q. Okay, when um, when you talked to your friends, alright, you said they came to your apartment?

A. Yeah, they came to my apartment, 'cause CLAUDIA, she was living on the 10th floor.

Q. Okay

A. And DONGTING, she's living in the, I don't know what that's, what the name of that apartment is, not far away from [REDACTED]



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Q. Okay

A. And they came over to my, to my apartment, um, we talked

Q. Okay

A. And CLAUDIA was with, with her boyfriend

Q. Okay

A. And they all knew what happened, 'cause I told CLAUDIA what happened.

Q. Okay, then after, after that conversation, alright, when did you go to the CARLSON SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT?

A. 'Cause, we also met the witness, like, the, the, the...

Q. The guy with the dog?

A. Yeah (inaudible)

Q. Okay, do we know his name?

A. No, but DONGTING, she might, she, she

Q. Okay, DONGTING will, alright. Alright. Alright, then what happened?

A. Uh, that's the, and, and they're asking me whether I want to sue him, I, whether, whether I want to go to the court, I told them, "I don't know," and they (inaudible), and they, they told me that, "If you want to um, you prob...you probably need his apologize and probably some money and that's, that worth it," like, they just told me this and CLAUDIA and [REDACTED], they just asked, they just told me, I don't know what to do, I just want to apologize that's it, apologize at first.

Q. Okay

A. So they (inaudible) money, 'cause it's necessary that that's what everybody told me.

Q. Unknown Male: We want to clarify when she says "sue," is she referring pressing charges or civil action (inaudible)

Q. Yeah, I was just gonna say, when you, when you, in your understanding of our legal system...

A. No, I don't understand, I don't, I...

Q. That's okay, that's okay

A. That's why like, that's why I, I gave my number to you and let you to gave it to the attorney

Q. Yes, yes

A. So, I don't

Q. Okay, when you called me back and you wanted to reopen the case, okay, there's two levels of this, and I'm trusting that your counsel explain, or has explained that to you, there's two sides to this situation. One is a criminal side and the other side is a civil side. Okay, I work on the criminal side of things. Remember when you asked me about that and I said, "Well, I can't, I can't facilitate that for you, but I can put you in touch with his attorney," and that's when you gave me your permission to do that and I did. Alright, that's the civil side of things. This is the criminal side of things. So when you called and you asked me to reopen the case, that's the criminal side of this. Okay, the civil side of this is nothing to do with me, okay?

A. Okay



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Q. So um, because I know when you called in the morning, you asked the police to sue him and we don't sue people, we just arrest them, okay

Q. Unknown Male: (Inaudible) maybe what she meant was pressing charges (inaudible)

Q. I think so, yeah, I, I figured that once she said reopen that's what it meant to me and

Q. Unknown Male: But when she used the word sue, she was (inaudible)...

Q. Yeah, oh yeah, no

Q. Unknown Male: ...understood that she meant (inaudible) criminal (inaudible)...

Q. Right, she just thinks that's, I'm

Q. Unknown Male: ...she doesn't understand (Inaudible)

Q. Yeah, no I figured that's, I thought it was because nobody else would ask me to do that so, alright, um, but that's fine, but yeah, that's, when you, when I got your message on Tuesday, that's what I took it to mean that you wanted me to open, reopen the criminal investigation, which is what we did, alright, and then uh, that's what led us to here, okay? Um, are there any questions that you have for me?

A. Nope

Q. Okay, I do have one quick, or I should, actually I have a couple more questions for you. Um, when you were at the CARLSON SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT the night the second group of officers came, okay, how is it that they came across him there?

A. Like, before this, I went to the hospital and I was telling, I was still thinking that he could just apologize to me or something

Q. Okay

A. And then I came to CARLSON, I, I talk, I had a meeting with [REDACTED], that's LIU's assistant

Q. Okay, yep

A. 'Cause she's, she was wondering why like, why I'm going to the hospital and she was, she wants to know what happened

Q. Okay

A. On that, uh, on that day, that night

Q. And you, did you meet her at the school?

A. At school

Q. Okay, alright. Alright, go ahead.

A. And um, there were two, like, there were two staffs there, like, they were black people

Q. Okay

A. And I think there is video of this

Q. Alright

A. And um, after that she knew that this is a serious problem and she went, or she came, she (inaudible), she, she came to LIU, probably, and then I was brought to MANDY (Inaudible)'s office

Q. Okay, that's MANDY?

A. MANDY

A. Unknown Female: Yeah, MANDY (inaudible)



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Q. Okay, MANDY BAI?

A. BAI

A. Unknown Female: B-A-I

Q. Okay, alright

A. I was brought to MANDY's office and she (inaudible) to call the police

Q. Okay. And what does MANDY do?

A. She is um, she is a staff of the DBA program

Q. Okay, alright. So she's an employee of the university or is she a student, too?

A. She's an employee of the un...of the university

Q. Okay, alright

A. She's the assistant of the DBA program.

Q. Okay.

A. And she, she told me that she called the police for me, um, that morning

Q. Okay

A. Is October the 30th?

Q. August

A. August

Q. Yeah, okay

A. August 30th.

Q. Alright

A. And she told me that she already called the police for me and she want me to call the police by myself 'cause they won't open a case uh, if, uh, like, you know, they had to let me to call them by myself

Q. Well, you have to tell them what you, what you're telling me, so that's kinda, that's kinda what, but that's not really important right now, so. Okay, so...

A. So then I, then she called the police...

Q. Mm hm

A. ...for me and then I answered the phone

Q. Okay

A. Right in her office

Q. Alright so, so then the officers arrived, how did, um, LIU get there?

A. 'Cause after I called the police, [REDACTED], she contact me, she um, she, we, we did a, she call, I answer the phone and I do have the record, [REDACTED] has the record. I told him to record the like, the conversation between me and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], she got to LIU and LIU, he, he, he thought that that's serious, but [REDACTED], they want to send another people to talk to me, like, the other people was HUA, H-U-A, H-U-A, L-I



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Q. Okay, L-I. Okay, and this is someone who...

A. Who's, um, he is LIU's friend

Q. Okay

A. And he was um, he was at ORIGAMI that night, so I didn't trust him. She was like, she wanted LI to come to talk to me...

Q. Alright

A. Instead of LIU, but I refused, I don't trust him, I just want LIU to be here

Q. Alright

A. I didn't think that, I, I didn't, I didn't thought, I didn't think that like, LIU's gonna be arrested right at CARLSON SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT

Q. Okay.

A. I thought, "They're not gonna arrest him, like, until like, they found the evidence or, or something." I just tell him to come and to tell him that "I'm, I, I probably gonna go to the court and you might want to be prepared for that, 'cause you didn't get, you didn't give me the apologize and you're still thinking that I'm going to New York with you, no I'm not," I'm just gonna, gonna see him and like, talk to him

Q. Alright

A. (Inaudible) but after, after talking to me and the uh, police officer, they saw LIU and he was arrested then

Q. Okay. Alright, did, was he there before the officers got there?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay, I thought that, I just didn't know, so. And then you talked to the officers and

A. I think, I don't, I don't know, like, 'cause after the, one of the officers, his name is TAO

Q. Mm hm

A. T-A-O, he was talking to me

Q. Yes

A. (Inaudible) and then he came to me and he told me that LIU is, LIU is outside, he was waiting for me

Q. Okay

A. And then I didn't, I didn't, I didn't think that they were gonna arrest LIU that night, but they did

Q. Yes, they did. Um, so you talked to Officer TAO, was that in MANDY's office?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay

A. And MANDY were there, she was outside

Q. Right, okay, so she was kind of wearing a blue dress...

A. Yeah



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Q. ...If I'm not mistaken, I think I've seen a picture of that. So, alright, so then I'm caught up to that point.

Alright, um. Alright, um, I don't have anything further right now

A. Unknown Male: Could I, could I...

Q. Yes

A. Unknown Male: ...ask you, are you interested at all in, in the, the text messages?

Q. Oh, I am, yes, I just thought we'd do that offline if you wanted, um

A. Unknown Male: Uh, but I think (inaudible) 'cause there's a lot of them

Q. Okay, yeah, that's fine

A. (inaudible) get the translations (inaudible) your case but...

Q. No, no worries

A. Unknown male: It's, it's not (inaudible), it's not a couple minute thing and it's (inaudible)

Q. [REDACTED], your attorneys have provided me with these three packets, alright, or I guess, somewhat I guess, screenshots of your phone and your text messages with your friends and with [REDACTED]

A. Yeah

A. Unknown Male: No, there's nothing with [REDACTED]

Q. Nothing with [REDACTED]?

A. Unknown Male: (Inaudible) we don't have (inaudible)

A. Unknown Female: (Inaudible) boyfriend...

Q. One is boyfriend...

A. Unknown Female: ...(Inaudible)

Q. Okay, one is a boyfriend

A. Unknown Female: Boyfriend is (inaudible)

Q. Alright, and I can, these are mine?

A. Unknown Male: (inaudible)

Q. Alright, perfect.

A. Unknown Female: (Inaudible) numbering it?

A. Unknown Male: (Inaudible)

A. Unknown Female: I'm sorry, (inaudible) if you mind, I just take a look...

Q. Yeah

A. Unknown Female: ...make sure (inaudible)

Q. Go ahead, make sure. Please do, 'cause

A. (Several talking at once, inaudible)

Q. Alright

A. Unknown Male: (Inaudible)

A. Unknown Female: So number one is, was the girlfriend, actually



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Q. Oh, girlfriend, okay

A. Unknown Female: YI XIE

Q. I'm not even gonna try to spell that, I'll just write girlfriend, okay?

A. Unknown Female: (Inaudible) I can write (inaudible)

A. Can I go to the restroom (inaudible)?

Q. Oh, that's fine, yeah, go ahead.

A. Unknown Male: If everyone else is taking a bathroom break, might as well do the same (inaudible)

Q. So number one is the girlfriend in China

A. KELLY: In China

Q. Okay, number two is...

A. KELLY: (inaudible) number two is...boyfriend

Q. Okay, alright. And he's also in China, right?

A. KELLY: Yes, boyfriend in China, girlfriend in China

Q. Alright. Alright, and number three

A. KELLY: Number three is really just um, some of her conversation with QUEENA.

Q. Okay, QUEENA is...

A. KELLY: QUEENA is the assistant to [REDACTED]

Q. To [REDACTED], right?

A. KELLY: To YAO (inaudible)

Q. YAO, yeah, he's the one that asked her to the event that night

A. KELLY: Yes, he (inaudible) dinner and then

Q. Okay

A. KELLY: Yes, her conversation with QUEENA, with, I believe, [REDACTED], as well,

Q. Okay, like I, okay...

A. KELLY: MANDY

Q. ...(Inaudible) [REDACTED]...is [REDACTED], is [REDACTED]?

A. KELLY: Yes

Q. Okay, [REDACTED]

A. KELLY: Yes, yes, LIU's assistant, one of the assistants

Q. And this, I trust this is, like a document is her um...

A. KELLY: That's, that's her like, uh, screenshot of her uh, contacts

Q. Contacts, right? Okay



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A. KELLY: All the list of people in the DBA program

Q. Alright, well, we'll wait for her to get back and then

A. KELLY: Yeah, I think that's one conversation with MANDY as well, MANDY (inaudible)

Q. Okay, okay, alright, that's fine. So, um, just for the record, the only people left in the room right now are myself and KELLY, uh, others are using the restroom

A. KELLY: I'm going to use the restroom as well (inaudible)

Q. Okay, then I guess I'll wait.

A. (Inaudible) it's way far away.

A. Unknown Female: Is this your first time in the...

Q. Here? Oh, yeah, yep.

A. It's pretty nice, huh?

Q. (Inaudible) And for the record, I'm the only one in the room now. And [REDACTED] is back now.

A. Unknown Male: Is the recorder still on?

Q. Yes, it is.

A. Unknown Male: (Inaudible) let me ask you some more about what happened in the uh, the limo

Q. Oh, okay. If that's something he wants to add, yeah, that's fine.

A. Unknown Male: (Inaudible) Want anything to drink?

A. Unknown Female: Um, I'm good

A. Unknown Male: Water or anything?

A. Unknown Female: No, (inaudible)

A. Unknown Male: (Inaudible) coffee?

Two unknown males whispering: (Inaudible) I don't know that, I'm just, guessing, I'm guessing that's (inaudible).

Unknown Female after knocking on door: Here you go

Unknown Male: Thank you

Unknown Female: You're welcome

Q. Are we ready? Okay, perfect, everyone's back in the room now and we're going over some, I guess, before we go to, before we go to the screenshots, let me just go back to something, um, with regard to the limousine ride. Um, is there something you want to tell me about what went on between the, in, in, in the limousine with [REDACTED]? Is there something you want to share with me about that?

A. I just thought (inaudible), [REDACTED], he, she was on the, on the, on the car, that time. I knew, like, she, she knew, she knows Chinese. Like, I was talking, I was begging LIU, like, "Don't do this," in Chinese. I think she's, she understand what I, what I said

Q. Okay, and did she do anything that was odd or, she didn't do anything to help you?

A. Uh, no, no. And the driver, he turned on the music

Q. Did he?



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A. (inaudible) trying to pull off my clothes

Q. Okay, so did he, did he, when he turned the music on, did he turn it, the volume up, down? Was it loud?

A. Just, he turned on the music.

Q. Okay, alright. Why do you think he did that?

A. I think probably [REDACTED] told him to turn on the music, where she has seen these certain thing before

Q. Okay

A. I don't know

Q. Why do you think, why do you think he turned the music up?

A. 'Cause he was trying to pull off my clothes and like,

Q. Not the driver, but MR. LIU, right?

A. Yeah

Q. Yeah, but why would the driver turn the music up in you, in your mind, why do you think he turned the music up?

A. I knew he, he, I, I, I was thinking about like, he knew what, what's gonna happen next, probably he's gonna rape me on the car. I was trying to pull, pull, push him away. So like, he didn't, he wasn't, he did not succ...succeed. Like, even though he wants to like, pull off my clothes or something, he did not succeed, 'cause he, I just battled with him in the car, I just try to push him away

Q. Alright. When you were in the car, you said that, was it [REDACTED] that was sitting in the front seat?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay, did she turn around to look over or anything like that?

A. No, I, I, I think, no

Q. Okay, was there a screen in the limousine? Did a partition come up at any time in the seats?

A. No

Q. Okay, alright. Were you relatively certain that [REDACTED] could hear you?

A. I think she could hear me

Q. Okay, did, but she didn't answer you?

A. She didn't answer

Q. Okay. Did, did LIU give any instructions to anyone in the car? Do you remember?

A. He just told [REDACTED], "Don't interrupt me."

Q. Okay.

A. But his tone was absolute and [REDACTED], she didn't answer

Q. Okay

A. Like, he was kind of, he show his anger to [REDACTED] for her, like, she was trying to get, like, separate he and (inaudible)



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Q. Okay

A. and she was, he was kind of angry at [REDACTED] and, you know, (inaudible)

Q. Alright. Does [REDACTED] travel with LIU?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay, does [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] y're his assistants

Q. They are, okay, alright. How old are they, do you know?

A. I don't know, probably like, it seems like they're 26, 25

Q. Okay, so they're, they're young [REDACTED]?

A. Young

Q. Okay. Alright. Um, we have the, the screenshots? Okay, so, alright. You know, we're moving now, uh, why don't we just start with packet one. Um, this has been identified by KELLY as being conversations between you and your boyfriend, who is in China, and he...

A. Girlfriend?

Q. I'm sorry, girlfriend, I can't read my own writing, um, girlfriend. Uh, she is in China, alright. And is this on the WeChat?

A. Yes

Q. Is that? Okay, alright. Now, I'm gonna take the cover off of this and have you walk me through what I'm looking at.

A. So she's asking, "What the fuck? What's wrong? What's going on?" Like, don't tell, like, um, just um, just don't tell anybody except...

Q. Alright

A. ...like, just keep it to yourself

Q. So let me, let me ask you, let me ask you and is, is one side of this your conversation and the other side hers?

A. This, this mine (inaudible)

Q. This is yours, this is hers, okay. Let me just mark that so I don't forget, so. Alright, so this is you?

A. Yeah

Q. Alright, and this is your friend?

A. Yeah

Q. Alright. Okay, there we go

A. And she um, like, I, I just told her that um, like, "I want to talk to you, something happened," and she, she asked, "What the fuck? What happened?" Um, I told her don't, don't tell, just keep it to yourself, she said okay, "You promise?" "I promise." "Like, I was raped by QIANGDONG LIU." "What the heck?"



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Q. Okay, and that was page one.

A. Yeah

Q. Alright. Okay, next page.

A. And this is my nickname

Q. What's your nickname?

A. Um, just my nickname

Q. Oh, okay

A. Unknown Female: It's very hard to have the derived Chinese (inaudible)

Q. Okay, that's alright

A. Unknown Female: (Inaudible) call you like, girl

Q. Okay, that's fine, just curious. Alright

A. This girl like, yes, okay, um, QIANGDONG LIU has been brought to, brought, brought back to his hotel.
"Are you safe now?" "Yes," um, just a call, I refuse her call.

Q. Okay

A. "Just give me, give me a second," "Are you feeling, or okay?" "Yes."

Q. Alright, that was (inaudible), alright. And page three?

A. "Are you forced to get drunk yesterday? Are you forced to get drunk yesterday?" just the question, like, like this

Q. Okay

A. "Yes, it's a trap." Um, "What's go...what's happening to the friend that you brought to the dinner?"

Q. Okay

A. Um, "That friend called the police but um, it's useless."

Q. Okay

A. "Where are you right now?" Um, "Police station of the home, home"

Q. Okay, okay (inaudible). Alright, page four?

A. "I will talk to the USNS I go back," um, "Aren't you at your apartment?" um, "I was on the police vehicle"

Q. Okay

A. "Okay, um, take your time, if you're not feeling well, you just, um, have to take a rest first," um, "We'll talk, we'll, we'll talk about this when you're feeling better"

Q. Okay

A. Um, she called me but I didn't pick it up

Q. Okay

A. Um, um, just, um, "Let me know if you, once you wake up."



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Q. Okay

A. "Are you okay?" "Yes" "Did you throw, threw, threw away your bedsheet?" "I can't throw, throw away my evidence."

Q. Okay

A. "Okay, um, are you, um, have you decided, um, have you decided, um, what to, how to deal with this, how to deal with this stuff?"

Q. Okay, alright.

A. "Not yet."

Q. Okay

A. "Um, do you want to do, are you going to tell your parents?" "Nope." "Do you want to um, um, like," I think she's meaning that, "Are you going to the court?"

Q. Okay

A. "Do you want, um, do you want him to pay back," or something.

Q. Okay

A. "Do you want to go to the court." Um, "I was like, I was shocked and um, I feel really bad after knowing this and I cried and now I'm feeling better so I want to keep calm and think about this seriously."

Q. Okay

A. Um, "I've already kind of um, recovered, okay, I'm not that, um, I'm not that, um, weak"

Q. Okay, alright

A. Right, "I'm not that fragile"

Q. Okay, you're tough

A. Yeah

Q. Alright

A. I'm, I'm saying that I'm not that fragile

Q. Alright

A. Um, um, "How, how many people did you talk to, like, did you talk to..."

Q. She's asking you how many people you talked to or told of the event, okay

A. (Inaudible), yeah, "many people, like, several people on the police and teacher"

Q. Okay

A. Um, "And some friends," and I send her the picture of QIANGDONG LIU being arrested

Q. Oh, okay

A. I have this, I have this picture

Q. Alright



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A. Um, "If he does not apologize, I probably, I probably want to send this to um, to the media."

Q. Okay

A. Um, "I'm gonna, I'm gonna look, I'm going to look for the video in my apartment."

Q. Okay

A. Unknown Male: Are you interested in the teacher's name? That she told...

Q. Is it, is it MANDY? I thought it was MANDY

A. Yeah

Q. Okay

A. Unknown Male: 'Cause I didn't know (inaudible)

Q. Yeah, I know, that one, that one I have already, so, alright.

A. Um, "this is only, is just some information, but I don't think this, this could be an evidence, um, if you lose the, if you lose, if you lose your like, if you lose and um, you, you are gonna give this to the public."

Q. Okay, oh, okay, alright, I understand, alright

A. "And I need to find the driver to have his words as the evidence"

Q. Okay

A. "If you send this information to the media, um, the people who, whose names QIANGDONG LIU, he's not the only person whose name's QIANGDONG LIU"

Q. Okay

A. "I do have his video, I think, um, the, is the driver, um, is the driver on his side?" Um, "the driver is hire...is being hired, I don't know, um, I, I don't know on earth where I was taken that night."

Q. Okay

A. "Who hired him?" "I don't know"

Q. Alright. Alright

A. Just the same thing, "Who hired him?" "I don't know, it was a foreigner."

Q. Okay

A. "If, if he saw you um, battling against QIANGDONG LIU, I just want to prove that I was brought to a place that I didn't know that night." "Why didn't you call the police that time?" "I got, I was really drunk and you know what? The driver also opened the musi...the driver opened, even opened the music. I can't, I failed to push him away."

Q. Okay, so just to clarify, you meant he turned the music up here?

A. Yeah

Q. Okay, alright. Alright. Okay, we'll go to packet number two. This is considerably longer. And this is your boyfriend, am I right?

A. Yeah



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Q. Okay.

A. I think there's something wrong with this page, I think that the order

Q. Oh, um, I don't suppose we have any way of knowing that, do we?

A. I can fix this

An unidentified Asian male directs another unidentified Asian male to the seventh chair from the right. There is much socializing going on with the group, it is very apparent that at least all of the males know one-another. There appears to be a great deal of laughter going on. [REDACTED] is the only female at the table the whole time; one of Richard's assistants was sitting near the right end of the table at the beginning, but she quickly moved to providing assistance where needed throughout the evening.

There appears to be a large amount of food and beverage being consumed at the table, throughout the night the guests can be seen eating and drinking quite regularly; food continues to be provided by the waitstaff.

[REDACTED], and others at the table, are drinking water as well, throughout the evening.

On September 1st, 2018, I was assigned this case for investigation. The following update references investigative activity from September 15th through October 1st, 2018.

On September 17th, 2018, University of Minnesota Police Department (UMNPD) Detective Dan Farrar; dropped off a disc containing surveillance recordings taken from the Carlson School of Management.

Detective Farrar stated the recordings contain images from the incident date and the date Richard was arrested. As of this report, the video is unplayable on MPD computers; I will be asking the MPD Crime Lab's Video Forensic technician to make the disc playable on MPD computers.

On September 17th, 2018, I was informed by the BCA that Ross Thomas, a Forensic Scientist, had been assigned to this investigation.

On September 17th, 2018, I met with Jon Newman, owner of Metro Alarm and Lock, who provided me with the video surveillance recording from the Origami Restaurant from the night of the incident. Newman also explained that he had been contacted by several attorneys and media organizations asking for copies of the video. I copied the Origami Restaurant security video to my case file and then reviewed the video. A separate supplement will be used for a synopsis of the video.

On September 20th, 2018, the "bulk" of this investigation and its collected evidence was delivered to the Hennepin County Attorney's Office for review; it was delivered to the Criminal Prosecution Team Lead, Al Harris, for review and possible assignment.

On October 1st, 2018, I reviewed the Security/Surveillance video I received from the University of Minnesota Police Department; the video showed the arrival of Richard at the Carlson School of Management (CSOM) on Friday, August 31st, 2018. Richard arrived at the CSOM and was escorted to a conference/class room by an Asian male, believed to be [REDACTED] [REDACTED] is apparently an employee/student in the CSOM study program. A short while later MPD officers approached the room Richard was in, entered, and took Richard into custody. Richard was then led from the room and escorted to the elevators by the officers. [REDACTED] appeared to be outside the room taking photographs as the officer's placed Richard in handcuffs. [REDACTED] then followed the officers as they escorted Richard toward the elevators, and again appeared to be taking more photographs of the arrest.

At approximately 2137 hours, we responded to 319 19th Ave S (Carlson School of Management) for a criminal sexual conduct report. Remarks stated that the caller had been sexually assaulted in the area of uptown Minneapolis last night. The caller would be waiting for us inside of the listed address.

Upon arrival, we were brought to the second floor where we met with the victim. Officer Thao spoke with the victim in a private conference room. I spoke with friends of the victim who were on scene but were not with the victim when the incident occurred. Friends of the victim informed me that Al/Qiandong Liu was leaving the state tomorrow in a private jet. Liu had contacted the victim today asking if they could meet and talk about moving to New York together. The friends also informed me that Liu has had been involved in a previous incident like this one in Australia. Liu is an entrepreneur who is well known in China.

I was advised by Officer Thao that Liu was on his way to Carlson School of Management. Liu insisted on speaking with the victim in person. I advised the victim's friends that we were not going to let them meet for the victim's safety. Several minutes later, the victim's friend informed me that Liu had in fact arrived on scene. I informed Officer Thao. At this time, I turned off my body worn camera to have a professional conversation with Officer Thao and also to speak with Sergeant Chad Joseph over the phone. I was informed by Officer Thao that Sergeant Chad Joseph had approved PC to arrest Liu for criminal sexual conduct.

I reactivated my body worn camera at this time. Officer Thao and I approached Liu who was waiting in a separate conference room on the second floor as well. The victim stayed with her friends in a secured conference room. We went into the conference room and handcuffed Liu who complied with our commands. Liu was informed why he was being placed under arrest for.

Before Liu was brought to our squad car, I explained the victim the process of a show up so she can identify Liu as the person who sexually assaulted her. The victim nodded that she understood and I brought the victim outside of the conference room she was in. Liu was waiting by the elevators with Officer Thao. Liu was facing towards our direction. I asked the victim if that was the man who assaulted her. The victim looked over at Liu and nodded



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her head yes, then immediately walked back into the conference room and began to cry. It should be noted that Liu was facing in the direction where I was standing with the victim. Also, the show up was completed in a very well lighted common area of the Carlson School of Management. On September 1st, 2018, I was assigned this case for investigation; this case involved the arrest of Liu "Richard" Qiangdong (3/10/1973), a Chinese national, and a student at the University of Minnesota.

Qiangdong was taken into custody by MPD Officers at the Carlson School of Management (CSM), on the campus of the University of Minnesota (UM), at approximately 2150 hours on August 31st. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] I will refer to Qiangdong as "Richard" for the purposes of this investigation.

Related to this incident was a previous call for Police service (MPD CCN: 18-293415); the prior contact occurred on August 31st, 2018, at approximately 0259 hours when MPD officers were asked to respond to an "in-progress" sexual assault at [REDACTED]. The caller, [REDACTED], reported to 911 that he had received a text message from a friend, [REDACTED] indicating that his friend was being sexually assaulted by a male known to her inside her apartment at the aforementioned address. MPD officers, along with UM Police Department (UMPD) Officers, responded to the call. Once contact was made with the victim, [REDACTED] it was determined that there was an apparent misunderstanding between [REDACTED] and the 911 caller, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] ultimately informed the officers that the sexual contact between her and Richard was "consensual" and "spontaneous." [REDACTED] was left in the company of [REDACTED]; while Richard was taken back to the hotel he was staying in at Minneapolis by the responding MPD squad. The responding officers then changed the nature code from Criminal Sexual Conduct to a Miscellaneous.

September 1st, 2018:

I reviewed the available PIMS reports associated with this investigation; based upon the information provided, and knowing that Richard was not given a Sexual Assault Exam (SAE), I drafted a Search Warrant to collect a sample, via Buccal Cell swab or blood draw, of Richard's Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA). The Search Warrant was electronically sent to Judge Laurie Miller; Judge Miller reviewed the Search Warrant and electronically signed it. During the time it took for me to send and received the signed Search Warrant I was contacted by Legal Counsel for Richard; Attorney Jill Brisbois (of Caplan and Tamburino) had contacted



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me and informed me that her client, Richard, was willing to give a Consent DNA sample and that he could obtain it immediately. Follow Up Report# MP 2

I proceeded to the Hennepin County Public Safety Facility (PSF) where Richard was being processed into the jail to collect the DNA sample via Buccal Cell swab. I completed and signed the MPD's Consent to Search Form and gave it to Attorney Alan Caplan to review (Caplan and Brisbois were both present); Caplan reviewed the form and advised his client Richard to sign it. Richard signed the form, and I provided Caplan with the subject's copy. I then collected the sample utilizing the standard MN Bureau of Criminal Apprehension's Buccal Cell sample kit. The sample was later placed into the MPD's Property and Evidence Unit under this investigation. The Search Warrant was not executed and will not be filed.

At 1315 hours I met with [REDACTED] at her apartment at [REDACTED], to conduct a formal interview regarding the assault she had reported on August 31st, 2018 at approximately 2100 hours. [REDACTED] is an international exchange student and [REDACTED]. When I arrived at [REDACTED] apartment, there were two other women and one male present; I recognized one of the women and possibly the male from the Body Worn Camera (BWC) video I had reviewed prior to meeting with [REDACTED]. I believe the woman and the man were present at the CSM when Richard was taken into custody.

I believe that [REDACTED] was intending on having the people stay with her during the interview; I explained that it would be fine if they stayed, but that they would be subject to a subpoena if the case were set for trial. I also explained that they would not have the protections of a certified advocate, and would have to respond to questioning by the court. All three decided to avoid that possibility and left the apartment.

I began speaking with [REDACTED] and explaining the investigative process to her before activating the recorder. During my preparation for recording [REDACTED] comments I asked her to briefly describe the incident so I would know where the event started and ended. During [REDACTED] description of the event she became very quiet and apprehensive in describing what happened; after several minutes of her pausing and stopping, I asked her if she wished to pursue this investigation? [REDACTED] immediately and spontaneously said; "No, I just want it to go away." I told [REDACTED] that it was her choice if she wished to pursue the investigation and that I would react accordingly. [REDACTED] explained that she did not want to pursue the investigation at this time. I had told [REDACTED] that if she wished I could close the case for the time being, but that if she changed her mind, we could re-open the case for investigation. I also explained that there was no guarantee of an outcome in either case, based upon closing or re-opening the case. [REDACTED] stated that at this time she wished to have the investigation closed. Then [REDACTED] said; "I want apology,and money."

[REDACTED] statement took me by surprise; I told [REDACTED] that I was not the person to be involved with that type of thing. [REDACTED] restated that she wanted an apology and money. I explained at that time that what she was asking for was not the responsibility of the police department. I told [REDACTED] that based upon her request for an apology that I could forward her contact information to Richard's attorney and she could communicate directly with her. I had identified Jill Brisbois as the attorney that [REDACTED] should speak with.

I told [REDACTED] that based upon her decision I would be releasing Richard from jail; [REDACTED] said she wanted Richard to stay in jail until he apologized to her. I told [REDACTED] that I was obligated to release Richard because at this time the case was closed, by [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said she understood my explanation.

I then activated my recorder and requested that [REDACTED] communicate her decision to not pursue the investigation at this time, which she did. The recording was stopped; I provided a business card to her and wished her well. I reiterated to her that at this time I would be closing the case and ceasing investigative efforts.



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Follow Up Report # MP 2

Prior to leaving [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]) I contacted the on-duty manager, [REDACTED], and asked to review the on-site security camera recording from the incident date. [REDACTED] took me to the security/maintenance office for the complex and we began reviewing the video footage. [REDACTED] was able to located [REDACTED] and Richard arriving at the complex at approximately 2156 hours. I watched as the system was able to track almost all of the movement from the parking circle entrance, to the elevator, to the ninth floor, and down the corresponding hallway to [REDACTED] apartment, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was unable to copy the video to a storage medium. I told [REDACTED] to not let it disappear, and that I would return to [REDACTED] with the MPD's video forensic specialist to copy it from the system to a storage device. [REDACTED] stated he understood.

Upon leaving [REDACTED] apartment I contacted Hennepin County Attorney's Office - Criminal Division Lead, Al Harris, and explained to him the outcome of my visit with [REDACTED]. I advised Attorney Harris that I would be releasing Richard from custody as soon as I returned to my office. Harris agreed with the decision to release Richard.

I then contacted Attorney Brisbois and advised her of [REDACTED] request for an apology. Brisbois said she would get in touch with [REDACTED]. I also told Brisbois that at this time the case would be closed, and that Richard would be released, pending complaint.

At approximately 1545 hours I prepared and faxed to the Hennepin County Adult Jail (HCJ) -Records Division a "Release - Pending Complaint" memo, advising the jail to release Liu "Richard" Qiangdong. The Fax was received and I confirmed the delivery with a phone call to the Records Division.

At approximately 1550 hours I received a call from [REDACTED]; she had been contacted by the HCJ and told of Richard's release. [REDACTED] misunderstood the caller and believed it to be Richard's Attorney, Jill Brisbois. [REDACTED] was angry that she had not received an apology or offer of money. I explained to [REDACTED] that she had not heard from the attorney and that it was the HCJ mandatorily informing her of Richard's release. Then [REDACTED] said; "if I not hear from Attorney by 6PM, I go to media." I told [REDACTED] that I could not have anything to do with what she had just suggested and that she should be hearing from Richard's attorney soon.

After receiving the 1550 hours call from [REDACTED], I called Brisbois and suggested that she contact [REDACTED] as soon as possible. Brisbois thanked me for the information and said she would contact her immediately.

I then advised the MPD's Public Information Officer (PIO), John Elder, of the case closure and of Richard's release. At that time I left the office for the weekend.

At approximately 1800 hours I received a call from Attorney Brisbois; Brisbois explained that she had received numerous calls and some texts from [REDACTED], all requesting money.

At approximately 1818 hours I contacted Attorney Brisbois and asked her if she could share with me why her client (Richard) was at the CSM the night he was arrested; Brisbois stated that she would have to check with her client to see if she could share the details, but did state that it appeared to be about money and possible extortion.

September 4th, 2018



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At 0830 hours I retrieved two voicemails that I had received on Saturday, September 1st, 2018. One at 1838 hours and another at around 1958 hours. Both messages were from [REDACTED]. The first message, received at 1838: [REDACTED] was received at 6:38PM Saturday, September 1st - "I just want to reopen case, I'm [REDACTED] I think he is, he is, his lawyers, his lawyers already talked to me, but he, he first let me to negotiate and let me to come to his office like today, but then....." Utilizing a recorder I copied the message from the Voicemail system to the recorder and uploaded it to the Winscribe system.

The second message was received at approximately 1958 hours (I believe), it was also from [REDACTED]; this message was not recorded or saved. The content of the message was similar to: "This is [REDACTED] I want reopen case."

Based upon the received messages I re-opened this investigation.

I began to review the BWC videos created by the responding officers to each call (18-293415 and 18-294338). I have shared the BWC videos via Evidence.com with the HCAO.

I received a contact from Attorney Jill Brisbois; Brisbois explained that she had some evidence related to the case that she wished to share with me. Brisbois also requested that we meet at the HCAO, and also invite Al Harris. The meeting was set for 10:00AM on September 5th, 2018.

September 5th, 2018:

I was contacted by PIO John Elder; Elder had received a contact form an attorney, Will Florin, of Florin/Roeberg (FL), who was apparently representing the victim, [REDACTED]. Florin had informed Elder that it was imperative that he meet with me before returning to his home state of Florida. Elder provided me his contact information.

At approximately 0830 hours on September 5th, 2018, I contacted Attorney Florin; Florin requested that we meet as soon as possible, Florin also stated that he was leaving for Florida on this day 1300 hours. I explained to Florin that I had an unrelated interview at 0830 hours and a case related meeting at 1000 hours with the county attorney's office and counsel for the suspect. Florin was respectful, but insistent that he meet with me before he left for Florida. I contacted Al Harris, at HCAO, and requested that he meet with Brisbois to acquire what ever evidence she was providing, so that I could meet with Florin and see what it was he needed to see me about, Harris agreed.

At 1000 hours Al Harris met with Brisbois and acquired from her the evidence she wished to pass along to me.

At approximately 0930 hours I met with Florin in Room 108 of Minneapolis City Hall. Florin was accompanied by two other attorney's; Chad Florin, of Florin / Roeberg (FL), and Jian Hang, of Hang and Associates (NY). Hang, who speaks Chinese, had apparently contacted Florin/Roeberg and they were now co-counsel representing [REDACTED].

During the meeting with Wil Florin, Chad Florin, and Jian Hang I was presented contact information for two of the individuals possibly involved in this case; [REDACTED] was identified as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] was identified at [REDACTED]. Phone numbers were provided for each party. I was also informed that neither would speak to the attorneys' about the incident.

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After finishing the meeting with [REDACTED] attorney's I contacted Al Harris to see what had been presented to him by Attorney Brisbois. I met with Harris in his office at the HCAO. Follow Up Report # MP 2

Harris provided me with a packaged Flash drive that apparently contained the evidence that Attorney Brisbois was speaking of. Harris showed me the notes he had taken while meeting with Brisbois. Brisbois had apparently showed Harris a prepared PowerPoint that included voice recordings and text messages of the communications between Brisbois and [REDACTED]. The timeline of the calls also included the times that Brisbois and I had contacted each other on the 1st of September. Harris's notes indicated that [REDACTED] was apparently extorting the sexual contact she had with Richard for money. This information coincided with the statement made to me by [REDACTED] when she called me on September 1st at 1550 hours and said that she would go to the media if she did not receive a contact from Richard's attorneys. I will review the material on the Flash drive and use a separate supplement to describe the contents.

Later on this day I received a contact from Attorney Brisbois; Brisbois wanted to meet with me at 0900 hours on September 6th, 2018, to show me what she had showed Al Harris when she met with him at the HCAO's office. I agreed to meet with her the next day.

September 6th, 2018:

At approximately 0900 hours I met with Attorney Brisbois and an additional Attorney, Earl Gray, at my office. Attorney Brisbois asked that she have the opportunity to review with me the contents of the Flash drive she had left with Al Harris of the HCAO. Attorney Brisbois played the PowerPoint project on her lap top and let me listen to the four audio phone calls she recorded between herself and [REDACTED]. The four calls involve contacts between [REDACTED], who is asking for money and an apology, or she will go to the police and the media. Brisbois asks her to make a monetary proposal, but [REDACTED] asks that Richard make the proposal because she doesn't know how much to ask for.

I prepared the paperwork necessary to transfer custody of the available physical and biological evidence to the MN Bureau of Criminal Apprehension's (BCA) Forensic Laboratory. The paperwork was then sent to the MPD's Community Service Officer (CSO) assigned to investigations.

I contacted the Origami Restaurant to ask that they hold and prepare the internal video surveillance footage from the incident date.

I conducted a phone interview with the suspect; Liu "Richard" Qiangdong, at the law offices of Hogan and Lovell's, located in the IDS Center. Present for the interview was; Jill Brisbois, Earl Gray, Attorney Peter Walsh (Hogan & Lovell's), George (an attorney who speaks Mandarin Chinese). Richard was provided a translator at his location in Beijing, China. The interview was recorded and uploaded to Winscribe.

Scheduled a formal re-interview of [REDACTED] through her attorney, Will Florin, for Monday, September 10th, 2018, at 1100 hours, at the Florin & Roeberg office at 7760 France Ave. S, Suite 130, Bloomington, MN. Florin extended an invitation to the HCAO's office to attend if they wished, that was passed along to Al Harris of the HCAO.

September 7th, 2018:

I attempted to conduct an interview with [REDACTED] who is one of two personal assistants to the suspect, Richard. This interview was to take place at the office of Hogan and Lovell's at 1100 hours. Upon arrival



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I was met with hostility by the attorney's Walsh, Gray, and "George", because the involved lawyers had been informed that the MPD was issuing a Press Release that I was somehow supposed to be aware of, and communicate said information to them. I was informed that [REDACTED] would not be made available for an interview and that I was somehow "fucking them" throughout this investigation. I explained that I am not informed of "Press Releases" by our PIO's and that I was not subverting their client in any way during this investigation. I contacted PIO John Elder and let him explain via speaker phone what was apparently going to be a "canned" response to press questions received that day. I was advised that I "might" be able to interview [REDACTED] at a later date. Attorney Gray was particularly upset that the victim was afforded legal counsel; I stated that it wasn't that unusual for a victim to seek legal advice from an attorney. Once the hostilities finished, I showed myself out of the office without further communication.

Evidence collected during this investigation that required forensic analysis was transported to the MN Bureau of Apprehensions' (BCA) Forensic Laboratory for testing and analysis. The evidence was transported to the BCA by MPD Community Service Officer Marvyn Velasco.

September 10th, 2018:

Conducted a recorded interview with the victim, [REDACTED] at the offices of Florin and Roeberg, located at 7760 France Ave. S, Bloomington, MN. Present for the interview was; [REDACTED] Attorney's Will Florin, Chad Florin, Jian Hang, and Keli Liu. In addition I was presented an envelope of 3 packets that contained photo copies of "screen shots" of the "WeChat" application apparently used between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] on the incident date. For a verbatim text of this interview, reference the transcribed version in a separate supplement.

September 12, 2018

I contacted and later conducted an interview with [REDACTED] was Richard's "driver" for the week he was in Minneapolis. I met [REDACTED] at his limousine parked in front of the Hotel Ivy in downtown Minneapolis. [REDACTED] is the owner of the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was concerned to meet with me because he has been inundated by attorneys and press trying to speak with him about this investigation. Once I proved to [REDACTED] that I really was a police officer, he permitted me to record a brief statement from him. Reference the transcribed report for a verbatim review.

I received MN BCA Lab Reports; 1 and 2: they were the Toxicology reports related to [REDACTED] SAE. Both tests, Urine and Blood, failed to reveal the presence of alcohol.

I visited the [REDACTED] complex and retrieved a copy of the video surveillance recordings from the incident date; the involved cameras were download by Crime Lab Forensic Video Technician, Ali Murray, and later placed into the MPD's Property and Evidence Unit. On site Manager, [REDACTED], was the contact at [REDACTED].

September 13th, 2018:

I retrieved the video surveillance evidence from [REDACTED] that was collected on the 12th. A copy of the evidentiary drive was also given to the HCAO for their review.

September 14th, 2018:



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I contacted [REDACTED], the 911 caller, and requested of him the copies or screen shots of the "WeChat" application contacts he had with [REDACTED] the morning of the incident. [REDACTED] told me that he deleted all of the files and would not let me conduct a forensic exam on his phone to recover the deleted files. I then recorded [REDACTED] as we spoke about the incident and what his knowledge of it was. [REDACTED] was unaware that I was recording the conversation. Once the call ended, I uploaded the contact to Winscribe.

Several minutes later [REDACTED] called back to tell me that what he had told me regarding the incident was not factual and to disregard what he said. I told [REDACTED] that if ever "remembered" the facts of the evening, I would like him to contact me. That conversation was also recorded.

I conducted a recorded interview of Richard's assistant, "Alice"; the interview involved a translator, Peter Lin, from Interpretation's Inc. The interview was conducted at the offices of Hogan & Lovell's. "Alice" was identified as Zhang Yujia (4/03/2018) and a citizen of China. This interview was uploaded to Winscribe; reference the transcribed version in a separate supplement for verbatim text.

On September 1st, 2018, I was contacted by Attorney Jill Brisbois, legal counsel for the suspect, Liu "Richard" Qiangdong (3/10/1973). Brisbois had been in phone/text contact with the victim, [REDACTED], after I had left [REDACTED] apartment and effectively closed the investigation at [REDACTED] request. At 1545 hours I released Richard from custody.

[REDACTED] had given me permission to forward her phone number, [REDACTED], to Brisbois for the purposes of extended conversation between the two.

At approximately 1800 hours I received a call from Brisbois informing me that she had had several conversations, via voice and text message, with [REDACTED] and that [REDACTED] was asking for money and to negotiate the amount with Brisbois. Brisbois indicated to me that she thought it was "a shakedown for money", at one point Brisbois had arranged for [REDACTED] to meet her at her office to discuss the payment/proposal of money. [REDACTED] had stated that she was going to bring a friend named, [REDACTED]. The meeting never took place.

Related to this contact from Brisbois, I had received a phone call from [REDACTED] at approximately 1550 in which she told me that if she did not hear from the attorney by 6PM she was going to the media. This comment was in direct conflict with what [REDACTED] had told me at her apartment; she had mentioned repeatedly during our conversation that she wanted no one to find out about this incident. I advised [REDACTED] at the time that the MPD had privatized the case and that the only way I could see anyone finding out the specifics of the parties involved would be if her ([REDACTED]) friends spoke publicly about it.

On Tuesday, September 4th, 2018, attorney Brisbois met with HCAO Criminal Division Lead, Al Harris; Brisbois provided Harris with a Flash Drive containing the several recorded calls between Brisbois and [REDACTED]. I was supposed to attend this meeting, but I was forced to attend a meeting with attorney's representing [REDACTED], as they had to catch flights later in the morning.

Harris later provided me with the Flash Drive and on Wednesday, September 5th, 2018, I met with Brisbois to review the Powerpoint on the Flash Drive, and to specifically listen to conversations between Brisbois and [REDACTED]. I heard [REDACTED] ask for money and engage in a conversation about "proposals" and meeting in person to discuss where and when the negotiations would be continued. I re-recorded the contacts so that it could be transcribed; I have forwarded a copy of the Flash Drive to the HCAO for review.

At approximately 1315 hours I met with [REDACTED] inside her apartment; upon my arrival there were three other person inside the apartment with [REDACTED], 1 man and 2 women.

I asked [REDACTED] if the other three people would be staying for the interview, I explained that if they did not have "advocate" status, they would be considered "witnesses" to the case and would be subject to subpoena if the case moved forward for trial. At that point the other persons decided to leave the apartment.

[REDACTED] and I moved to the dining/sitting area of the apartment to start the interview. Prior to starting the recorder I as began to explain the investigative process and the various steps the investigation would be going through. [REDACTED] appeared to understand the process, but was very quiet. I began to walk through the scenario of events that led to the first call to 911 and then to the second call. As we continued to speak and I gathered more background on the incident it became quite apparent that [REDACTED] was very apprehensive about the investigation.

While explaining the various outcomes that can occur related to these types of investigations, it became very clear to me that [REDACTED] was troubled about the process and the investigation. At one point I asked her if she wanted to continue to pursue the investigation; as I finished that question, [REDACTED] immediately stated; "NO, I want it to go away." This was the most emotional [REDACTED] had gotten during our conversation.

[REDACTED] stated something similar to; "I want apology....", I said; "okay", but then [REDACTED] added; ".....and money." I was surprised by this request and responded by telling [REDACTED] that it was not within my investigative parameters to secure or request money for the victim of an assault. I told [REDACTED] that with her permission I could pass along her contact information and the request for an apology (not money) along to the suspect's attorney, and that they could speak directly. I explained to [REDACTED] that I could not be involved with that communication.

I reiterated to [REDACTED] that to "close" the case at this time was her decision; and her decision alone. I explained that the case would not necessarily be "closed forever", but that it would be in a hibernating state, and that if she wished she could request that the case be reviewed for re-opening at another time. [REDACTED] asked that I close the case at this time.



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Due to the "higher profile" of this case I asked that [REDACTED] allow me to record her request to close the case at this time, which she did. I activated the recorder, asked [REDACTED] to identify herself, and then I asked her if she wished to delay or no longer pursue the investigation; [REDACTED] answered; "yeah." I reiterated to [REDACTED] that I would not be investigating the case, but that it could be reviewed for re-opening at a later date if she requested it. [REDACTED] said; "Okay." With that I terminated the interview, wished [REDACTED] well with the upcoming school year and left the apartment.

Upon leaving apartment [REDACTED], I proceeded to the management office of [REDACTED] where I met with Asst. Manager, [REDACTED], who showed me the internal surveillance recordings related to the incident. I reviewed the videos and requested that [REDACTED] download the videos to a media I could take with me. [REDACTED] was unable to make the recording system download the videos, so I told him I would return with a technician from our Crime Lab and download the videos at another time.

When I left the complex I contacted Attorney Jill Brisbois, counsel for the suspect, and provided her with the request for an apology and the Cell phone number for [REDACTED]. Attorney Brisbois said she would contact [REDACTED] shortly. I advised Brisbois that I would be closing the case at the victim's request and that I would be releasing her client from jail when I returned to my office.

Upon arrival, OFFICER SEILER and I were met by [REDACTED] and her father [REDACTED] in the rear parking lot of the apartment. [REDACTED] stated that her friend who she verbally identified as [REDACTED] was going to come and give her the evidence which she described as the screen shots of the text messages from



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the night she reported or being raped. [REDACTED] stated that she was going to then download those screen shots onto a flash drive and give it to officers. Follow Up Report # MP 3

[REDACTED] was talking to [REDACTED] on the phone and then handed me the phone stating that [REDACTED] wanted to talk to me. I identified myself to [REDACTED] as the Police and stated that we were there to gather evidence. [REDACTED] stated that he refused to give OFFICERS any evidence because he does not trust [REDACTED] and her lawyer. [REDACTED] said he would only be willing to give them to the prosecution when the time comes and only if they need them. [REDACTED] then stated that she could call [REDACTED] who possibly still has the text messages on his phone from 8/31/18 because he was the one that texted her before calling the Police.

[REDACTED] was on the phone with [REDACTED] and later handed me the phone. I identified myself to [REDACTED] as the Police and gave him my badge number as he requested. I advised [REDACTED] that we were there to collect the screen shots of the text messages between him and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] refused to give OFFICERS the evidence and stated that if we don't have any legal obligation to have them then he is not willing to give them up.

When I ended my conversation with [REDACTED] I advised [REDACTED] that if both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] refused to come give her the evidence we could not force them to come. [REDACTED] stated that she needed her blanket that [REDACTED] had. [REDACTED] later arrived and returned [REDACTED] blanket.

I took photos of the screen shot messages on [REDACTED] laptop that [REDACTED] had with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] on WeCHAT. Photos were later uploaded onto Evidence.com under the CCN# 18-294338. It should be noted that while I was speaking to [REDACTED] stated she thinks that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] probably want her to pay for the evidence. The flash drive that officers were originally were out to collect from [REDACTED] was not retrieved because both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were uncooperative and was not willing to give out any evidence.

I signed on my squad and saw that a call was waiting in pending for [REDACTED] [REDACTED] regarding follow-up to a CSC crime which had been reported(CCN 18-294338) and a Miscellaneous report (CCN 18-293415).

The remarks on the call stated that the caller wanted to turn over evidence for a case she has pending and that she did not have the case number because she gave it to her lawyer.

I advised my Lieutenant and sent Squad 223 Officers Yang & Seiler to this address to handle the call, because they were the initial officers who took the first report from [REDACTED]. It should be noted that I was also familiar with the call and had also responded to [REDACTED] at the early morning of September 2nd.

At approximately 2130hrs, I was contacted by Officer Seiler by cell phone and informed that [REDACTED] reported that a Zip drive and possible her cell phone had evidence on it regarding the CSC. I contacted Squad 710 Sgt. Sullivan and reported the information from the officers on scene. I received a return call from Lt. Goset of the Minneapolis Sex Crimes Unit and he advised me on how to proceed with the call.

I went to [REDACTED] and met with Squad 223 who was standing by in the rear parking lot. My BWC was activated and the following is a synopsis of my portion of the call.

Upon arrival I spoke to the officers and [REDACTED] and was informed that she did not have the Zip Drive and the important messages from the evening of the incident were actually on web messaging system she and her friends use to communicate called WeChat. [REDACTED] stated that she does not use the text messaging system on her cell.

I asked about the messages and was informed that several days ago she was encouraged be another person named [REDACTED] to delete the messages. [REDACTED] deleted the messages on her end and could not reproduce them at this time. [REDACTED] also reported that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have the messages by are reluctant



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to give them up at this time because they fear for their safety as well as their families safety in China. Follow Up Report # MP 5

I asked about physical evidence and was told by [REDACTED] that officers had already collected bedding and a sample of the suspect's hair and other items. Officer Yang photographed some of the messages on the WeChat message system that were not erased. [REDACTED] was advised and we cleared the scene.
