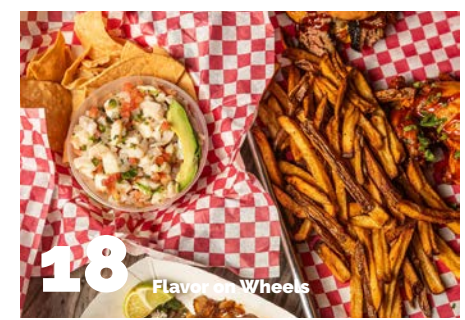

February

Charro Days Fiesta

Feb. 29th - March 2nd, 2024

The Charro Days Fiesta in Brownsville is an annual community celebration of the town's rich cultural heritage. The festival typically starts at the end of February and ends in March.

Gringo De Mayo

May 3rd, 2024

During this event, local restaurants and bars will compete for the best avocado dish and best tequila cocktail by creating and serving their best avocado-theme foods.

Come enjoy live music, avocado-themed food, beer, and flavored margarita samples.

The inception of "Gringo De Mayo" traces back several years and is credited to the late Jeff "Lighting" Lewis. The narrative unfolds with Jeff persuading the founders of Brownsville Beerfest to organize an event on Cinco De Mayo as a promotional tactic for our annual Beerfest gathering. During the proceedings, Jeff expressed gratitude to the founders for hosting his "Gringo de Mayo" celebration. When queried about the significance, he responded with a beaming smile, revealing that it was his birthday. It dawned on everyone that Jeff had cleverly orchestrated a birthday party under the guise of a new tradition, coining it "Gringo de Mayo." The ensuing moments were filled with laughter and birthday wishes for Jeff, marking the establishment of what would become a cherished annual tradition.

Rebel Fest

May 4th, 2024

Celebrate Star Wars with fans, friends, family, and all at Linear Park (E. 6th St. and E. Ringgold St.) on May 4 from 6 to 10 p.m. It's Rebel Fest: A Star Wars Festival! This galactic event features Wookiee Roar Contest and costume Contests for adults, teens, children, and pets.

Local, regional, and world-class acts headline the three-day festival, featuring dance performances and art shows.

Brownsville Beerfest

October 8th, 2024

Happening on the first Saturday of October. Our Beerfest is a non-profit organization created in 2013 to promote the city by producing a quality-of-life event for its community and neighboring towns in the Rio Grande Valley and Northern Mexico.

November

Holiday Village

Nov. 20th, 2024 - Jan. 1st, 2025

Celebrate the start of the holiday season at Brownsville's Holiday Village! Stroll through Dean Porter Park from November to the end of December, and you'll see adorable scaled-down cottages lit up just for the holiday season. Performances from dance, choir, and mariachi groups are held throughout the event. Admission to the Holiday Village is free, but the memories are priceless.

In its early days, it was the site of some of the most critical moments in this country's history, but today it's an outdoor lover's playground. Explore Brownsville's palm tree-lined pathways on a bicycle, meander through a tropical forest in search of rare birds, or discover the events that shaped America into the country it is today. These are just a few of the great things to do in Brownsville, so hop on your bicycle or assemble your hiking gear and get ready for an adventure.

Hit Brownsville's Bike Trails

One of the best ways to experience South Texas' tropical beauty is by exploring the various biking trails in Brownsville. Whether you're into road cycling or mountain biking, there's something for you here. Brownsville has 64 miles of bicycle paved and off-road trails and on-street bike lanes for you to traverse, including the nationally recognized Brownsville Historic Battlefield Trail. This nine-mile paved hike and bike path, flanked in parts by evergreen palm trees, runs north from downtown Brownsville to the Palo Alto Battlefield. Along the way, you'll see many of Brownsville's significant attractions, such as the Gladys Porter Zoo and the Brownsville

Museum of Fine Art, as well as many locals who are jogging or biking on the trail.

The winding trails and small climbs found in the 6.2-mile-long Monte Bella Bike Trail provide a fun challenge for experienced and beginner mountain bikers alike. The course, located just northwest of Brownsville, is a popular hiking and jogging spot as well, so you'll need to keep an eye out for it. Head a little farther to the northeast; you'll find eight miles of multi-use trails at Resaca de la Palma State Park, also known as one of the main birding areas in Brownsville. Didn't bring your bike? No problem. Resaca de la Palma State Park offers bike rentals for use at the park.

Take a Walk Through History

Many pivotal moments in American history can be found on these trails such as the first battle of the Mexican-American War, a conflict that would shape the future of both nations, occurred here in 1846.

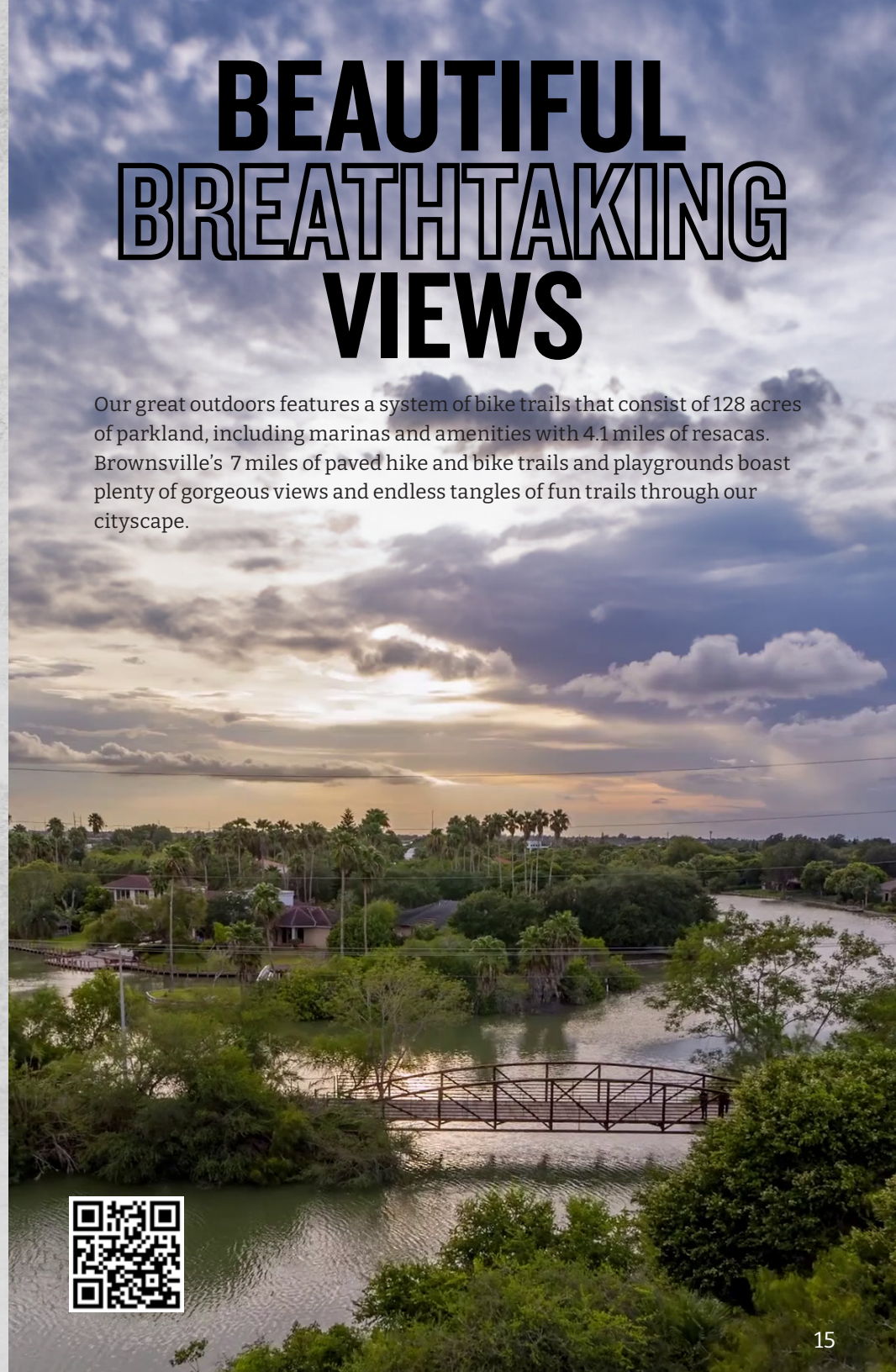
In 1865, the last match of the Civil War happened at Palmito Ranch, just east of Brownsville. Start at the Palo Alto Battlefield National Historic Site, located just north of Brownsville. Here you'll walk the battlegrounds and discover how the battle was fought, what turned the tide in America's favor, and the causes and effects of the war from exhibits within the park's visitor center. On the other hand, Palmito Ranch contains a historical

marker and an observation platform that affords a good look at the battlefield.

There are numerous historic sites in Brownsville that are worth visiting as well. The Historic Brownsville Museum, situated inside a picturesque Spanish-style building constructed in 1928, is an excellent place to learn about the town's history. Other historic sites in town include the Stillman House Museum and the Old City Cemetery Center, established in the early 1850s. Most of Brownsville's historic sites are nestled within the Mitte Cultural District, a collection of museums and parks that comprise the downtown area.

BEAUTIFUL BREATHTAKING VIEWS

Our great outdoors features a system of bike trails that consist of 128 acres of parkland, including marinas and amenities with 4.1 miles of resacas. Brownsville's 7 miles of paved hike and bike trails and playgrounds boast plenty of gorgeous views and endless tangles of fun trails through our cityscape.



Festivals All Year Long

Brownsville is known as “Where the Fiestas Never End,” and for good reason. There’s almost always something happening here, and no two events are the same. Take, for example, the Charro Days Fiesta. This late-February fiesta celebrates Brownsville’s rich cultural heritage with a vibrant parade, dances, a golf tournament, and a carnival with more than 40 rides. Don’t miss the Brownsville Latin Jazz Festival for something more musical, a three-day event held in October featuring top-

class musicians’ performances. The Brownsville Beer Fest, also in October, showcases some of the best craft and specialty beers from around the world at a 121-foot-long wooden bar, known as the “longest bar in Texas.”

Go Birding in Brownsville

Birding in Brownsville is serious business. After all, the riverside border town is home to as many as 500 tropical species of birds at any time of the year. That’s due to its mild climate, lush tropical landscape, and strategic location within a central migratory bird path. What that means for you, and any other birder, is there are birds here that you may not see anywhere else in the country.



As you may expect, there are quite a few places you can go to spot some wildlife. Resaca de la Palma State Park, Sabal Palm Sanctuary, and Boca Chica Beach are all good birding locations, but the top choice may be the Laguna Atascosa Wildlife Refuge. The refuge is home to more than 400 bird species, such as aplomado falcons, redhead ducks, and Altamira orioles, as well as the endangered ocelot. Each season brings with it a new set of birds to spot.

COASTAL *Delights*

Of course, any time spent in Brownsville includes a trip to the beach. Brownsville is within 40 miles of two of the most pristine beaches: South Padre Island and Boca Chica Beach. South Padre Island is a popular tourist destination in its own right.

The island has a complete set of restaurants and hotels, the Beach Waterpark, and many places where you can rent a jet ski or go on a dolphin or whale-watching tour. If you want to avoid the crowds, then the miles of untouched beach of Boca Chica are for you. Here you can fish, swim, jog, relax, or watch a flock of pelicans soar overhead.



FLAVOR *On Wheels*
