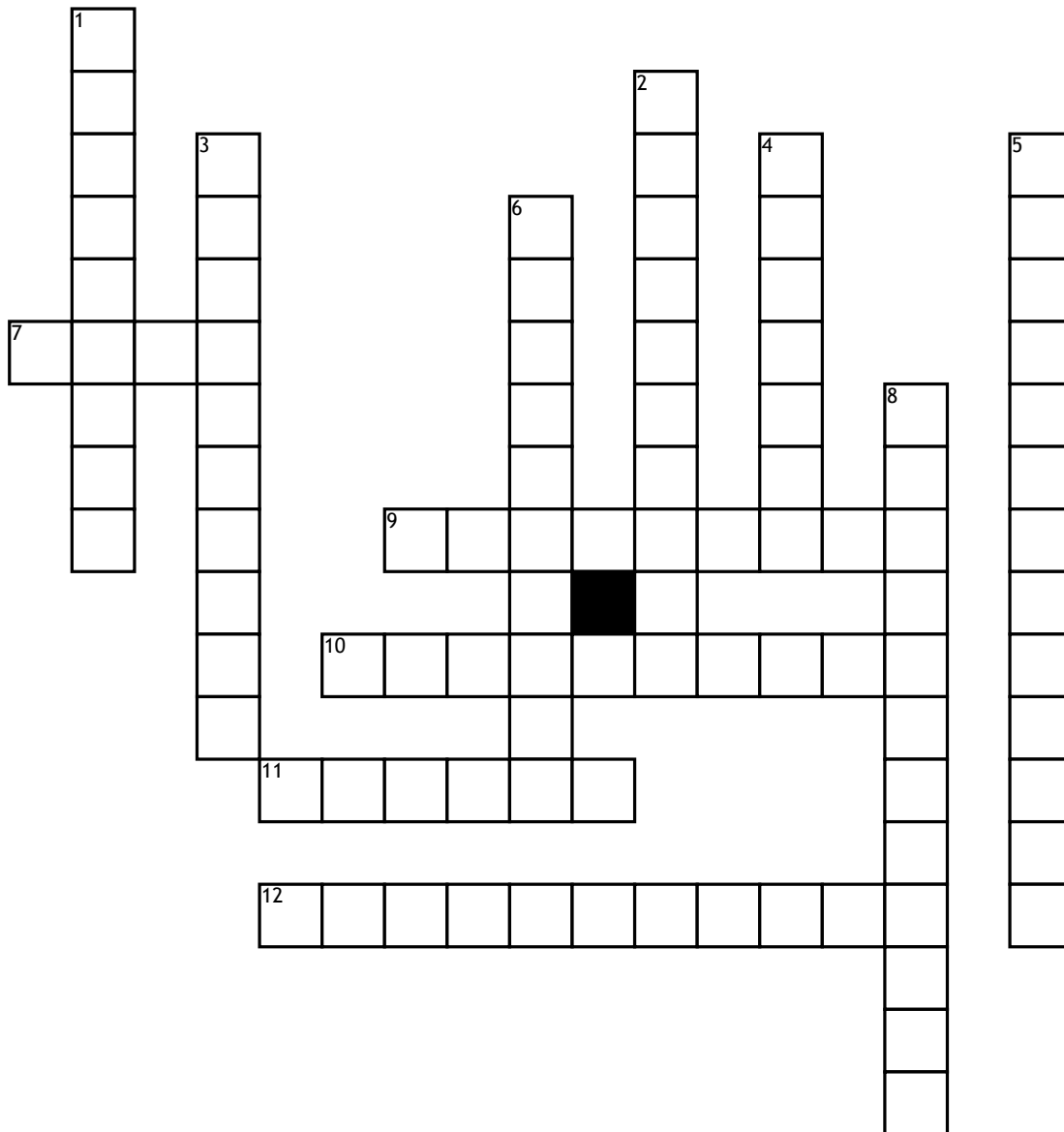


# Attacking and Defending a Castle

7. Fluid area on the outer ring of the castle

1. From whence the machinery for the drawbridge and portcullis was controlled.

2. A movable weapon in which ladders were climbed by soldiers

3. Iron grille raised to allow people to enter and leave.

4. A catapult device used to fire heavy projectiles

5. Useful to help surmount the walls of a castle

6. This was lowered by chains at the entrance to the castle.

8. Elongated weapon used on the entrance of a castle
