

- **6.** Enzyme in mouth begins breakdown of starches
- 10. This type of digestions separates food into its molecular components by chemical means
- **15.** Stores bile produced by liver
- **17.** Produced in liver; brakes down fat
- **18.** Enzyme breaks down proteins
- **20.** Eliminates stores and eliminates waster from the body
- **22.** Largest salivary glands; below and in front of ears
- 24. Begins chemical digestion and moistens food
- 25. An accessory digestive organ
- **26.** As food leaves stomach, it passes through this as it enters small intestine

- **27.** A component of plant walls that provides bulk for the food passing through the digestive system
- **28.** Enzyme breaks down carbohydrates **Down**
- 1. This enzyme breaks down fats and lipids
- 3. kills bacteria from food
- 4. Broken down into simple sugars
- **5.** Number of accessory digestive organs
- Salivary glands on floor of mouth
 This type of digestion breaks food into smaller pieces

- **13.** accessory digestive organ that produces enzymes that act on carbs, fats, and proteins
- **14.** Gastric juice in stomach that chemically alters food
- **16.** Attached to caecum (colon); no know function
- 19. Broken down into amino acids
- **21.** Lining of small intestine contain these finger-like projections that increase surface area
