

Digestive System

- **2.** a thick muscular organ that occupies the floor of the mouth and nearly fills the oral cavity when the mouth is closed
- **4.** Fold of tissue that anchors the tongue to the floor of the mouth
- **6.** Rhythmic waves of muscular contraction in the walls of certain tubular organs
- **9.** Produces bile, which emulsifies fat
- **10.** Part of the gastrointestinal tract from the ileum to the anus, divided into the cecum, colon, rectum, and anal canal

- **12.** Receives food and begins digestion by mechanically breaking solid particles into smaller pieces and mixing them with saliva
- **13.** Digestive organ between the esophagus and the small intestine
- **14.** Mass of food or liquid, that enters the esophagus during swallowing

Down

- 1. Hollow part of a tubular structure such as a blood vessel or intestine
- **3.** Part of the digestive tract extending from the stomach to the cecum; consisting of the duodenum, jejunum, and ileum

- **5.** Fleshy portion of the soft pallet that hangs down the root of the tongue
- 7. Alternating contraction and relaxation of circular muscle fibers that mix intestinal content
- **8.** Breaking down of large nutrient molecules into molecules small enough to be absorbed
- **11.** Tubular part of the digestive tract connecting the pharynx to the stomach
