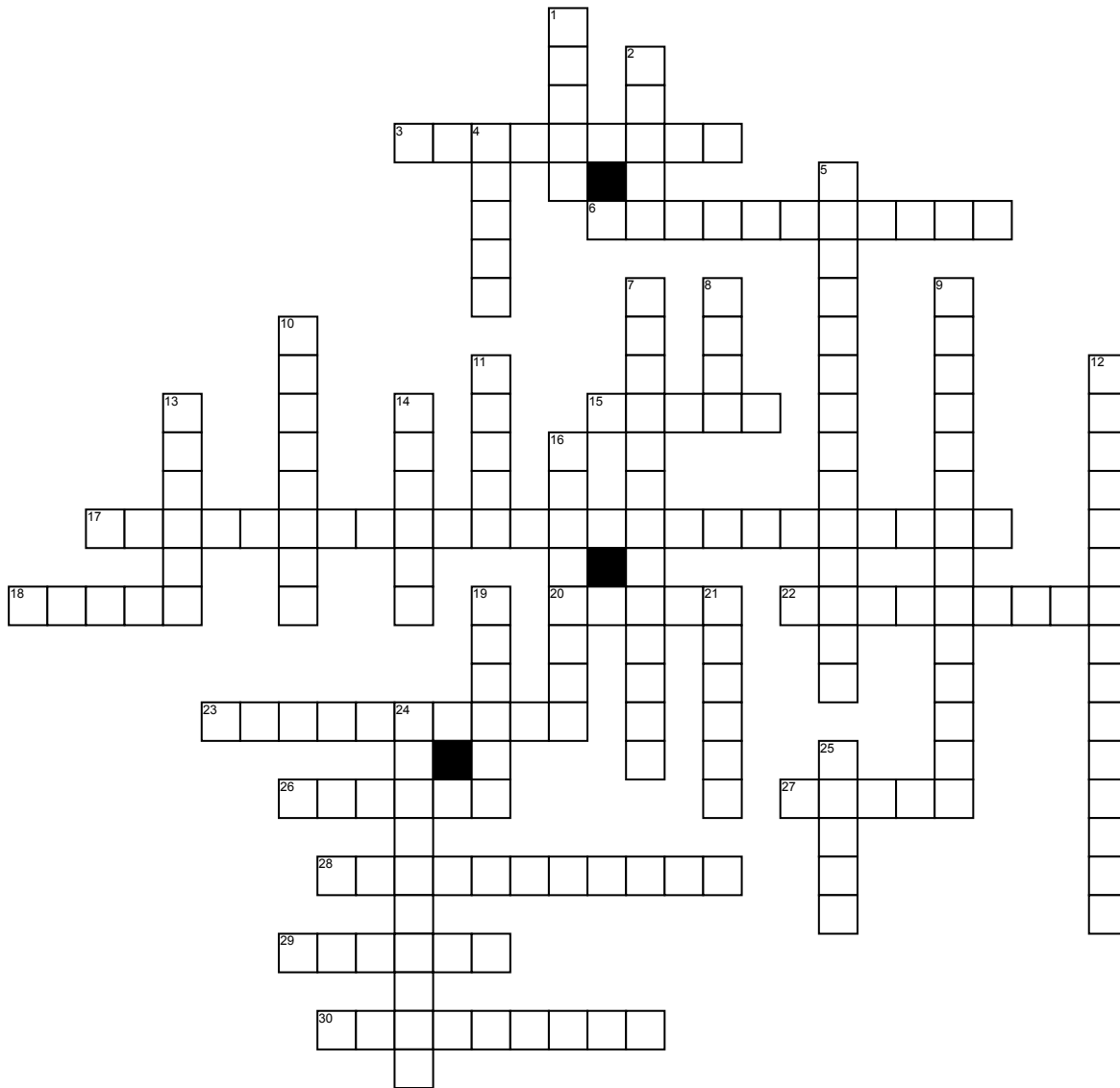


Digestive system
