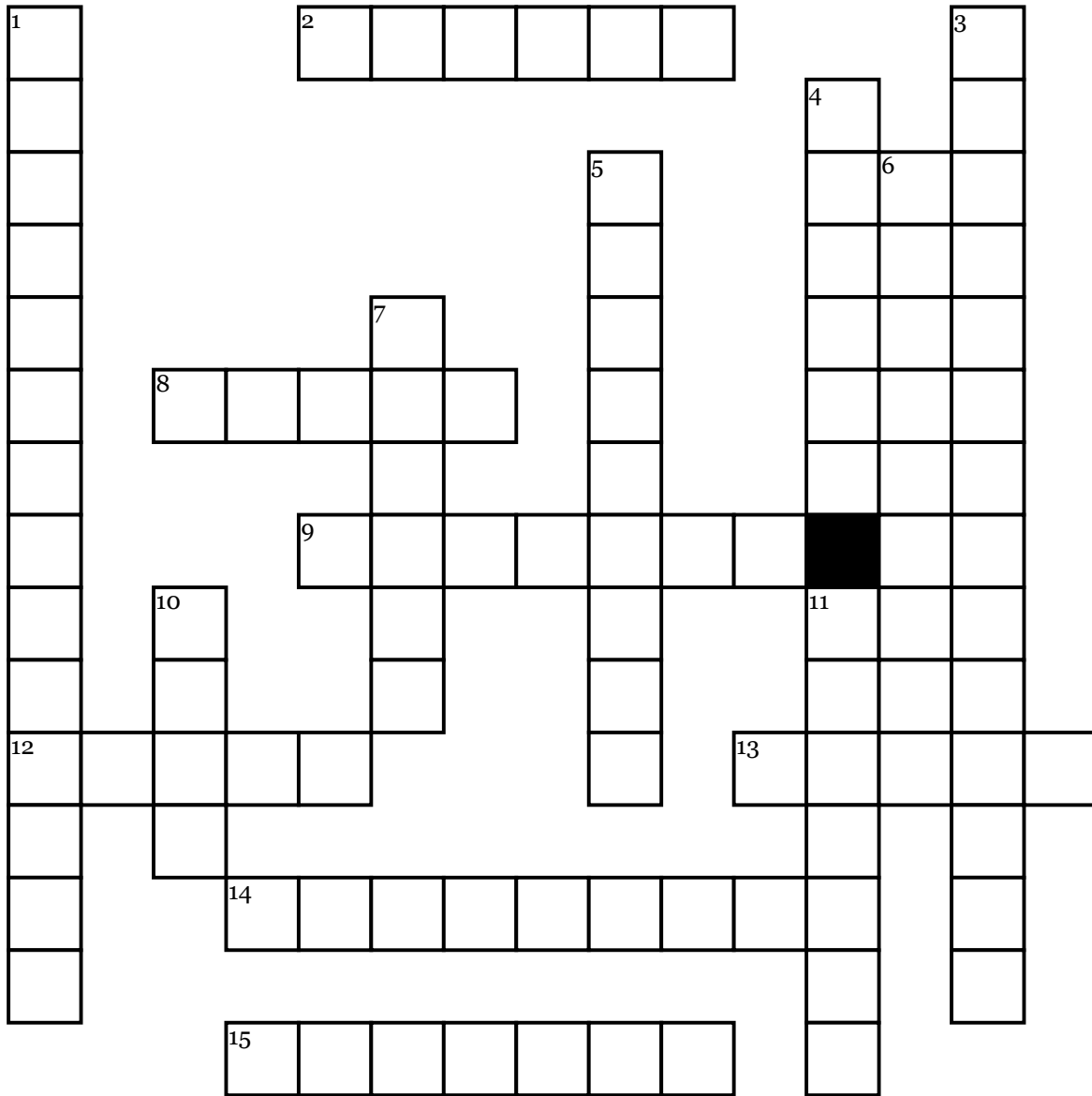


The Digestive System
