

SJCSD Elementary Report Card Updates

Fall 2022

* New ELA and Math B.E.S.T. Standards

- In the 2021-2022 school year, new ELA B.E.S.T. Standards were implemented
- o In the 2022-2023 school year, new Math Standards were implemented
- The K-2 report card will document student progress on each new standard; not all standards will be taught and/or assessed every quarter of the school year
- The 3rd-5th grade report card will document student progress in each course based upon progress on each new standard

* Character and Social Development

- The competencies on the elementary report card for Character and Social Development have been updated to align with the pillars of Character Counts
- Students will earn a 1 (consistently), 2 (sometimes), or 3 (rarely) for the following pillars: Caring, Citizenship, Fairness, Respect, Responsibility, and Trustworthiness

* Grading

- The Grading Scale for K-2 students will be reported as follows:
 - M = Meeting Standards (85% 100%)
 - \circ P = Progressing toward Standards (70% 84%)
 - \circ I = Improvement Needed (<70%)
- \circ The Grading Scale for 3rd-5th grade students will be reported with letter grades:
 - A = Outstanding Academic Progress (90%-100%)
 - \circ B = Above Average (80%-89%)
 - \circ C = Average (70% 79%)
 - \circ D = Below Average (60%-69%)
 - F = Failing (< 60%)
- Student progress will be reported through grades on the report card as well as state progress monitoring three times/year; Students with a reading deficiency will receive a letter detailing their performance and instructional plan per state statute; Because of this, the 'Grade Level Performance' line has been removed
