


Volunteers of the Month: Bruce & Ron

Bruce and Ron have been radically transforming Scheffler Park, cutting down huge amounts of invasive brush. This project has helped reveal the beautiful Mallett's Creek, flowing through the park, once mostly hidden. This project was approved through our Adopt-a-Park Special Park Project Proposal! Volunteers have been assisting at several workdays, planting native plants and trees, installing a new garden bed, and helping cut more invasive brush.

"Malletts Creek is a feature of Scheffler Park that was hidden by an expanding wall of invasive honeysuckle and buckthorn. By removing the invasives, visitors can view and come to respect the creek. With the invasives cut back, we've recently planted native trees and plants on volunteer workays. It will be exciting to see the changes over time."

An Adoptable Park: Hunt Park



Hunt Park is a large neighborhood park on the west side of the city, near downtown, with a great view of the iconic city skyline.

This is a large and beloved neighborhood park. There are rolling grass fields, tennis courts, a playground, Project Grow gardens and more. There is a garden bed full of native plants at the sign on the upper point of the park, with wild geranium and helianthus (wild sunflower), which would benefit from some mulching and division every year to increase the diversity of the garden.
