When should you visit AJE?

- When you want to learn more about your rights regarding your child's education.
- When you have doubts or questions about the special education process, ESL services, SST services, transitioning, etc.
- When you want to learn how to effectively advocate for your child.
- When you think your child's school is not providing appropriate services for your child's needs.
- When your child has academic or behavior problems in school.
- When your child has been suspended or expelled.
- When you want to find out about services available to young children with developmental delays.
- When you need linkages to community resources and supports for your child.
- When you need access to a medical home for your child and help with obtaining appropriate services for children and youth with special health care needs.
