# State Report Card Results: 4.5 Star Rating

Based on 5 Criteria:

1. Achievement: 5 Stars - Percentage of overall rating - 28.601%
2. Progress: 3 Stars - Percentage of overall rating - 28.601%
3. Gap Closing: 5 Stars - Percentage of overall rating - 14.266%
4. Graduation Rate: 5 Stars - Percentage of overall rating - 14.266%
5. Early Literacy: 4 Stars - Percentage of overall rating - 14.266%

# Achievement: 5 Star Rating (District)

- The Achievement Component rating is based on the District's Performance Index (PI). The PI gives each District or individual school building a score based on the results of each State test taken by each individual student.
- AWLS students took 6,291 tests over the course of the 2023-24 school year.

# Performance Index & Performance Level

**\*Advanced Plus:** 3.54 % of all tests taken x 1.3 = 4.5 POINTS

**Advanced:** 35.67% of all tests taken x 1.2 = 42.8 POINTS

**Accomplished:** 25.37% of all tests taken x 1.1 = 27.9 POINTS

**Proficient:** 21.57% of all tests taken x 1.0 = 21.6 POINTS

**Basic:** 7.95% of all tests taken x 0.6 = 4.8 POINTS

**Limited:** 5.66% of all tests taken x 0.3 = 1.7 POINTS

**TOTAL PI POINTS:** **103.4 POINTS**

\*Indicates a test taken at an accelerated grade level

# Performance Index Continued

- The State takes the top 2% of all PI's scores across the entire State to create a "Maximum PI Score." The "District" average PI score for 2023-24 was 109.261.
- They then take each District's PI score and turn that into a percentage based on the Maximum PI Score.
- Anthony Wayne Local Schools had a PI Percentage Score of **94.6% or top 5.4% across the entire State.**
- **The AWLS PI score ranks it 36th out of 607 Public School Districts across the State**




# Whitehouse Primary School
