

DIRECTIONS TO USCG SECTOR DELAWARE BAY

1 Washington Avenue, Philadelphia, PA 19147

FROM NORTH OF THE BASE: Take I95 South to Washington Avenue/Penn's Landing exit (Exit 20). At intersection, take a right onto Columbus Boulevard. The USCG Base is approximately ½ mile down on the left (at the stop light), adjacent to the Sheet Metal Workers Union Building.

<u>FROM SOUTHEASTERN PA & DE</u>: Take I95 North to Washington Avenue/Penn's Landing exit (Exit 20). At the "T", make a left onto Columbus Boulevard. The USCG Base is approximately ¼ mile up on the right (at the stop light), adjacent to the Sheet Metal Workers Union Building.

<u>FROM THE WALT WHITMAN BRIDGE</u>: Stay to right after the toll and take I95 North. Take Washington Avenue/Penn's Landing exit (Exit 20). At the "T", make a left onto Columbus Boulevard. The USCG Base is approximately ¼ mile up on the right (at the stop light), adjacent to the Sheet Metal Workers Union Building.

FROM THE BEN FRANKLIN BRIDGE: Stay to the extreme right when exiting the bridge. Take I95 South to Washington venue/Penn's Landing exit (Exit 20). At intersection, take a right onto Columbus Boulevard. The USCG Base is approximately ½ mile down on the left (at the stop light), adjacent to the Sheet Metal Workers Union Building.

<u>FROM THE PHILADELPHIA AIRPORT</u>: When exiting the airport lots stay left toward Philadelphia. Continue onto I95 North to Washington Avenue/Penn's Landing exit (Exit 20) stay in center lane when exiting. Take a left at intersection onto Columbus Boulevard. The USCG Base is approximately 1/4 mile on the right at the light.

<u>PUBLIC TRANSPORTAION:</u> There are three means of public transportation in the city; taxi cabs, bus lines, and subways. Below is a link to the SEPTA (Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority) website that provides schedules and maps. http://www.septa.org/

PHILADELPHIA AREA HOUSING

Sector Delaware Bay proper does not have government housing however there is some government housing available at Fort Dix in New Jersey. Most of our members receive Basic Allowance for Housing and live on the economy. However you must still contact the Housing Officer Mindy Badillo at 609-677-2174 to obtain a release from housing.

Our members reside in many different areas and states. You have the option of living in the Philadelphia area or you can commute from New Jersey or Delaware.

Some popular areas in Philadelphia to search for housing: Queens Village, Olde City, Bella Vista, Pennsport, Northern Liberties, Fishtown, City Center, Rittenhouse, and Fairmount. A few suburban areas include: Haverford, Manyunk, Bala Cynwyd, Germantown, Merion, and Ardmore.

If you are looking to live in New Jersey here are a few options: Cherry Hill, Haddonfield, Mount Laurel, and Blackwood. We do have a few members who live in Egg Harbor Township/Atlantic City Area, which is about a hour away.

• Note: you will have to cross a bridge and pay a \$5.00 toll daily if you do decide to commute from NJ.

And finally if you decide to live in Delaware, the most popular area is Wilmington. This will give you about a 45 min commute in the morning.
