### **1st-3rd Grade**

- Large backpack (big enough to hold winter gear, but no wheels)
- Several small glue sticks
- Crayons (24 count)
- Two dozen sharpened pencils
- Small pencil box or zip-up case
- Colored pencils (12)
- Scissors (Fiskars work best)
- Washable markers (broad tip)
- Mini pencil sharpener that "catches" pencil shavings

### **4th Grade**

- Large backpack
- Big three ring binder with zipper or an accordion folder
- Pencil pouch
- Pencils

- Glue sticks

### 5th Grade

- Three-ring binder or individual folders for each subject: math, science, social studies, and Bible (students will receive a separate ELA binder).
