1.1 Release Notes for LGY Suite - LGY 22.7.1

Focus of Release: The area of focus for the 22.7.1 release includes enabling the automated retrieval of Surviving Spouse information when users create a record or select redetermine. The release also addresses issues with liquidation appraisals, appraisal assignment, issue guaranty, and Veteran and seller homeowner POC phone number mapping on the new 1805 form. This release provides value to the Veteran by ensuring that Surviving Spouse Certificates of Eligibility process seamlessly and without downstream impact to appraisal ordering.

1.1 Bugs

LGY-1332116	COE	This fix enabled requestors to order an appraisal with a valid Surviving Spouse COE.
LGY-1332323	COE	This fix enabled lenders to issue guaranty with a valid Surviving Spouse COE.
LGY-1332344	COE	This fix enabled the Request an Appraisal page to properly load for a Surviving Spouse COE.
LGY-1332331	C&V	This fix allowed users to open the Appraisal Request Form 1805 in LGYHub and will display the Appraiser phone number and email in that form.
LGY-1330818	C&V	This fix populated the seller/homeowner name (form 1805 field 4M) for liquidation appraisals (SAPP, LGI, and LPL).
LGY-1330957	C&V	This fix populated the Veteran point of contact name (form 1805 field 4D) with the owner name (Section 6 on the Appraisal Request screen) for liquidation appraisals (SAPP and LGI).
LGY-1332064	C&V	This fix ensured the Veteran and Seller/Homeowner Point of Contact Phone Number fields are populated for all appraisal types by leveraging the Appraisal Request fields "Keys at Location Phone Number" and the "Owner Phone Number" to populate.
