2. EHF/BHT Discussion Antony Notes:

Discussion Points:

- Encourage board to work through ambiguous time as we structure the ACH, where BHT programs will live, and how we come together to do the work of health transformation
- EHF has fundamental approaches; move the needle, have impact, and fill gaps
- Roles EHF plays provide startup capital, form new entities, provide grants or work with other organizations to re-grant money
- BHT board members were hand-picked for expertise
- According to bylaws governing board governs this entity (hires ED, approves budget, approves bylaws, etc.)
- Have concluded it is premature to say what the role between EHF, BHT and PIA is or will be
- Important to recognize difference between governance decisions (board) while making interrelated decisions that may be reliant on individual organizations
- There was a sense needed to move the work faster; got other things out of sequence
- For BHT to be seen as credible other organizations need to see board as having decision making authority
