## Professional Training for Players ages 6 - 8



The Bridgewater United Soccer Club (BUSC) is proud to offer the Panther Soccer Academy (PSA). The Panther Soccer Academy is designed as an introduction to BUSC's Travel Soccer program. PSA is an instructional development program for boys and girls looking to improve upon their skills and take their game to the next level. Soccer instruction during the program will be provided by Dutch Total Soccer (DTS) trainers. DTS trainers are KNVB and UEFA licensed professionals. Players receive professional training and participate in small-sided games and scrimmages. Players who enroll in PSA for both the Fall and Spring seasons and then try out for and are accepted to a BUSC Travel team will receive a \$140.00 credit towards their first year of travel training costs. \*Prerequisite - Players must have either participated in In-Town Soccer in Spring 2018 or be currently enrolled in our In-Town Soccer program in Fall 2018.\*
