



CJ "Caritas Jordan" has long-standing experience of working with refugees and vulnerable people across the country. The organization was officially established and registered in the Ministry of Social Development in 1968, following the large influx of Palestinian refugees to Jordan. Since its foundation, CJ has been responding to humanitarian crises that impact Jordan, such as the influx of Iraqi refugees during the Gulf wars in 1991 and 2003. Since June 2011, CJ has been active in responding to the massive influx of refugees into Jordan due to the Syrian crisis. In Jordan, CJ is active in **9 governorates**, through a network of **26 Centers** staffed by **400 trained staff members** who are being supported by a network of more than **3,000 trained volunteers** (including Syrian refugee volunteers, both male and female).

THE CENTRES ARE LOCATED IN ACROSS JORDAN:

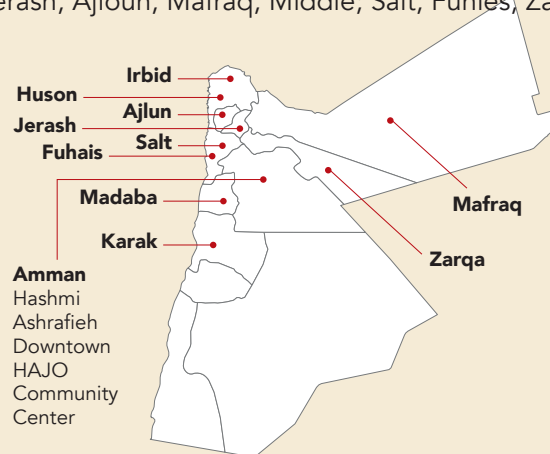

- Combat the dehumanizing poverty in all its different types.
 - Improve health conditions physical and mental, and welfare for the refugees and vulnerable host communities' families.
 - Promote better education access and develop the quality of education for the refugees and vulnerable host communities' students.
 - Enhance sustainable development partnerships between Caritas and the state departments, private sector, civil society, non-governmental organizations, and community-based organizations.
 - Develop livelihoods opportunities promoting financial development, employment and decent work to the refugees and the vulnerable host communities' families.
 - Promote protection and self-resilience safety, dignity, and avoid harmful actions that negatively affect people of concerns, as well as, secure complaints mechanism and accountability.
 - Encourage youth at all ages and involving them actively in civil society and social-voluntary works and initiatives.
 - Provide Humanitarian Assistance and Emergency Relief.

Caritas Jordan has exceptionally strong relationships with communities, CBOs, local/international NGOs, the Government of Jordan and the UN. Caritas has a strong network of local partners, volunteers, and stakeholders and adopts a strong internal and external referral mechanism through its centres distributed across the Kingdom.

It implements multi-sector programs in all its operational centres and project beneficiaries are routinely referred to other services provided by the organization such as shelter maintenance, psychosocial, WASH, health, education and livelihood services. Caritas has agreements with several local organizations and service providers including government ministries.

CARITAS JORDAN SECTORS



Food & Basic Needs Sector: Through a combination of cash payments and direct distributions, Caritas provides refugees and vulnerable Jordanians with food & Non-Food Items, including winterization and shelter support.



Protection/Counselling Sector: Caritas has expertise in first response services, therapy and legal support through its nation-wide specialist team, in addition to cooperation agreements with different institutions and Organizations for advanced referral cases. Caritas provides a host of protection services for refugees including individualized legal and social support, public human rights advocacy. Additionally, the psychosocial team provides group and individual sessions, trauma and peace-building activities.



Health Sector: Caritas has 12 primary health centres across the country providing Primary Health Care services, including: Basic Primary Health Care services, Mother & Child Health Care, Chronic Disease Management, Medical Humanitarian Assistance, health awareness and medication, with a special emphasis on women, children and elderly besides referrals to secondary providers.



Education Sector: Caritas provides four distinct educational opportunities for Syrian refugee children: kindergarten classes, catch up classes, remedial classes and child friendly spaces. In addition to educational support psychosocial activities, counselling activities are included to meet the emotional and mental needs of the children.



Shelter & WASH Sector: Caritas provides support with shelter rent and house improvements. This includes fumigation, repairs, maintenance, and installation of electricity works, water piping and sewage services, in addition to the legal awareness between tenants and landlords.



Livelihoods Sector: Caritas Jordan provides business premises to income-generating projects, small enterprises and basic life skills and occupational training courses such as cooking, sewing, babysitting and housekeeping (home based activities).



Youth Sector: Caritas is committed to continue the enhancement and empowerment of youth through volunteers within Parishes, Schools, local and international youth organisations. Civil Service, Parish Credits, Social Service and Emergency Response -Support. Since its establishment the Volunteers' Program's scope of service broadened to include a network of (30) parish committees which extend to more than (45) parishes, (25) schools serving (55) areas, with an aim to serve the community's needs and provide emergency response support while concentrating on concepts of social and citizenship.
