CORRIDOR BAPTIST CHURCH CAMP Camper Info and Agreement Form

Who can go: 7th-12 graders (this includes those going into 7th grade and those who just graduated)

What to bring: Bible, pen, **phone**, camera, flashlight, pillow, sleeping bag/bedding, water bottle, jacket, sunscreen, clothing for 2 full days of activities (plus an extra set), clothing that can get wet, bath articles, towel, money for Saturday Lunch and activities (\$20-30), a good attitude, and a soft heart.

What not to bring:

Gaming systems, electronics of any kind (except for phone & cameras), explosives, any type of weapon (including pocket knives), cigarettes, vape devices, drugs, matches, a bad attitude, or foul language.

What to wear: It is our desire to keep a godly testimony in both our behavior and dress. Clothing should be modest at all times. For recreation, clothing such as t-shirts, jeans, athletic warm-up pants, loose knee-length shorts are acceptable for all campers.

What not to wear: At no time should anyone wear short shorts, anything revealing, and clothing with suggestive or inappropriate themes.

Guys: this means no tank-tops, short shorts, muscle shirts or super skinny jeans.

Girls: this means no tank tops, leggings or yoga pants of any kind, low-cut clothing, halter/crop tops, short shorts or short skirts.

Important camp rules: Good common sense should cover whatever is not listed below.

1. No boy-girl contact is permitted (hand holding, etc.).
2. No campers will be allowed to leave the campground without permission from the camp director.
3. Everyone will participate in organized games/activities and attend all services. This is not optional. Casual dress is permitted at all times.

I agree to carry out all the rules and regulations of the camp and to participate in all activities and classes to help make this camp the most spiritually beneficial camp possible both for myself and others.
