SBI Raises ₹10,000 Crore through 15-Year Infrastructure Bonds at 7.54% Coupon Rate

Indian Grandmaster R Praggnanandhaa becomes 1st Indian after Viswanathan Anand to reach Chess World Cup semis since 2002.

The Grandmaster defeated compatriot Arjun Erigaisi 5-4 to enter the semifinals of the **FIDE World Cup Chess tournament at Baku in Azerbaijan.** He will now face American Grandmaster Fabiano Caruana in the semi-final.

No Indian had reached the last four stages of the FIDE World Cup since Viswanathan Anand won the first two editions of the tournament in 2000 and 2002.

India will be rooting for Praggnanandhaa to win as this brings him closer to becoming the World Chess Champion.

He is also one of the youngest chess wizards in the country who has brought glory to the country on several occasions.

India's First Hydrogen Bus Hits the Public Roads in Leh, Ladakh

NTPC Limited, a prominent **Maharatna Public Sector Undertaking (PSU)** operating under the Ministry of Power (MoP), has embarked on a groundbreaking venture by launching the trial of India's inaugural hydrogen bus in the picturesque region of Leh, situated in the Union Territory (UT) of Ladakh.

India, ASEAN agree to review FTA by 2025

In a significant move, India and the **ASEAN countries** have come to an agreement to reevaluate their existing free trade pact for goods. The aim of this review is to address the existing trade imbalances and disparities between the two parties.

The announcement was made by the Commerce Ministry, indicating the commitment to enhance bilateral trade relations.











India announces 'Green' Hydrogen standard

India has announced the definition of Green Hydrogen. The Green Hydrogen Standard for India sets a criterion of **2 kg CO2 equivalent per kg H2 as a 12-month** average emission threshold.

It is a significant move for the progress of the National Green Hydrogen Mission.

The guidelines established by the **Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE)**, Government of India, delineate the emission benchmarks that must be fulfilled for hydrogen production to qualify as 'Green', signifying its origin from renewable sources.

The Ministry of New & Renewable Energy has characterized Green Hydrogen as having a well-to-gate emission (encompassing processes like water treatment, electrolysis, gas purification, hydrogen drying, and compression) that does not exceed 2 kg CO2 equivalent per kg H2.

India Overhauls Criminal Laws

India is poised for a substantial legal transformation as key legislations are set to be replaced to align its criminal justice system with evolving societal values.

The proposed reforms include the replacement of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) 1860 with the **Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS)**, prioritizing offenses against the state, crimes against women and children, and murder.

Another significant change is the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Bill, which aims to streamline criminal proceedings for enhanced citizen safety. The Bharatiya Sakshya Bill focuses on evidence rules to bolster the reliability of evidence in court.

These reforms introduce community service as a punishment and underline the commitment to citizens' rights and justice. The meticulous planning involving legal experts, parliamentarians, and law enforcement agencies emphasizes a balanced approach to reform.

Top States on Drug Seizure Chart

In the past three years, the **Border Security Force (BSF)** has confiscated significant amounts of narcotics from various Indian states.

Data revealed by the Ministry of Home Affairs indicates that Punjab and Rajasthan, situated along the **India-Pakistan border**, have seen the highest seizures of heroin, while Tripura and West Bengal, near the India-Bangladesh border, top the charts for 'ganja' confiscations.

Union Minister of State for Home, Nityanand Rai, presented these findings in the **Rajya Sabha**, detailing the quantities seized and the trends observed.

The report also highlights the handover of seized substances to law enforcement agencies for further investigation.











Strengthened surveillance measures, including advanced equipment deployment, have been adopted to curb drug trafficking across vulnerable border patches.

It draws members from MeitY's Digital Economy Advisory group and other prominent leaders in the field of AI.

India Becomes 4th Country landed Successfully on Moon

India successfully landed its Chandrayaan-3 mission on the lunar surface on August 23, 2023, making it the fourth country to do so after the United States, Russia, and China.

The lander Vikram touched down on the south pole of the moon, a region that has never been explored before. The rover Pragyan is expected to roll out of the lander and begin its exploration of the lunar surface in the coming days.

The successful landing of Chandrayaan-3 is a major achievement for India's space program and a testament to the hard work and dedication of the scientists and engineers who made it possible.

It also puts India in a select group of spacefaring nations and furthers its ambition to become a leading player in the global space race.

Uttarakhand Government's Comprehensive Survey of Disaster-Prone Areas

OpenAI CEO Sam Altman launches Worldcoin crypto project

Open AI CEO Sam Altman along with two co-founders launched the **Worldcoin crypto project** to grant users a verified digital identity and access to a financial project. What is Worldcoin?

Worldcoin is a crypto-currency project that is **launched by the Open AI CEO Sam Altman along with Alex Blania and Max Novendstern** with the main aim to provide its users with a private digital identity—"a World's Identity"—after they register in person, where an "Orb" imaging device scans their eye's unique iris pattern to verify they are "a real and unique person."

Iraq becomes the 18th country recognized by WHO for eliminating Trachoma

The **World Health Organization (WHO)** officially recognized Iraq as the 18th country to successfully eliminate trachoma as a public health concern.

This achievement also marks Iraq as the fifth nation within the WHO's Eastern Mediterranean Region to accomplish this milestone.

Additionally, the WHO has acknowledged Iraq as the 50th country to eliminate at least one **Neglected Tropical Disease (NTD)** on a global scale.

This accomplishment signifies a significant step towards the goal of having 100 countries achieve similar milestones by 2030, as outlined in the 2021-2030 NTD roadmap.

This roadmap aims to address and combat 20 different diseases and disease groups through prevention, control, elimination, and eradication efforts.

BRICS's New University Ranking System











Education ministers from the BRICS countries—Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa—have collectively decided to launch an independent university ranking system.

The move comes as a response to criticisms regarding existing rankings and their lack of comprehensive data. During a meeting held in **South Africa's Mpumalanga province**, the ministers acknowledged the necessity for a reliable and relevant education framework in today's global context.

The initiative stems from an agreement among departmental leaders, recognizing the limitations of current rating methods.

Russia's Deputy Minister of Science and Higher Education, **Konstantin Mogilevsky**, highlighted the need for a fresh evaluation framework based on objective, universally accepted data.

Representatives from all five countries' Ministries of Education endorsed this idea, emphasizing qualitative benchmarks for the forthcoming rating system.

BRICS Welcomes New Members: Inclusion of Argentina, Iran, UAE, Saudi Arabia, Ethiopia, and Egypt

In a significant geopolitical development, the BRICS alliance, comprising Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa, has announced the inclusion of six new member countries.

This expansion marks a notable shift in the alliance's composition and has the potential to reshape the dynamics of global cooperation.

President Cyril Ramaphosa of South Africa, the host nation of the recent BRICS summit, made a historic announcement on August 24th, revealing the names of the new entrants to the alliance.

The expanded BRICS now welcomes Argentina, Iran, the United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, Ethiopia, and Egypt into its fold. This move not only diversifies the alliance but also provides a platform for emerging economies from different regions to align their interests on the global stage.

Dutch Economy Enters Recession

The **Dutch economy** has entered a recession, shrinking 0.3% on a quarterly basis in the second quarter. This is the first recession since the pandemic, and follows a 0.4% contraction in the first three months of the year.

The eurozone's fifth largest economy was driven by a drop in consumer spending and exports. Consumer spending fell 1.6%, while exports were 0.7% lower than in the first three months of the year.

Inflation in the Netherlands has dropped since hitting a peak of 14.5% in September 2022, but was still relatively high at about 6% in the second quarter of 2023.











Water Crisis in Afghanistan

The International Organization for Migration (IOM) has reported that a staggering **79% of Afghans lack sufficient access to clean water** for essential needs, exacerbated by the worst drought in 30 years, economic instability, and decades of conflict.

The dire situation has led to half of the population facing acute hunger, with six million people on the brink of famine.

The International Organization for Migration (IOM) has requested \$33 million in funding to offer water, sanitation, and hygiene support to 2.3 million Afghan citizens throughout the year 2023.

With 25 of 34 provinces experiencing severe or catastrophic drought conditions, the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) emphasizes the need for urgent international attention to address the crisis.

Despite the extensive challenges, only 23% of the required \$3.23 billion in funding for humanitarian assistance has been received, further endangering vulnerable Afghans.

Saudi Arabia launches AI-Powered program to combat desertification

The **Saudi Environment Ministry** has launched a program to combat desertification using **artificial intelligence (AI).**

The program, which is a collaboration between the ministry, the National Center for Vegetation Development and Combating Desertification, and the **King Abdullah University of Science and Technology**, aims to study the status of vegetative cover in the Kingdom and contribute to the goals of afforestation projects and the "Green Saudi" initiative.

Amazon Cooperation Treaty Organization

After a hiatus of 14 years, South American nation leaders convened to prioritize the Amazon rainforest's protection during the Amazon Cooperation Treaty Organization summit.

This pivotal gathering is taking place in Belem, a Brazilian city that stands as a testament to the urgency of the situation.

Founded 45 years ago, the **Amazon Cooperation Treaty Organization (ACTO)** plays a vital role in fostering collaborations among nations.

It serves as a global entity dedicated to fostering sustainable growth within the Amazon Basin. The nations involved in this organization are Bolivia, Brazil, Colombia, Ecuador, Guyana, Peru, Suriname, and Venezuela.

The foundation for this collaboration was laid with the signing of the Amazon Cooperation Treaty (ACT) on July 3, 1978, which saw revisions in 1998. To bolster the treaty's execution, ACTO was inaugurated in 1995. Further solidifying its presence, its Permanent Secretariat was set up in Brasilia in 2002.











Iraq bans media from using the term 'homosexuality'

The media regulatory body of Iraq has issued a prohibition on the usage of the **term** 'homosexuality' instructing both media and social media entities to employ the term 'sexual deviance' in its place.

This directive encompasses all media and social media establishments functioning within the country, as specified by the Iraqi Communications and Media Commission (CMC).

The use of these terms in any of their applications is now prohibited for all licensed CMC phone and internet companies. As a result, these companies are constrained from including "homosexuality" or "gender" in any of their mobile apps.

Pakistani Senator Anwaar-ul-Haq Kakar Named Caretaker Premier

Pakistani Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif's surprise decision to dissolve the country's Parliament, with just three days remaining before the completion of its five-year term, has led to the appointment of Senator Anwaar-ul-Haq Kakar as the caretaker premier.

Kakar, a relatively unknown figure in political circles, hails from **Balochistan**, a province marked by internal turmoil.

His appointment has sparked questions about his role, especially as he is set to oversee national elections mandated within 90 days of Parliament dissolution.

AI Robot Guides Rituals in Mecca's Grand Mosque

The General Presidency of the Grand Mosque and the Prophet's Mosque has unveiled an innovative "guidance robot" powered by artificial intelligence (AI) to assist pilgrims and Umrah performers at the Grand Mosque.

This advanced robot serves a dual purpose, aiding in religious rituals and offering guidance while facilitating fatwa operations. Its capabilities include simultaneous translations, remote expert communication, and services in 11 languages.

Designed for mobility, the robot boasts innovative features such as a **21-inch touch screen**, four wheels for easy movement, and high-resolution cameras. Enhanced audio and connectivity ensure effective communication, all driven by AI's transformative power, merging tradition and technology.

United States Introduces Preventive Pill for STIs

The United States is set to deploy an existing antibiotic, **DoxyPEP** (**doxycycline**), repurposed as a preventive pill to combat sexually transmitted infections (STIs).

Recent reports state that DoxyPEP can substantially reduce the risk of chlamydia, gonorrhea, and syphilis after unprotected sexual activity.











The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) will assess the potential benefits of curbing rising STI rates against the risk of promoting antibiotic-resistant strains.

The new approach targets high-risk groups like gay men and transgender women with prior infection histories.

Clinics are already beginning to prescribe the pill, offering a "morning-after pill" option for risky encounters.

Efficacy trials conducted in San Francisco and Seattle showcased promising results, with a two-thirds reduction in STIs every three months, particularly for chlamydia and syphilis.

The introduction of this preventive pill aims to provide a much-needed tool to address the escalating public health issue of STIs.

FIFA lifts ban on Sri Lanka Football Federation

World governing body FIFA has lifted the ban on the Sri Lanka Football Federation (FFSL). The ban was imposed in January 2023 due to government interference in the federation's affairs.

In a letter dated August 28 by Fatma Samoura, the FIFA secretary General, it said that the FIFA bureau had decided on 27 August "to lift the suspension of the FFSL with immediate effect". The FFSL has also agreed to hold fresh elections for its executive committee.

The lifting of the ban is a major boost for Sri Lankan football. It means that the country's national team will be able to resume international competition and that the FFSL will be able to resume its development programs.

The FIFA Bureau's decision to lift the ban was welcomed by the Sri Lankan government and by the football community in the country. The government said that it was committed to supporting the development of football in Sri Lanka.

UAE's Ministry of Health Launches Back-to-School Health Awareness Campaign

The UAE's Ministry of Health and Prevention (MoHAP) has initiated a back-to-school health awareness campaign spanning from August 17 to 31.

The campaign aims to educate parents and students about the significance of adopting healthy lifestyles as they return to school.

It emphasizes the benefits of physical activity, balanced diets, regulated sleep patterns, and controlled screen time.

Community events were organized in collaboration with the Ministry's representative offices across the UAE, featuring healthy cooking workshops, expert chef-guided sessions, nutritionist tips, and discussions on health-conscious practices.











The campaign aligns with MoHAP's strategy to manage community health, uplift quality of life, and promote public health. It also focuses on raising awareness about seasonal influenza and respiratory diseases through preventive measures and vaccination drives.

Foreign Relations

LCS System for Settlement of Crude Oil Transactions Between India and UAE

India and the United Arab Emirates (UAE) have initiated a groundbreaking move by settling their crude oil transactions using their respective national currencies. The landmark transaction will involve the utilization of the Indian rupee and the UAE dirham, representing a notable transformation in the dynamics of international trade.

This transformative change is facilitated by the **Local Currency Settlement (LCS) System**, which was introduced via an MoU signed during the visit of Prime Minister Narendra Modi to the UAE.

The LCS System effectively removes the necessity for intermediary currencies, leading to a reduction in both transaction time and associated costs. This pioneering step is expected to enhance economic cooperation, bolster economic resilience, and strengthen bilateral relations.

The system's success has already been demonstrated with transactions involving the gold trade. As India seeks to promote its national currency in international transactions, this move sets a precedent for innovative trade practices.

India and New Zealand sign MoU to boost cooperation in Civil Aviation

The Government of India and the Government of New Zealand have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to boost cooperation in civil aviation. This will cover the scheduling of new routes, code share services, traffic rights and capacity entitlement.

The MoU was signed by Shri Rajiv Bansal, Secretary, Ministry of Civil Aviation and HE Mr David Pine, the New Zealand High Commissioner in the presence of Shri Jyotiraditya M. Scindia, Minister for Civil Aviation of India and Mr Damien O' Connor, Minister for Trade and Export Growth, Minister of Agriculture, Minister for Biosecurity, Minister for Land Information, and Minister for Rural Communities of New Zealand.
