Assets in foreign currencies











The foreign currency assets, which make up a big part of the savings, went up by \$1.488 billion to \$565.648 billion.

When non-US currencies like the euro, pound, and yen go up or down in value, it affects these investments.

During the stated week, gold reserves rose by a large amount, adding \$1.072 billion to \$55.952 billion.

It is the art of Ajrakh.

- The art of ajrakh, which is a type of textile craft, is highly regarded in the cultural fabric of Gujarat, notably in the regions of Sindh, Barmer, and Kutch, where its history dates back millennia.
- The art of Ajrakh is characterized by a painstaking technique of hand-block printing on treated cotton cloth, which ultimately results in elaborate designs that are imbued with a wealth of profound meaning and historical significance.
- Indigo is a well-known material that is most frequently used as a powerful dye to generate a bluish effect.











The name "Ajrakh" originates from the word "Azrak," which means indigo. Traditionally,
Ajrakh prints were made up of three colours: blue, which symbolized the sky; red, which
represented the land and fire; and white, which represented the stars.

Thiruvananthapuram International Airport Leads Nation with Zero Waste to Landfill Accolade

The Zimbabwean rupiah, which is backed by Zimbabwe's gold reserves, was initially presented digitally at the beginning of April and has since been released in the form of banknotes and coins.

Rejection and a lack of regard

- Even though it is the sixth currency that has been introduced since the collapse of the Zimbabwe dollar in 2009, the Zimbabwe dollar (ZiG) is already being met with skepticism and opposition from certain sectors.
- Since the United States dollar continues to be the most trusted money among Zimbabweans, some government departments and businesses have decided not to accept the new currency.
 Instead, they have chosen to continue using the traditional currency.

World's First 6G Device Launched in Japan

World Press Freedom Index 2024 Announced, India Ranked 159th Out of 180 Countries

Reporters Without Borders (RSF) puts out the World Press Freedom Index every year.

The latest version, which ranks India 159th out of 180 countries, is not good news.

This is a little better than its previous number of 161, but it still shows how hard things are for journalists in the country.

Surprisingly, India is ranked 152nd, behind its neighbouring country Pakistan. Sri Lanka is ranked 150th, just ahead of India.

The World Press Freedom Index put Norway at the top of the list and Denmark at the bottom. Swedish came in third place on the list.

A Look at the Press Freedom Index

There are 180 countries that the World Press Freedom Index rates based on how free and independent journalists are to work and report.

The scores show how there are different levels of press freedom around the world. The Asia-Pacific region is the second most difficult place for journalists in the world.

Myanmar, China, North Korea, Vietnam, and Afghanistan are some of the most dangerous places for journalists to work.

This year, none of the Asian countries that made the Index's top 15 made it. This shows that press freedom is still a big problem in the area.

Freedom of the Press in South Asia











Reporters Without Borders (RSF) just put out the 2024 World Press Freedom Index, which shows once again how free the press is around the world.

In South Asia, India is ranked 159th, and its neighbour Pakistan is ranked 152nd, just ahead of it.

Sri Lanka, another important country in the region, is ranked 150th.

The difficulties journalists face in the area are shown by these rankings. It is not always possible for them to work and report freely.

For the first time ever, every person in the top 15 has a net worth of \$100 billion or more.

How Rich and Famous Mukesh Ambani Is

The 12th richest person in the world is Mukesh Ambani, Chairman and Managing Director of Reliance Industries Limited (RIL).

He is worth \$110 billion. Ambani is one of the richest people in the world because RIL works in many fields, such as petrochemicals, oil and gas, internet, retail, and financial services.

Gautam Adani's Return

Ganesh Adani comes in at number 14 with \$100 billion. Adani Group does business in a lot of different areas, such as ports, airports, power production and transmission, green energy, edible oils, cement, real estate, and more.

India has now reached the milestone of one million drivers, making it the third country in the world to do so, following the United States and Brazil.

This purchase, which includes a technology transfer deal between Adani Defence Systems and Technologies Limited (ADSTL) and Rosoboronexport of Russia, is a big step forward for India's defence readiness.

Why do you need Igla-S VSHORAD Systems?

The Igla-S VSHORAD system is a portable missile system that is made to fight low-flying aerial dangers like planes, helicopters, and drones that are close by.

Adding it to the Indian Army's arsenal fills in important holes in the country's air defence system.

The package for buying things has 48 launchers, 100 missiles, and extras like night vision gear and a place to test the weapons.

Indian Army and IAF Conduct Joint Exercise in Punjab

The main goal was to make sure that these assets could be used to help ground offensive operations by strike corps, along with live fire from helicopters as required by mechanized troops during offensive manoeuvres.

DRDO's Supersonic Missile-Assisted Torpedo Delivery System Achieves Success

The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has achieved a significant milestone in enhancing India's anti-submarine warfare capabilities with the successful flight-test of the Supersonic Missile-Assisted Release of Torpedo (SMART) system.

This next-generation torpedo delivery system was successfully flight-tested on May 01, 2024, at around 8:30 AM from Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Island off the coast of Odisha.

Extending the Range of Lightweight Torpedoes

- SMART is a missile-based system designed to significantly extend the range of lightweight torpedoes used by the Indian Navy.
- By incorporating advanced technologies, this canister-based system can deliver torpedoes far beyond their conventional range, providing a strategic advantage in anti-submarine warfare operations.

Microsoft Unveils AI-Enhanced 'Copilot+' PCs with Unique 'Recall' Functionality

To fight with Alphabet and Apple, Microsoft has released a new line of PCs called "Copilot+PCs" that have advanced AI features.

The goal of these devices, which were made with help from Acer and ASUSTeK Computer, is to do AI work directly instead of using cloud data centres.

Launch events took place on May 20 at Microsoft's campus in Redmond, Washington. The first sales began on June 18 with a \$1,000 price tag.

The new "Recall" feature is

This feature works for voice chats, web reading, and more, making things easier and more productive for users.











TCS & IIT-Bombay Partner to Develop India's 1st Quantum Diamond Microchip Imager

It has been agreed that Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) and the Indian Institute of Technology, Bombay (IIT-Bombay) will work together to create India's first Quantum Diamond Microchip Imager.

This high-tech sensing tool is meant to change the way semiconductor chips are examined, which should lead to fewer failures and better energy economy in electronics.

Details of the collaboration

Tech experts from TCS will work with Dr. Kasturi Saha, an Associate Professor in the Department of Electrical Engineering at IIT-Bombay, for the next two years.

The main thing they will be working on is building the quantum imaging tool in the PQuest Lab.

Quantum sensing technology will be used in this relationship to improve the quality control of semiconductor chips. This will make electrical devices more reliable, safe, and energy efficient.

Agnikul Cosmos' Agnibaan – World's First 3D Printed Space Rocket Engine

The Chennai-based company Agnikul Cosmos has done an amazing thing by successfully launching the world's first space rocket with a 3D printed engine made of a single piece. Agnikul finally succeeded on its fifth try, sending its own rocket into space. It was named Agnibaan.

This launch is India's first rocket with a semi-cryogenic engine that was created and built entirely in India.

New Ways to Use Inconel Material

The Inconel material was used by Agnikul to make the 3D-printed rocket. Inconel is an alloy that is known for not oxidizing or corroding and being good for space flight.

This makes it a great choice for this groundbreaking project.

Scientists Unveil World's Deepest Blue Hole in Mexico

Frontiers in Marine Science reports that experts have found the Taam Ja' Blue Hole in Mexico's Chetumal Bay to be the deepest blue hole known to exist on Earth.











It goes down an amazing 1,380 feet. This abyss is 480 feet deeper than the previous record-holder, the Sansha Yongle Blue Hole.

It is a fascinating place for scientists to explore and could lead to the finding of new marine life.

Figuring Out the Depths

- Echo-sounders were only able to get as deep as 900 feet in the first depth measurements of the Taam Ja' Blue Hole, which left a lot to the imagination.
- Nevertheless, a recent dive using cutting-edge gear, such as a cutting-edge CTD analyzer, gave us more information about its sizes.
- Researchers tried hard but couldn't get to the bottom because at 1,380 feet, they might have run into problems like underwater rocks or strong currents.
- This mysterious depth makes us wonder about the structure and possible connections between the cave systems inside the blue hole.

Gopi Thotakura Makes History as First Indian Space Tourist

An Indian living outside of India named Gopi Thotakura became the first Indian to go on a trip beyond Earth's atmosphere. This was a big deal for space tourism.

As part of Jeff Bezos's Blue Origin program, the NS-25 mission sent Thotakura and five other crew members into space on the New Shepard. They took off from a private ranch in West Texas.

Ed Dwight was also on the team. He was the first Black astronaut to go into space.

This trip was the program's first step back into space tourism after a two-year break caused by a rocket accident.

Thotakura's addition to the crew shows how space travel is becoming more inclusive and open to people from all over the world.

Members of New Shepard (Mission NS-25)

- Gopichand Thotakura: An entrepreneur and pilot of Indian origin, Thotakura secured his place among the six crew members for the NS-25 mission.
- Ed Dwight: A former Air Force aviator, Dwight's journey to space comes decades after facing rejection from NASA's astronaut corps. At 90 years old, he sets a record as the oldest person in space.











- Mason Angel: Founder of Industrious Ventures, Angel brings entrepreneurial expertise to the
- Sylvain Chiron: Renowned for spearheading Brasserie Mont Blanc, Chiron represents France in the crew.
- Kenneth L. Hess: A software engineer and entrepreneur, Hess contributes technical expertise to the mission.

NASA's Magellan Mission Discovers Ongoing Venus Volcanic Activity

It has been proven for the second time that Venus has had recent volcanic activity by looking at old data from NASA's Magellan probe.

Scientists in Italy have found changes to the surface that show new rock formations formed by lava flows from volcanoes that erupted while the spaceship was in orbit.

A Look at the Magellan Mission

NASA's Magellan project, which was run by the Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL) in Southern California from 1990 to 1992, made maps of 98% of Venus's surface.

Using synthetic aperture radar to get through Venus's thick clouds, the mission took the most accurate pictures of the planet to date.

ISRO successfully tests 3D-printed Rocket Engine

Using 3D printing, the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) was able to successfully complete a long-term heat test of a PS4 rocket engine.

The engine is produced in a single piece using additive manufacturing, which results in a reduction of production time by sixty percent and a savings of ninety-seven percent on raw materials.

Over the course of the entire qualification period, which lasted for 665 seconds, the engine was successfully tested.

ISRO's Liquid Propulsion Systems Centre was the one responsible for its development.











ISRO Develops Semi-Cryogenic Engine Using Liquid Oxygen

Kerosene

An advancement in the development of a semi-cryogenic propulsion system is being made by the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) through the Liquid Propulsion Systems Centre (LPSC), with assistance from other launch vehicle centres.

Through the utilization of a 2,000 kN thrust semi-cryogenic engine that is driven by a mixture of liquid oxygen (LOX) and kerosene, this system intends to improve the payload capacity of Launch Vehicle Mark-3 (LVM3) as well as future launch vehicles.

Ignition of the semi-cryo pre-burner was successful, which is a major accomplishment. Ignition of the semi-cryogenic pre-burner was an important milestone in the development of the semi-cryogenic engine by the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO).

During the testing that took place at the Indian Space Research Organization's Propulsion Complex (IPRC) in Mahendragiri, this accomplishment, which is essential for starting the semi-cryogenic engine, was accomplished.

DRDO and **IIT Bhubaneswar Collaborate on Defence Technology**

Projects

The Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Bhubaneswar and the Defence study and Development Organization (DRDO) have joined forces to do more study in areas like power systems, radar systems, and AI-driven surveillance.

DRDO has permitted IIT Bhubaneswar to work on nine projects from the Electronics and Communication Systems (ECS) Cluster.

Seven more projects are still waiting to be approved and will receive ₹18 crore in funds.

Announcement of Collaboration

Prof. Shreepad Karmalkar, Director of IIT Bhubaneswar, talked about how important the collaboration was, saying that it marks a change from creating knowledge to using it in real life, starting businesses, and making skilled professionals.

He thinks that this partnership will help defence science and technology get better.
