

**EDWIN C. and LUCILLE M. EGGEN
SCHOLARSHIP FUND APPLICATION
DIRECTIONS**

1. One senior from North High School will win a \$2,500 per year scholarship, renewable for up to 5 years, for undergraduate studies. That makes this scholarship worth up to **\$12,500!**
2. One or more seniors will receive a **one-time non-renewable scholarship**; the amount is yet to be determined by the scholarship fund.
3. The selection criteria will include:
 - Academics (you must be in top 25% of class)
 - Character
 - Commitment to complete a post-secondary program
 - Financial need
 - Extra-curricular
4. Your completed application packet must include:
 - Cover sheet (title of scholarship and your name)
 - Personal information page
 - Participation page
 - 5 essays
 - Signature page
 - Three letters of recommendation
 - A letter of acceptance from the post-secondary school you will attend. If you are undecided, attach letters from the schools you are considering.
 - Official transcript
5. Attach a transcript that includes first semester of your senior year and your current class rank. Only one original transcript is needed. The rest may be copied from the original.

Please submit application packet with cover sheet on each application (title of the scholarship and student name on each copy) and one (1) original application and four (4) copies. Include all recommendations) by April 9, 2025 by 3:30 PM to Ms. Her in Student Services.

**Deadline: Wednesday, April 9, 2025 by 3:30 PM
to Ms. Her in Student Services.**

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

3. In evaluating your application, the scholarship committee hopes to gain as complete a picture of you as possible. However, our knowledge of you is limited to the information you provide to us. Please use this page to tell us anything about you that you think we should know regarding your qualification/need for the Eggen Scholarship.

4. In order for the scholarship committee to know your academic and extracurricular interests better, please respond, in essay form, to ONE of the following:
 - A. Describe an intellectual experience of the past two years that has given you great satisfaction.

 - B. Which activity in or out of school is most meaningful to you? Why?

5. If you were given the opportunity to spend a day with any one person, living, deceased or fictional, with whom would you choose and why? Your choice should illustrate to the committee, something about you/your values, the kind of person you are/hope to become.

IMPORTANT: Three written recommendations are needed from non-relatives including: a) a civic leader: b) a business leader: c) one of your own choosing.

Note: You may be asked to attend a personal interview with the committee.

Please attach an additional page with any other pertinent information, financial or otherwise, that you would like the scholarship committee to know.
